

Canaan's Nursery Room Guidelines:

Nursery Room (room 103) welcomes children from age 4 months to 36 months and is staffed with 2 babysitters from 10am to 12:30pm.

Check In/Out Procedures:

1. Complete the sign in sheet and be sure to leave a cell number.
2. Leave a diaper bag with diapers (if not potty trained) and drink bottle – be sure to mark all items with your child's name.
3. Inform staff of any special instructions regarding your child.
4. Upon pick up – please complete the sign out sheet with pick up time.

Food Policies:

- Inform staff if your child has any food restrictions. Snacks (cheerios, raisins, or goldfish) will be served to children marked ok to serve to by parents. If you do not want your child to eat the church snacks, please provide a home snack for your child to eat. Be sure to label the snack bag/container with your child's full name.
- Please provide a bottle of water for your child. Solid baby foods will not be fed to babies.

Crying Policy:

- Staff will do their best to distract and comfort a crying child, but parents will be called if a child is still inconsolable after 10 minutes.

Health/Safety Policies:

- Staff are fully COVID vaccinated and have received booster shots. Wearing face masks is optional in the nursery room.
- For the health and safety of all children and staff, anyone who have had any of the following symptoms in the last 24 hours should not enter this room:
 - A known or suspected infectious illness
 - Fever of 100 or higher
 - Nausea, vomiting or diarrhea (or is feeling unwell)
 - Cough, sore throat, or croup (except in the case of allergy)
 - Colored runny noses
 - Common cold
 - Contagious skin rash
 - Pink eye or communicable eye infections
 - Lice
 - Any symptom of usual childhood diseases such as mumps, measles, chickenpox
 - Use of antibiotics of 24 hours or less
- Staff cannot administer any type of medication to children.
- For the safety and proper care of the children, we need to maintain a 1:4 ratio of adults to kids in this room. Thank you for understanding that there may be times when you can not drop off your little one. Each worship service has a cry room for you to bring your child with you to worship.
