


Strip Square Baby Quilt

39 X 39



You will need:

- Fabric strips from leftover projects
- 18 " fabric for the sashing and border

Use up your scraps and sew strips of fabric together, cut into 10.5" squares.

Cut 5 sashing strips 2" wide x WOF

Cut 2 strips 33.5 long, cut 6 10.5 sashing strips

Sew by rows with a 10.5" sashing strip on each side of the middle block. Sew to both outside blocks to form rows.

Sew rows to long sashing strips, join

rows.

Cut 4 border strips 3.5" x WOF

Trim 2 to 33.5" Sew these strips to opposite sides of quilt top.

The other 2 strips need to be 39.5". Sew on to other sides of quilt and Ta Da!

*** I am not a professional quilter or pattern maker. I am happy to share these simple patterns. I do not go into detail, I am assuming some basic quilting knowledge. All of the WOF strips are assuming you are using 40-42 inch wide fabric. I apologize for any mistakes I may have made.
