Lyon, France 21-25 October 2024



Each year, ECHN supports one Workshop that is organised by one of its members. This year, the winning proposal came from 'Le Textile Lab' from Lyon (France) with the Workshop '**Precious Textile** - Alternative Textile Waste Recycling'.

This Workshop is aimed at Hub Managers who:

- are concerned about textile waste and local production
- want to implement circular economy in their hubs
- need to develop new activities (workshops, production...)
- want to act in a new global community
- have developed their expertise around textile, fashion and circular economy
- AND also for those who are not into textile or fashion but want to bring a fresh perspective to the subject and implement something new!

# The Precious Textile Workshop in a nutshell:

### What is it?

The 4 day event will combine a mix of field trips to inspiring projects in the area of Lyon (from social enterprises working towards a closed loop fashion process, to industrial recycling premises, and even a fish leather tannery!) with on-site learning and experimenting with the lab's machines, and creating new materials from textile waste.

Besides the program which is being designed, all the participants will bring their own expertise and experience to enrich the event with peer learning, collaboration and idea generation

### Who is this designed for?

Space managers of any hub interested in alternative ways to process textile waste and finding new uses for it.

### Who is eligible?

ECHN members will be prioritised, other hubs can apply.

The spots are limited to 15 participants, so make sure to apply soon!

### What's included

- 4 days of training, networking and inspiring visits
- All the materials we will use during the workshops
- Most of the lunches and a few evening meals
- Toolkit to help other hubs learn new ways to use textile waste
- Networking event with local stakeholders
- Accommodation (in shared rooms an extra fee applies for individual rooms)

### What is \*not\* included

- Travel allowance to/from Lyon
- Breakfasts, 1 lunch, 2 dinners (main meals from 25-35€ on average)
- Accommodation in double room (extra 15€ per night, per person)
- Accommodation in single room (extra 55€ per night, per person)

\* The ECHN Workshops are an initiative promoted by the European Creative Hubs Network to empower smaller creative hubs and to make use of their expertise for the broad ECHN community. Every year, the ECHN members nominate a workshop proposal that takes place in the chosen creative hub with the support of ECHN and is co-funded by the European Commission.

The ECHN Workshops put the spotlight on smaller or peripheral creative hubs in order to identify hidden basins of innovative practices and accelerate the sharing of knowledge among the members of the ECHN network and beyond.

# **About the Field Trip Visits:**

**Tremplin 01** If you haven't heard of Tremplin 01, this is a great opportunity to explore this project! Tremplin 01 is a social enterprise for textile sorting; they collect post consumer textile, sort and sell some in their second hand shops. Besides this, they also run a social restaurant in their premises!. Their goal? Zero textile waste for export by 2025. Currently, 100% of the textile collected in their space must be processed within a radius of 360 km, by reusing, recycling or any other form of recovery.

**Nouvelles Fibres Textiles** The aim of this visit is to understand how textile recycling works on an industrial scale, and the solutions for automating large-scale sorting of the materials and products produced.

**Fish leather Factory, Ictyos** Discover a project that has taken the crazy gamble of transforming a waste product from the agri-food industry - fish skins - into a luxury product, marine leather. The aim of this visit will be to find out how the 3 founders went about creating this micro factory from scratch and setting up a virtuous logistics system with the French agri-food industry.

# About the Museum Gadagne's Exhibition:

"From the 15th-century fairs where it all began to the industry of today, without forgetting the silk workshops of the "Grand Fabrique" from the 17th to the 19th century, this new exhibition at Lyon History Museum retraces Lyon's industrial exploits.

This history, in particular that of the silk workshops of the Fabrique, has had a profound impact, shaping the landscape of Lyon and leading to the emergence of a large working-class population. These developments have had a lasting impact on the city and its identity, right up to the present day.

Discover the techniques, skills, and daily life of the workers of the past. Lyon's industrial history is juxtaposed with the questions facing present-day work and industry. The exhibition is interspersed with numerous sound and video archives, objects from day-to-day working life, textiles, previously unseen contemporary photographic commissions, and major items from the collection (a drawloom, a Jacquard mechanism...)."
