### 3. Principal's report

- **Fundraisers:** 40th Anniversary Dinner and dance made \$270 put in towards field trips/carnival
  - 800 printed, 170 tickets left to go out to sell ( if all sold)
- **Microsoft Grant:** Andrea worked with Tom Manning (tech NLSchools) to do up an order for Mona to put in tomorrow; \$19 690.19  
4 Teacher/Staff laptops (Mona and 3 sub ones), 6 docking stations, 1 desktop (janitor's room), 10 student laptops (LRC), 5 projectors and 125 wired headphones (class sets).
- **Grants:**
  - Andrea is going to apply for an Active NL Fund Grant through the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador, Department of Tourism, Culture, Arts and Recreation for the basketball court area once she receives approval from facilities.
  - The last School Lunch Taste Test day for the Wellness Coalition Grant is tomorrow. Andrea will put in the receipts to receive a refund for money spent tomorrow.
  - The paint has been ordered from Home Hardware from the Safe, Caring and Inclusive Schools Special Initiatives Grant. Hopefully we will get our "Empowerment Walkway" started soon. The weather has not been cooperating.
  - Arts Smarts report will be finalized tomorrow.
- **Playground:** Tender is out online. It closes June 19, 2024. The playground is to be completed by August 31, 2024.
- **40th Anniversary Dinner and dance:**
  - It went extremely despite the turn out.
- **ArtsSmarts:**
  - Still waiting on approval of the proposal from facilities to get permission to put the mural on the wall of the school. Andrea called again today.

- **School Development -**
  - Fourth is this Tuesday, June 11 Rise and Shine! PJs and Breakfast Time!
  - Complete it this week and upload to drive to share with Kirk Smith and Patricia Emberly.
- **Spring Concert:** Made \$1 900 with tickets sales, door sales and so on. This money will be used to offset the cost of students' field trips and carnival.
- **Carnival:**
  - Our Carnival date is Wednesday, June 19.
  - Sky High Amusements - 2 Huge Bouncy Castles, Sno-cones, Cotton Candy, Popcorn, Carnival Tent and three workers(\$1 495.75). This includes the workers. We will give the children tickets so that food is not unlimited.
  - Frontline Action - Face painting, Balloon Twisting and Dunk Tank (\$1 383.45).
  - The total for rental equipment or activities and travel is \$2 879.20.
  - Including the Spring Concert, Recreation Committee and if all tickets are sold, we will have \$3 050. That allows a little extra for hotdogs, buns and drinks.
  - The RCMP and BGC are going to do loot bags.
  - We were hoping to have the Teen Mentors but the high school ended up scheduling an activity on that day as well so hopefully we still get a couple and some adult volunteers and non homeroom staff.
  - Joey, Jenna and Jordon are coming to help.
  - Andrea will get some costumes from Tourism and Marty the Miner will be attending.

  - These are the only awards given out on this day because it is meant to be an extra special award day for these recognitions and for Lydia's retirement.
- **Retirement:**
  - We will celebrate Lydia on June 17th at the awards as this is also a huge accomplishment and

important milestone.
