- Avatar released in 2009 and quickly became the highest grossing of all time
- Avatar 2: The Way Of Water is set to release on December 16th, 2022
- Avatar 3: The Seed Bearer is set to release on December 20th, 2024
- Avatar 4: The Tulkun Rider is set to release on December 18th, 2026
- Avatar 5: The Quest For Eywa is set to release on December 22nd, 2028
- Each sequel will play out as a standalone movie, and each story will come to its own conclusion.
- The title for Avatar 2 was confirmed by director James Cameron 3 days ago, the rest of the titles can still change, however.

- For context, the second film was delayed about 7 times over the span of 8 years and was originally supposed to come out in 2014.
- Disney, which inherited the franchise after acquiring 20th Century Fox in 2019, unveiled new footage of the highly anticipated film at CinemaCon, the annual gathering of movie theater owners that's currently unfolding at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas.
- These films are all coming to theaters and will later show up on Disney+ as well.
