a. Group Officers

- i. Online Coordinator - Ensures online access to A.A. and D.A. 12-step resources and literature for members and newcomers. This role manages the group's electronic communications (blog, calendar, emails, etc.), providing multiple channels for members to share questions, concerns, and ideas. This position involves coordination with other service roles. All group officers share tasks equitably.
- ii. GSR - Facilitates group conscious meetings (including agenda setting and chairing), represents the group at area meetings (including Houston Intergroup and WSC), tracks meeting metrics, and promotes service. This role involves coordinating with GSO, Houston area GSRs, other group officers, and members to share ideas for improvement. While valuable, a GSR is not essential for the group's basic operation. All group officers share responsibilities equitably.

b. Weekly Meetings Service Positions

- i. Greeter - Welcome new members (No Sign-up is required)
- ii. TECH- follows along with the meeting format, providing links in the chat as prompted. The TECH must meet the following criteria:
 - 1. Minimum of 4 meetings attended
 - 2. Strong understanding of the group dynamics.
 - 3. Tech: Zoom proficiency, PC/MAC proficiency
- iii. Leader - Shares for 8 - 10 minutes on the week's topic
 - 1. Has a solvency requirement of 30 days to lead this meeting and can not be a paid professional for their time.
- iv. Chair - Follows meeting format and ensures meeting begins & ends on time, but cannot be the meeting Leader on the same day as being the chair group.
 - 1. The CHAIR has a solvency requirement of 30 days to chair this meeting (person cannot have incurred unsecured debt for 30 days).
 - ★ When a meeting leader is unavailable: This instance only requires a meeting CHAIR to start the meeting by reading D.A. Conference-approved literature that aligns with the meeting's scheduled topic for up to 5 minutes (with no personal reflection)
