2. Encourage, in keeping the policies of our government, the establishment of a concrete plan to secure permanent international peace and to assist in the maintenance of international peace.
3. Inspire in our membership a sense of responsibility and to develop leadership for the preservation of our American democratic way of life.
4. Help unify divergent groups in the overall interest of American democracy.
5. Train our youth to become purposeful citizens in a democracy with full knowledge of the responsibilities as well as the privileges of citizenship.
6. Cooperate with all duly recognized existing veterans organizations in the furtherance of the aims of the American veterans who have served or are serving in the Armed Forces of the United States during and since World War II.
7. Ensure the orderly return of veterans to civilian life by protecting their rights as individuals while still in uniform.

9. Act as a liaison agent between the veteran and the Government.
10. Provide an organization to encourage fellowship among all American veterans who have served or are serving in the Armed Forces of the United States during and since World War II.
11. Keep the public forever reminded that American veterans who have served or are serving in the

Armed Forces of the United States during and since World War II fought and served to preserve peace, liberty, and democracy of their Nation.
