
September minutes: Motion made by Susan, seconded by Myrna. to approve the September 2025 minutes. Unanimous approval.

Chair's Reports: Carolyn

BDC 2026 budget -- Thank you to Michele for being instrumental in maintaining the current \$12,000 budget allocation for 2026.

Shell hash path replanting --

- CF has moved plants in the king-tide flooded area. Consultation with Jim Chrulski indicates that saw palmetto may be the best plant for this wet area in future.
- Sedge Hammer application by Creative partially successful. Will wait until November for next treatment rather than apply RoundUp now, as the latter could affect new plants.
- Need volunteers to help with weeding to get rid of St. Augustine grass here. Mike, Myrna, and owner Phyllis have helped CF to weed. Will seek to entice additional weeding volunteers with, "If you feed them, they will come" approach, which Phyllis offered to help with. Dune plantings to replace wedelia: PowerPoint presented to the POA Board. Approved. Discussed best plants based on availability. Discussed schedule for ordering after November 1 so plants will arrive no sooner than November 15. This timeframe will give owner volunteers an opportunity to gather to prepare the planting sites ("feed them").

Nickerbean FL plant: Presenting as invasive on dune. Chris Willis will have the team apply herbicide to bring it under control. The plant is thick up and down A1A.

Sea oat seed harvesting: CF met with Carly Batts for harvesting sea oat seeds for commercial use. Batts, owner of "B the Change Natives," signed an <u>agreement</u> that, among other items, gives Ocean Village the first opportunity to purchase sea oats that her company cultivates.

Heavy equipment agreement: Holly confirmed that this agreement with CW Willis has been renewed for 2025-2026.

2026 annual beach cleanup: CF = coordinator. Black tee shirt color chosen. Same artwork as last year. Change amounts to 15 small and 5 2XL. Will incur about \$20 shipping charge, as our OV rep is in the hospital. Decided to distribute tee shirts the day of the event *after* participants come back to the Community Center and show the litter they picked up, which will also allow for weigh-ins.
