Oil Paint:

Titanium white
Yellow Ochre
Cadmium Red Deep
Ivory Black

Any brand such as *Gamblin*, *Winsor & Newton*, *Michael Harding*, *Old Holland*, etc., will work as long as they're not student grade.

Brushes: an assortment of medium, and small sized filberts, flats or brights. The Utrecht Manglon's are an affordable option. For the filberts I would get a few sized 2,4,6,8,10 and brights 2,4,8,12 <https://www.dickblick.com/products/utrecht-manglon-synthetic-brushes/>

Palette Knife: I recommend a trowel shaped knife, with a blade length of approximately 2-1/2" <https://www.jerrysartarama.com/creative-mark-painters-edge-knives> - 'Painting knife 7T, trowel'
