General Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Guidelines are contingent upon a state of Phase 4 in the Restore Illinois Plan• General information, including all pertinent screening procedures/required record keeping, can be found in the Guidance for Winter Season Athletics document• Participation in bowling centers is contingent on the regulations and guidelines of that bowling center, if these regulations and guidelines are more strict than the CPS guidelines.
Spectator Policy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• No spectators are allowed in bowling alleys for any/all practices or competitions. All present individuals must have a specific and necessary role/responsibility and the total number of individuals must be under the lesser of 50 people or 25% of the total capacity of the bowling alley.
Student Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Cloth Face Coverings or masks must be worn at all times in the bowling facility.• Student-athletes must adhere to the guidelines and procedures set by the bowling alley where participating• Every bowler should have a ball and shoes for their exclusive use. (Equipment can be rented from the bowling alley)• A maximum of 6 participants are allowed in the "pit" area representing a maximum of 2 schools. All participants must social distance at all times.• No personal equipment should be shared (towels, gloves, water bottles, etc.)• Bowling balls must be cleaned with isopropyl alcohol and towels• Students should wear their own appropriate bowling shirts. All equipment and clothing should be washed immediately upon returning home.• Hand washing and the use of hand sanitizer should be frequent at all contests and practices.• Athletes who are feeling ill should inform coaches immediately if they are not feeling well and leave the premises as soon as possible. <p>Eating and Drinking</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• No outside food or drinks (except bottled water) are allowed to be brought into the bowling facility. SNACK SHOPS are provided.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure 6 foot distance whenever athletes are eating or drinking.• Face covering MUST be worn except during the act of eating and/or drinking.• Athletes are not allowed to share food and/or drinks.
Competition Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Competition opponents are limited to CPS schools or intra-IDPH COVID EMS-Region 11 schools (city of Chicago) or out-of-region within 30 miles (no out-of-state travel is permitted).
