### Criteria for National Poetry Month Poster:

0=missing; 1=included; 2=good; 3=visually impressive

**Include title wording: *National Poetry Month - April 2015* (0 - 1 - 2 - 3)**

- Vivid Lettering (0 - 1 - 2)
- Correct Spelling / Capitalization (0 - 1 - 2)

**Include a theme subtitle (0 - 1 - 2 - 3)**

Examples - Poetry Zoo; Scientific Poetry; Stages of Life Poetry; Athletic Poetry; Youthful Musings; Poetic Places; Poetry Garden; Patchwork Poetry; Planetary Poetry; School Days Poetry; Springtime Poetry; Creepy Crawly Poems.

- Vivid Lettering (0 - 1 - 2)
- Correct Spelling / Capitalization (0 - 1 - 2)

**Include 6 to 8 poems that you have written using at least four different poetry forms (free verse; concrete; rhyme scheme stanzas; limerick; sonnet; haiku; diamante; ballad; ode; acrostic, etc.). (0 - 1 - 2 - 3)**

- 6 to 8 original poems (0 - 1 - 2)
- titles on all poems (0 - 1 - 2)
- vivid lettering (0 - 1 - 2)
- minimum of 60 lines of poetry in total (0 - 1 - 2) (0 - 1 - 2) (0 - 1 - 2)

- at least four different poetry forms (0 - 1 - 2)
