

HOPE RIGOR REQUIREMENT

- To qualify for the HOPE scholarship students must:
 - Have a 3.0 **HOPE** GPA (Calculated from core and Foreign Lang classes ONLY)
- AND**
- Take any **4** classes that meet the HOPE rigor requirement sometime before graduation.
- All classes listed below qualify as HOPE Rigor classes.

- Students should monitor this closely especially if using a CTAE course to meet the senior science requirement and/or not taking 2 years of foreign language. CTAE courses do not count as HOPE Rigor classes.
