Background

Scouts and parent communication are protected per BSA guidelines. Our internal site is

- powered by Google Sites and requires a Google Account
- protected by a Google Group

So in order to access our site, you must first

1. Create a google account if you don't have one already
2. Request to the communications chair (stephen_tsun@yahoo.com) to add you to the Google Group

Creating a Google Account

Follow this process below.

If you use gmail, stop. You already have a Google Account - your gmail address is the one.

If you use Aol, Hotmail, Yahoo mail, etc. then get a Google Account, but do not create a gmail account. Follow these steps:

1. Create an account [here](#). Where it asks you for your email, enter you current email - you don't need gmail for this.
2. Go to www.google.com and try to login to verify that it works.

Once you verified your email has a working GMail account, go to the next step.

Requesting to be added to the T453 Google Group

All our resources in Google are protected by one single Google Troop. Before accessing the site, you must be in this group. This group is unrelated to the T453 Yahoo Group. You must belong to both groups.

To get access:

- collect all the emails you need access (you, your son, your spouse, etc)
- send an email to the communications chair (stephen_tsun@yahoo.com), stating which patrol you belong to

Do not click on the group link to request access -- per BSA guidelines, we are not going to approve anyone who request access. So you need to properly identify yourself via an email to the communications chair first.
