### ABSTRACT

The Introduction should be written in Book Antiqua font, size 10 pt, using a single-column format with 1.15 line spacing and justified alignment. Section headings must be written in ALL CAPS AND BOLD. The Introduction generally comprises approximately 10–20% of the total manuscript length.

The flow of the Introduction should be structured using an inverted pyramid approach (starting with a broad explanation of the phenomenon and gradually narrowing down to the specific issue being addressed).

Mandatory Components of the Introduction:

1. Research Background: Explains the context, phenomenon, significance, and underlying motivation for the research.
2. Previous Studies / Related Research: Presents a concise review of relevant prior research. Avoid textbook-style explanations of basic theories or general definitions.



3. Research Gap Analysis: Identifies limitations, shortcomings, or unresolved issues in previous research.
4. State-of-the-Art: Presents the latest scientific developments, methodological trends, or cutting-edge approaches relevant to the topic.
5. Novelty and Contribution: Explains the originality and the theoretical or practical contributions that distinguish this manuscript from previous studies.
6. Research Objectives: Explicitly states the research objectives, problem statement, or research questions.

Citations in the Introduction must follow the APA Style (author-date system)—such as (Surname, Year) or (Surname, Year, p. X)—integrated with a reference manager (Mendeley, Zotero, or EndNote).

### **Recommended Structure for the Introduction**

Paragraphs 1–3 (Background & Context of the Phenomenon): Explain the general phenomenon, the context of the problem, and the significance of the topic being studied at both local and global levels.

Paragraphs 4–6 (Previous Studies & State-of-the-Art): Discuss relevant prior research findings, compare results, and outline the latest scholarly trends using APA Style citations.

Paragraph 7–8 (Research Gap): Highlight limitations, conflicting results, or unanswered questions left by previous studies.

Paragraph 9–10 (Novelty & Contribution): Present new ideas, a distinctive approach, and the academic and practical benefits of the research.

Single Reference List: All types of references—whether scholarly journals, textbooks, legislation, court rulings, proceedings, theses/dissertations, or web articles—must be combined into a single reference list. No Categorization: Authors are strictly prohibited from separating the bibliography into groups or sub-headings (e.g., separating entries into categories such as "Books," "Journals," and "Legislation").

Alphabetical Order: All references must be arranged sequentially in a single list from A to Z, based on the surname of the primary author or the name of the publishing institution/organization (if no individual author is listed).

Mandatory Use of Reference Manager: This formatting and compilation process must be performed automatically using a reference management application—such as Mendeley, Zotero, or EndNote—by selecting the APA 7th Edition style (American Psychological Association 7th edition).
