Steps:

1. Restate the question & Answer (Claim)- Red
2. Cite Evidence/Quote from text/ CITE- ".....", (Author's last name, page #).-Blue
3. Explain/Reasoning/Elaboration (2 sentences)--- Use sentence starters- Green
4. Sum it Up/Closing sentence---use sentence starters- Yellow
