

## **Ringer Tournament**

The purpose of a Ringer Tournament is to establish the best score over a period of time. A player does not have to play each scheduled date; she only has to establish a base line score. There is a \$5.00 entry fee for each ringer tournament, paid to the Club Treasurer.

There are two ringer tournaments each year, one on the Concord course and one on the Lexington course. The ringers are played on a calendar year basis running from January 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>.

The latest handicap information prior to the first play date is used. This handicap remains in effect throughout the tournament. Flights are established by handicaps based on the number of players.

Ringer cards are kept in the accordion file on the counter outside the restrooms near the pro shop. Each player is responsible for picking up and marking her ringer card following play on any day when individual scores by hole are kept. On the first day of eligible play for the new year, the player establishes a base line score. On subsequent days, only improved scores for each hole are marked. If a player picks up on any hole, that score cannot be used as a ringer score.

After completion of the tournament at the end of October, 1/2 of each player's handicap is subtracted from her best score to determine winners. At least 1/3 of the field will be paid.
