# Color Coordination: Sith Lodge Jedi Warlord Alliance Independent

#### **34 ABY**

- The Hosnian Cataclysm is perpetrated by the First Order, resulting in the destruction of the New Republic's governing body and what remained of its fleet.
- Supreme Leader Snoke is assassinated by Kylo Ren and the Supremacy is unexpectedly destroyed, followed by the Battle of Crait.

### **35 ABY**

- Much like Hosnian Prime and Alderaan before it, the planet of Kijimi is utterly destroyed.
- The Battle of Exegol soon followed. Resistance fighters were joined by the Allied fleet, resulting in the obliteration of the Sith Eternal and the final destruction of Darth Sidious.
   The First Order's rule over the galaxy began to rapidly decline as a result. A Provisional Galactic Government is formed after the fall of

## **36 ABY**

- Rey founds the New Jedi Order on the old temple on Ossus. The leaders of the Tion Cluster and the Resistance's supporters supply the Jedi Order with repairs, supplies, and ships in exchange for aiding in protection from evermore-present Hutt and criminal threats. Rey's first class was made up of 12 Force sensitives from throughout the galaxy.

### **37 ABY**

The Carida Authority is founded by old FO leadership and their first act is to take over the Kuat shipyards. They invade Kuat space and face opposition by the local Kuati leadership and citizenry. The Kuat are victorious in defending their home world and the Authority is pushed back. The Kuati declare themselves a sovereign System and begin building up a navy for defence, vowing revenge on the Carida Authority

### **39 ABY**

 Under the combined leadership of several of the Corell system's industry leaders and moguls, the Corellian Sovereignty is formed in response to the myriad of warlords and First Order remnants sowing chaos in and around the Core.

#### **41 ABY**

- The Atrisian Commonwealth rises once more led by Emperor Xiangshin and begins to build up a small force.
- Rey's first class of Jedi are made Knights and they begin to look for more recruits and begin protecting the galaxy. Some move to the Core to help combat the warlords, while others stay in the Outer Rim to combat the crimelords of the Rim
- Resistance, Allied fleet veterans, and several politicians begin to form a loose defensive and trading pact to protect themselves from growing concerns of fighting in the Core and unprecedented levels of criminal activity throughout unmonitored space in the wake of any real galactic authority.

- Alsakani nobles form the Alsakani Empire after invading Coruscant and neighbouring star systems. Creating a large powerbase in the core to challenge other rising warlords. Individuals loyal to the Resistance and Allied Fleet flee to the Outer Rim to avoid the fighting. Many refugees also follow, not wanting to be victims of a new war.

#### **51 ABY**

- In response to the Core's sudden interest in them, the Alliance of Free Systems is officially formed in the Outer and Mid Rim.
- **The Core Skirmishes** begins with the Empire, Authority and Kuat scrambling to gain control over the core worlds.

## 55 ABY

 The Jedi, now well-known throughout the galaxy, begin to take responsibility as the peacekeepers of the galaxy and reaffirm their position of solidarity with the Alliance of Free Systems.

#### **63 ABY**

Alsakani Imperials and Carida Authority forces clash in one of the biggest confrontations
of recent years. The fleets fought for nearly 3 days between the 28 moons of the planet
Ralltiir. In the end Carida won with a decisive victory.

## 70 ABY

- To respond to claims of their power waning and the Alliance of Free Systems encroaching too close to their territory, the Hutts start to make bolder shows of power and control, which caused many fringe worlds in Hutt Space seek to leave and join the Alliance. **The Hutt/Alliance War** begins when the Hutts attack Bimmisaari and move to other Alliance planets. A lack of solidarity in the senate and military lead to many losses, but a member of the Bothan Defense Force declares himself Supreme Commander of the Alliance Military and leads the united forces in retaking territory. The Jed join the Alliance Defense Forces in combating the Hutts.

### **74 ABY**

The Hutt/Alliance War ends with the Hutts surrendering and many worlds in northern Hutt Space, like Nimban, Klatooine, and Tal Nami among others, joining the Alliance. As part of the surrender the Hutts promise to stop antagonizing the Alliance and Neutral Worlds so long as they cease any future attacks. Many of the more radical members of the senate request that the Supreme Commander stand down, but it is agreed that in times of war the Supreme Commander would have complete control of the military and in times of peace he serves as an administrator and representative of the military in the Senate and Alliance Council.

- The Atrisian Commonwealth invade Fondor space in order to take her shipyards. Fondor fights back ferociously, fighting off the commonwealth.
- Fondor declares their stateship, and many planets nearby freely join, fearful of the Atrisian's. This includes Abregado-Rae. Creating the Unitary Systems of Fondor

During a diplomatic meeting with Bakura and the Pacanth Reach, forces from the Unknown Regions attacked the summit. The two group's armies and Alliance Defense Forces from Riflor held them off for a month until the Supreme Commander arrived with a small fleet capable of ending the conflict. The Pacanth Reach, Bakura Modell Sector, and other nearby worlds would then join the Alliance.

## 95 ABY

Peace Officially Declared Between the Empire, Authority and Kuat after nearly 44 years
of constant fighting the three warring parties agree to a tentative peace to lick their
wounds. And expand/rebuild their territories

### 112 ABY

- The Duros sector, wary of their precarious position between all of the constant warfare, agree to join the Corellian Sovereignty

### 120 ABY

 Denon begins to build a small planetary defence force, fearing the threat of the growing USF.

### 130 ABY

On the planet Abhean, the Jedi's new praxeum ship, *Dulon*, produced. The Jedi use the ship to be more active in their peacekeeping and it takes them as far as parts of the inner rim. Eventually the scores of Jedi, new and old, fill the ship and it becomes as populated as the Ossus Temple. With the Jedi traveling more, multiple Jedi chapter houses are established on various Alliance and neutral worlds.

### 145 ABY

 Over the past 50 years the warlord states have begun to build up their fleets and strengthen their claims. Other parts of the Empire start to secede and rebel against the large territory.

## 146 ABY

Kuat and the Authority jump on this opportunity and try to invade many of the rebelling and seceding systems, battling it out with tyrant forces, beginning a new string of Conflicts in the core. The Authority begins it's campaign of propaganda claiming that Alsakan is filled with extreme anti-alien policies.

Fondor reaches Corellia and is surprised to find they have a sizable defence force made up of a fleet of notoriously-fast ZD-9300 Corellian-class Star Destroyers. The battle is long and ferocious but Corellia succeeds in its defense against the Fondorian aggressors.

#### 168 ABY

 Denon fears for its safety after the Fondor attack on Corellia and their government forms the Cerulean Guard, a defense force funded in-part by their Corellian neighbors with the intention of bolstering defenses along the Corellian Run.

### 169 ABY

- The War was brutal, and the conflict left deep scars, but at the end of the 23 year turmoil a great battle over Chandrila saw the Kuat, Authority and Empire forces fighting until the Empror himself was assassinated by the Authority. The fleets were all but destroyed and the factions returned home to lick their wounds.
- The Atrisian Commonwealth gains a new Emperor who continues the hunt for worlds in the unknown regions, but also uses resources found from dead worlds to finish construction on large Shipyards and droid factories to bolster their forces.

#### 170 ABY

 Denon's fears are realised when the armada of Fondor reaches Sagar. The Cerulean Guard and Corellian Privateers fight back the Armada, and hold back the onslaught of Fondor's might.

### 172 ABY

 The Empire is then split in a horrible civil war where the leadership begin to battle over who will lead the Empire.

## 175 ABY

The Alsakani civil war ends with the establishment of a new hierarchy of Alsakani nobles. The new leadership denounced the other core worlds and vows revenge.

#### 180 ABY

 Atrisian-Fondor War With a newly strengthened military the Atrisian Commonwealth launch a full scale invasion of Fondor. The Invasion is successful and many ensuing battles happen, pushing their way towards the Fondor homeworld.

## 186 ABY

- Unexpectedly, the Cerulean Guard overthrow the Denon government and declare themselves an Empire
- With Denon's government in shambles and unable to reach agreements with the new leadership of the Cerulean Guard, the Corellian Sovereignty cuts all ties with the

Cerulean Guard, ceasing further starship manufacturing and maintenance agreements and issuing sanctions against the newly-formed "Empire."

#### 187 ABY

The Cerulean guards launch an attack on Corellia in an all out attempt to take the shipyards there. But the Corellians were prepared, and successfully stave off yet another foreign attempt of conquest. The Cerulean Guard retreats from the Corell system while they still have space-worthy vessels intact.

#### 198 ABY

 18 years of constant skirmishes with no real major conflicts leave both factions breathless and they declare yet another peace with one another, the Fondor and Atrisian conflict ends.

#### 200 ABY

 Abregado-Rae starts an uprising on their homeworld, to defend their ruined planet from Fondor and Atrisian wars. They quickly gain support from other war torn worlds in the sector. Claiming themselves the Rae Coalition

## 214 ABY

The Carida insurgents have been convincing the new noble house of Kuat on Rasterous to secede from Kuat for years, telling them that they could become independent or even rule Kuat with their help. An uprising occurs, with Carida backing the insurgents. Starting the **Kuat Civil War**.

## 229 ABY

In an attempt to muscle in on the bounty organization, a small group of Bounty Hunters form their own guild known as the Hunter's Lodge. Under the leadership of Mayla Orran, The Lodge quickly gained notoriety for their efficiency and rate of success much to the ire of other bounty guilds.

### 231 ABY

The Kuat Civil war lasted 10 years, but in the end Rasterous and Carida combined are too much for the Kuat, and they try to sue for peace. But Carida is out for blood. As they attacked into the Kuat homeworlds, the Rasterous Insurgents turned on Carida attacking them as well and for the next 7 years the Carida Authority and the newly founded Rasterian Despotism battle it out, before they call a stalemate.

#### 233 ABY

 The other top bounty guilds jealousy reaches a boiling point as more and more bounties are given to the Lodge. They agree to band together and put an end to the upstart organization.

Two years of skirmishes reaches a climax when the Lodge's Huntmaster is mortally wounded by a stray projectile in a firefight. In her dying breath, Mayla Orran gives her helmet to one of her trusted champions who dons the title of Huntmaster and begins a devastating crusade against the rival guilds and beginning the legend of the immortal Huntmaster.

#### 236 ABY

 With the Crusade over, the Hunter's Lodge secures its place at the top. Led by the new Huntmaster, who forgoes their name to continue the legacy of Mayla's original leadership.

### 241 ABY

- Kuat and Fondor engage in a small skirmish that builds into a massive battle in the Karvoss system between huge warships. Fondor ends up winning the engagement in a stroke of luck against the better equipped Kuat. Where they were able to take out the Kuat Capital ship in a last ditch attempt. With their leadership gone Kuat routed.

## 249 ABY

 A group of Dark Side cultists, known as the Ascendants, gain influence on the planet Empress Teta and the other deep core worlds along the Byss Run.

# 250 ABY

Influenced by the outspoken Jedi Master Dumenaris Payne, a handful of Jedi Masters and Knights begin to express the belief that they should be free and encouraged to study all aspects of the Force, beginning the first pivot away from the Order's traditions established by the Skywalker Legacy left behind by Rey two centuries prior.

## 258 ABY

 Dissatisfied with perceived stagnation of the Order, Jedi Master Dumenaris Payne storms out of the Jedi Temple after a vehement disagreement with the High Council, discarding his rank of Master and denouncing the Jedi Order. He returns to his homeworld of Corellia and ignores further summons and attempts at contact from the Jedi Order.

## **260 ABY**

 Leadership of the Lodge transfers to the next Huntmaster who dons Mayla's helmet, and much like the former, they forgo their name to keep the legend. This new Huntmaster puts a focus on recruitment, examining skilled bounty hunters across the galaxy and growing their numbers.

 The Huntmaster makes the decision to switch to a more mobile base of operations, spending a hefty amount of credits to purchase and outfit a cruiser. The Lodge becomes mobile and begins roaming the stars.

### 281 ABY

A small group of Fondor breakaways form the Milagro Stratocracy. The nation captured
multiple Mid Rim worlds in an attempt to ready themselves for conflict with Fondor and
the Alliance. Alliance Commodore Maippo aided the planet Kabray in defending against
the invaders. The battle was the start of the Alliance's first military campaign in many
years.

## 283 ABY

- The Milagro Campaign came to a close after the Milagro forces were finally defeated at Krann. After winning the battle at Krann, Maippo was promoted to Admiral.

### 285 ABY

Maskar Kython secretly falls to the Dark Side

## 288 ABY

 A Rebellion group backed by the Alliance begins to fight in the underworld of Coruscant against Alsakani occupation. It is brutally squashed by Alsakani forces.

## 290 ABY

The Lodge's focus on recruitment has begun to dilute its reputation for efficiency.

### 293 ABY

 Many other rebellions begin to spring up across warlord space. This is nothing new, but this is the first time where the Alliance is backing many of the uprisings. Trying to free the core from the tyranny of the warlords.

# **295 ABY**

- Maskar Kython's Jedi Enlightenment reaches the peak of its popularity within the order.
- A group of traditionalist Jedi Masters attempt to arrest Maskar Kython; Maskar dies resisting the attempt.
- The Second Jedi Civil War begins; instigated by Maskar's death, the followers of the Jedi Enlightenment strike out violently against their peers in the First Battle of Ossus. Though a stalemate, the Dark Jedi flee, dispersing into the nearby systems to continue the fight. The Jedi Council alerts the Alliance Senate that the Jedi Enlightenment is a group of rogue Dark Jedi and warns them of possible danger.
- Not long after, fighting breaks out aboard the *Dolun* between the traditional Jedi and the
  Jedi Enlightenment supporters. The traditionalists were warned of an attack by the
  Ossus and drove the Dark Jedi off the ship when they attempted to mutiny.

- A group of Dark Jedi attack the Jedi chapterhouse on Columex and fortify it after killing the Jedi present and request any Force-sensitive on the planet come to them for immediate training. A strike team of Jedi are sent force them off the planet. The survivors are followed to Centares where the Jedi are victorious in wiping them out. Similar engagements continue for the next few years.

#### **297 ABY**

- The second battle of Ossus occurs, and though casualties are high on both sides, the Dark Jedi are defeated, forcing them to disperse further. Many follow in the footsteps of Maskar Kython's apprentice Thella Grall, who fled to the Core worlds after her master's death. Though many simply integrated themselves into the existing hierarchies of the warlord states, some, like Thella, carved out their own empires.
- Alsakan-Kuat War Having installed herself as the ruler of Kuat, Thella Grall breaks the longstanding pattern of Kuati inaction and invades Alsakan Space. Though outgunned and outnumbered, the Alsakans are able to hold the Kuatis back for a time thanks in large part to poor hyperlane access.

#### 298 ABY

- After a long reign as the Huntmaster, the helmet is passed on to its newest leader. The newest leader desires to put a focus on returning the Lodge to its status as the top guild in the galaxy. More rigorous recruitment tasks to ensure only the best are included in the ranks of the Lodge. A controversial ranking system is introduced to separate hunter's by their skill level. Those at higher ranks earn greater benefits from the Lodge, providing hunters a competition and motivation to improve their skills.

### 299 ABY

 The Rae Coalition declares war on Fondor. The coalition have been building up their own military the past hundred years, beginning the Rae-Fondor War.

## **300 ABY**

- After attempting to change certain policies of the Carida Authority, Warlord Arthur Xandran is assassinated in a coup that fractures the Carida Authority into two factions, the Castell Authority and the Yabol Dissension. Other parts of Authority territory, including Carida itself, fall into the hands of Kuat and Alsakan.
- In a shocking move, the Cerulean Guard moves southward and conquers the world Chaardan. The Guard strike fear in the populace and nearby systems by crucifying and executing many citizens and officials.
- The Jedi begin sending agents into the Core to directly deal with the Dark Jedi in league with the Warlords.

#### 300.1 ABY

Argus attempts to assassinate Thella Grall, but the resulting battle kills Thella, Argus,
 Marie, and all of the other Dark Jedi. Kuat fractures and loses almost all the power it

- once held. Commenor, Demophon, Neimoidia, Balmorra, Humbraine, and Mawan have all begun to build up their forces to defend themselves.
- Emboldened by their conquest of Chaardan, the Cerulean Guard conquer Osarian with the help of the neighboring Rhommamool who willingly joined the Cerulean Guard.

## 300.2 ABY

- The Rasterous Despotism grows bold after the fall of Kuat and begins to move towards conquering worlds close to the Alliance, including Umbara, and moving towards the Galactic North.
- Caridan Loyalists joined the Cerulean Guard and aided in conquering Kuat.
