



## **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **What do I need to do to become a tutor with Literacy Delaware?**

Complete an application (link to app)

Provide 2 references

Complete the background check through the invitation link we will provide

Complete tutor orientation and training via zoom

### **How many hours a week do we meet with our adult learner?**

1 to 4 hours per week.

### **How long will I tutor my learner?**

We ask for a 1-year commitment.

### **Where do we meet our learner?**

Either online or in a public place like a library or coffee shop.

### **Does Literacy Delaware provide teaching resources?**

Yes, we provide lessons to get you started until the books for your learners arrive. We also provide quite a lot of resources on our intranet to supplement all your lessons.

### **Will there be support available once I complete the training?**

Yes! We have mentors available to help get started and our staff is available for any questions you may have.

### **Are there other volunteer opportunities available if tutoring isn't for me?**
