Vulcan/Human physiology:

- +2 Physique (Strength, Endurance, Durability to heat and radiation)
 - +1 modifier to any check where strength is key. (+1 damage on attack/+1 to skill if not doing damage)
 - Extra eyelid: Bright lights, flashes, and sand have no effect on you.
- -2 Physique to cold.

Vulcan Rage:

If a vulcan ever loses his temper (examples: if provoked into a fight or loses a mental contest) the player gets a fate point from the GM and goes under the control of the GM for the remainder of the Scene. During this time his stats are modified to:

- +4 Physique. +2 modifier to any check where strength is key.
- If this happens in public, the character gets a Severe Social consequence of "Raging Vulcan".

<u>The Humanity Factor</u>: Whenever you tie in a personal social contest with a member of another race, without spending any fate points, you may treat the results as if you had rolled one point higher.
