

Cheers & Sips



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Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Cheers & Sips (165588)
- Cardstock and Paper: Thick Basic White (159229); Basic White (166780); Strawberry Slush (165625); Celebratory Sips 12"x12" Designer Series Paper (165586)
- Stampin' Ink: Strawberry Slush (165286); Timid Tiger (165278)
- Miscellaneous: Spotlight on Nature (163580); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Bone Folder (102300); Paper Snips (103579); Optional: 2025-20247 In Color Flat Pearls (165192)

Measurements:

- Thick Basic White Cardstock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4", folded and burnished with the Bone Folder
- Strawberry Slush Cardstock: large scrap
- Regular Basic White Cardstock: medium scrap
- Designer Series Paper: flowered design – 1 1/2" x 5 1/2", diagonal design – 2 pieces 1/2" x 5 1/2", two images cut out from large cocktails piece, 1 sprig cut from one of the edge images

Instructions:

1. Adhere the diagonal Timid Tiger DSP pieces to the top and bottom back of the flowered piece of DSP with liquid glue. Glue that entire piece to the front of the card, placing it below centre.

2. Cut out with the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine and the Spotlight on Nature Dies: one large circle (3 1/4") in Strawberry Slush and one smaller circle (2 3/4") in Basic White. Glue together then position to the left of the card and adhere in place.
3. Ink the 'Cheers" with Strawberry slush and stamp to the right of the circles. Ink the "to you!" with Timid Tiger and stamp below it.
4. Cut out your choice of two cocktails from the piece of DSP with the larger images. (I chose one taller and one more squat glasses for balance and variety.)
5. Find one of the images on the edge of the DSP and cut one green sprig.
6. Add the taller drink image to the left side of the circle with Stampin' Dimensionals. Add two Stampin' Dimensionals to the right side (back) of the smaller cocktail, then add a dab of liquid glue to the back bottom left. Adhere to the circle so the drinks overlap.
7. Glue the sprig to the taller drink.
8. Optional: Add Flat Pearls if desired. (Note: as the flowered paper is a bit "busy", I chose to leave off the pearls.)
