

Priorities

1. ✓ Stabilize 3.3. Risky changes will be delayed until the stream of issues settles down.
2. ✓ Fix problems with Catalina. After 10.15 is out, new problems will be discovered. These need to be dealt with.
3. Core functionality improvements.
4. Nice-to-have new features

Core functionality

For the foreseeable future the highest priority is improving core functionality. In particular:

- Fixing long-standing deficiencies in existing systems.
- Add polish to new features added in 3.3.
- Improving throughput.
- Reducing latency.
- Reducing power usage.
- Catch up with Terminal.app where there are gaps.

Increase Throughput/Reduce Latency/Reduce Power+CPU Usage/Reduce Memory Usage

- It's impossible to select text when the scrollback buffer is full and you've scrolled up in to history. There is a race between changing the visible rect of the document and drawing it, during which time the model changes. The solution is related to the plan for improve concurrency: mutations happen on a copy of the model, off the main thread. The main thread's copy must not change between the time it scrolls and when it is redrawn.
