Stand Your Ground With Righteousness
The breastplate covered the full torso, protecting vital organs, especially the heart.
Our/thinking and/feelings are critical areas to stand against the enemy through putting on righteousness!
Paul teaches two forms of righteousness in Philippians 3: - Salvation/" righteousness" Philippians 3:9 - Sanctification/" righteousness" = the practical working out of imputed righteousness Philippians 3:12-14
"Imputed righteousness makes practical righteousness possible, but only obedience to the Lord make practical righteousness a reality!"
