There was an explosion on a bus in Voronezh. Sixteen people were injured and one more was killed.

One of the first versions of the tragedy was the explosion of gas cylinders. Later, it was denied. According to deputy head of the city Department of Transport Maksim Zakharov, the bus was running on diesel fuel. The explosion occurred when the bus was at a bus stop and people were getting on. Employees of the Federal Security Service are working at the site. A group of forensic specialists left Moscow for Voronezh.
