

VILLAGE OF CRESTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-32

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO RESIDE OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised Code provides, “the Fiscal Officer shall become a resident of the Village within six months after the appointment takes effect, unless an Ordinance is passed approving the Fiscal Officer’s residence outside of the Village” and;

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer is not an employee whose immediate presence is required in response to emergencies or disasters that may occur in the Village and;

WHEREAS, the Village Council wishes to eliminate the residency requirement for the current Fiscal Officer.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. That Council hereby finds and determinates that it is unnecessary and provides no benefit to the Village that requires the current Fiscal Officer to be a resident of the Village of Creston.
2. That pursuant to ORC 733.262, Council Hereby approves the current Fiscal Officer, Jennifer Webb.
3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
4. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Creston and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency is allow the Fiscal Officer to reside outside of the Village and comply with Ohio law. Therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
