The Vikings traveled to Kettle Moraine to compete in the Thanksgiving Classic. Waunakee had strong control of the game, using efficient shooting and dominant rebounding to secure a 66–48 win over Wisconsin Lutheran. The Warriors set the tone early, but the Vikings did stay in it, trailing by only 7 going into halftime (32–25.) Waunakee came out strong to start the second half, pulling away in the second half with a 34-point offensive burst.

Wisco Highlights

Despite moments of energy, the Vikings were unable to overcome the shooting droughts or the rebounding deficit. Still leading the way for Wisco were:

- **Londyn Hollins** led the team with 13 points, knocking down 3 threes and going 2-for-2 at the line.
- Kaelyn Nommensen added 8 points and a team-high 9 rebounds, providing inside presence.
- Layla Walz contributed 8 points, including two makes from beyond the arc.
- Morgan Martinez was productive with 5 points, 4 rebounds, and 4 assists.

Key Differences in the Game

- Waunakee shot 51% from the field, including 8 made threes, and held a decisive 39–25 rebounding advantage.
- Defensively, Waunakee forced 18 turnovers, which helped fuel transition scoring and prevent Wisconsin Lutheran from finding an offensive rhythm.
