School Accountability Meeting #1 - September 30 via Zoom @5pm

The TRCS School Accountability Committee (SAC) would love your support in our first SAC meeting of the year. SAC's are important organizations within each public school in Colorado that are statutorily required to provide feedback and support for schools. Besides being a requirement, it's actually a great chance for parents to be involved in the school and help guide us in the right direction. The SAC will provide inputs on a range of topics including:

- The school's Unified Improvement Plan (UIP) - the plan to address learning gaps and improve schoolwide instruction and student outcomes
- Spending priorities recommendations for the annual budget - SAC members are the first group involved in helping develop the budget for the coming school year
- Evaluating the Head of School and determining if school strategies are impeding or advancing the school's goals.
- Working to enhance parent engagement across the school
- Working to solve attendance challenges across the school (generally, not individually student or family specific).

8th Grade Mexico Trip - Initial Meeting Oct. 2 6pm via Zoom- ACTION REQUIRED for ALL 8th Grade Families

Every year, TRCS sends its 8th grade class on an incredible adventure to Baja California, Mexico. Our students immerse themselves in culture, practice their language skills, surf in the Pacific, and snorkel with sea lions in the Sea of Cortez. It is the ultimate culminating field study for TRCS students! The vast majority of this trip is subsidized by the TRCS community through fundraisers that will require significant support from all families, but especially our 8th grade families.

This year, due to the rising costs of flights and expenses for every component of the trip, the individual cost for students will be \$700. While this is certainly a lot of money, it is significantly less than comparable trips offered by other schools in the area. This price includes all activities on the trip and nearly every meal. Families will have the choice of paying all of the money in one payment by November 1st or choosing a payment plan of \$100/month from October through April. Please note, once you commit to the trip, any payments made are non-refundable and parents will be expected to pay the full \$700, even if the family decides at a later date that the student will not be attending as the airplane tickets are also non-refundable.

Please take a few minutes to complete this initial “trip commitment” form so that we can move forward with the planning process. This is required for ALL families.

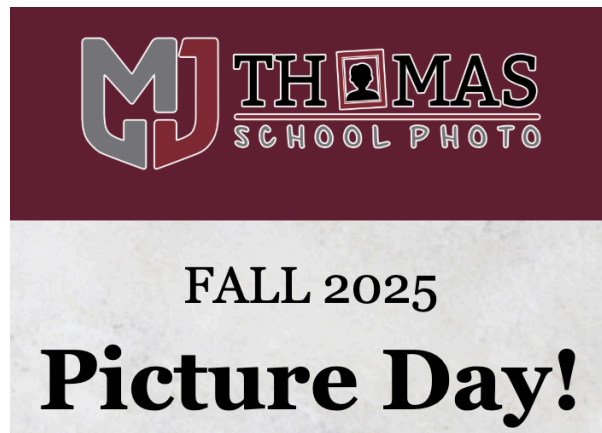

Middle and high school students across Colorado will participate in the Healthy Kids Colorado Survey (HKCS) this fall. The HKCS is Colorado's most comprehensive survey on youth health and wellness. Every two years, more than 100,000 students take part in the voluntary and anonymous survey. The results are used to inform programs and policies that help youth thrive.

Parents will receive a consent form from RFSD in the coming days. All students will be automatically "opted in" to completing the survey but any parent who wishes for their child to opt out, can do so using this form:
