Vocabulary

1. obsessed - If you are obsessed with something, you think about it all the time.

My grandfather is obsessed with model trains.

2. disoriented - Creatures that are disoriented are confused about where they are.

The tourist was disoriented and needed to look at a map.

3. blunt - Something that is blunt is flat or rounded, rather than sharp.

The blunt pencil still needs to be sharpened.

4. recruiting - If you are recruiting people, you are asking them to help do something.

Akari began recruiting her friends to help collect canned goods for the food drive.

5. appointed - If you are appointed to a job, you are assigned to or chosen for it.

Kaito was appointed as the caretaker for the classroom plants.

6. stranded - If you are stranded, you are stuck somewhere without a way to leave.

Mom is stranded because her car broke down on her way to work.

7. estimate - If you give an estimate, you give an amount or size that is not exact.

Our teacher taught us that finding an estimate first can be a helpful step when solving a math problem.

8. decay - When things decay, they slowly break down and rot.

The apple looked like it was brown and starting to decay.
