What is the WEMTA PubPD?

The WEMTA PubPD is a one-day face-to-face and virtual meetup for educators, administrators, librarians, and any other interested community members across Wisconsin... and beyond! Anyone interested in hosting can sign up to have a face-to-face meeting at a local establishment on **Tuesday, November 12th at 6:00 PM CST** (4 PM Pacific, 7 Eastern), and everyone is welcome to join the hosts at the posted sites! During the face-to-face meeting, WEMTA will host a virtual meetup via Twitter for face-to-face gatherings to join live or use as a discussion point for their site-based conversations.

Where will these face-to-face locations be?

As the name implies, a great starting point would be a local pub! Many places have private areas for groups to gather for free - bonus points if they can lend a screen, projector, or other audio/visual aid to use to project a PC for the virtual chat. If you cannot get a screen, that's okay! Participants can keep an eye on the chat via their phones, or focus on the face-to-face conversation instead.

If you cannot find a pub, feel free to host a site at a coffee shop, restaurant, school, or other willing location. Be creative!
