



Isolation/symptomatic Saliva Test

Please complete the following steps for collecting a saliva sample from your child presenting with COVID-19 symptoms

STEP 1: Pick up your child and saliva collection kit from school

NOTE: Sample may be collected at SCHOOL when picking up your child or at home and then returning the sample to school the day after before 11:00 am for processing

- When you are ready to collect the sample, have your child drink a glass of water and wait 60 minutes
- Ensure that 30 minutes before collecting sample, they must NOT eat or drink anything

STEP 2: Prepare the label on the container from saliva kit

Please write on the saliva container label the following information:

- Child's name
- Child's date of birth

If you can't write the above information on the container label, fill in the blank sticky label in the bag and stick it to your tube.

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STEP 3: Collect the sample

- You are now ready to collect the sample. Please carefully read and **follow the instructions** included in the kit
- Collect sample
- Please ensure lid is placed on tightly once finished

Please complete and review information on registration form to ensure that everything is complete and legible

Once completed, it is very important to return the registration form with the sample

STEP 4: Options for processing:

Option 1: Leave sample at school with the school staff if you have collected it at school

Option 2: Return sample to school if you have done home collection

- Please return the sample to the school by 1200 pm (noon) the day after so it can be picked up and processed by Women's College Hospital.

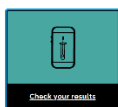
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RESULTS FOR COVID19 TESTING
