-RATIONALE-

Research question:

Does 131 prefer people who aren't affected by anomalies better than others? What if the people affected by anomalies are faster than normal? Does it not mind the change in appearance as 131 comes in multiple color variants itself? Does it think that these Class-D's might be another instance of itself, as in, another 131 variant, just in a different shape or size? For this test, I'll use 294, and a few of its drinks that affect both the Class-D's speed and appearance.

Hypothesis:

Knowing that 131 likes to bond with people will the appearance of the subject change how 131 bonds with people. 131 might bond quicker with someone that is faster due to 131s competitive nature. He might like the color similar to its own and perhaps show dislike to the color on the opposite side of the spectrum

Possible outcomes:

Possible Outcome A:

Seeing the competitive nature that 131 possesses, it might initially choose a random CD without much consideration about the choice itself.

However, after showing 131 the speed increase in one of the CDs, it could change its preference to either:

- The slower one, to make winning easier, or
- The faster one, to make it a better competition for itself.









If that were the case this would show that 131 takes a liking to those who have the same kind of energy and speed that it does.

Possible Outcome B:

131 might not take attributes like speed and color into consideration when choosing a person.

Instead, that could imply that there are different factors at play, such as:

- The behavior of the person, or
- Something entirely else that we are yet to understand.

-METHOD-

Originally there were 3 CDs planned, but 1 had to leave early.

First, we headed to 294. I assigned each CD a number:

- CD 1 was Gx Scan3
- CD 2 was Squupee

I will now be referring to them as such.

I briefed CD 1 to get the drinks Krill, Kiwi, and Strawberry. After that, I told CD 2 the drinks they were assigned: Lithium, Soap, and Scientific Department.

I made sure both of them understood the drinks they needed to obtain and sent them into the 294 room. The CDs took their drinks, and I confirmed it visually.

We then proceeded to head into SCP-131's chamber. Before entering the chamber itself, I briefed both CDs:

When I give them a command to drink, they are to drink the next drink.

After that, I proceeded to tell SCP-131 what I was doing. I explained that I would present it with 2 people, and it should pick its favorite by standing in front of that person.

I asked SCP-131 for permission to stay in the room during the test for a better view, and it gave me permission to do so.

I then ordered the CDs into the room and showed them their positions near the wall of the







CC. I told the CDs to drink their first drink.

I let SCP-131 choose its favorite, and after that, I told the CDs to walk around for a bit due to 1 of the drinks in the first round increasing walking speed.

After a short while, I told the CDs to stop walking and return to their positions.

I then told them to drink their next drink and let SCP-131 choose its favorite once more. Since there was no speed increase this time, I didn't order them to walk, assuming that SCP-131 still remembered that CD 2 has a faster walking speed.

I once again told the CDs to drink their respective drinks and let SCP-131 pick its favorite. This time, I let them walk around for a bit again due to CD 1 having drunk Strawberry, which increased their speed.

After observing SCP-131's choice, the test was concluded.

We thanked SCP-131 for its assistance and left the containment chamber.

-RESULTS-

During the first round, where the CDs drank their drinks, 131 seemed to be unsure.

It looked at one CD and made a sound, then looked at the other and made a sound again. 131 ended up going close to the CDs to inspect them more closely and even jumped on them to check them out.

After that, it returned to me and made a low-pitched noise, which I assumed was similar to "no" or something negative. It then went to the middle of the CDs, made the low-pitched noise again, and jumped.

I asked 131 if its choice was "neither," and it told me no. The escorting SD asked if it was "both," and it said yes.

When the CDs ran back and forth, 131 ran with them, but it didn't pick a side, remaining in the center of the CDs.

I went on to ask 131 if it had changed its opinion since one CD was faster. Due to its competitive nature, I thought it might prefer the faster one to have a good competition or the slower one to win. However, it told me that its choices remained the same.







After the CDs drank their second drink, 131 approached them and looked at them for about one second before making a medium-pitched noise.

It went back to the first CD, made the low-pitched noise, and then did the same thing with the other CD. Afterward, it went into the middle of them once more, jumped twice, and returned to me.

I said, "No preference again!", and it agreed to that statement.

Not sure if it's of interest to the rationale, but while waiting for my next command, 131 was driving/running around me, which could indicate that 131 is quite impatient.

When the third and last round of drinks was consumed, 131 saw CD 2, which had turned dark blue due to the drink called "Scientific Department".

It just so happened that the skin color of the CD almost perfectly matched 131's color.

131 approached CD 2, looked at him for about 0.5 seconds, and made a high-pitched sound. It moved side to side in front of CD 2, making a high-pitched sound at the furthest point of each arch pattern it was doing.

The high-pitched sound seemed to indicate something positive, like agreement or even happiness, based on how excited 131 behaved.

I asked, "This one?" It stopped moving in the pattern, looked toward me, and nodded in agreement.

I then asked the CDs to walk around for a bit more since CD 1 had drunk "Strawberry" this time, which made him faster.

131 eagerly followed CD 2, and it seemed that 131 was faster than earlier when moving to the middle. It didn't even take notice that CD 1 was faster.

After I asked the CDs to stop, 131 made a few more high-pitched sounds and started dancing in front of CD 2, making even more high-pitched noises.

It circled CD 2 one more time before I thanked 131 for assisting with the test.

With that, the test was concluded. The CDs were brought out and terminated shortly







afterward.

Conclusion:

I assume that the same applies to other instances of 131, but it needs further testing to confirm.

It seems that instances of 131 like things that match their color.

If the color is different from their own, it doesn't seem to have any effect. Similarly, they do not appear to consider the speed of the subjects.

The noises that 131 makes seem to be associated with positive and negative emotions.

My theory is that these noises may not only express feelings but could also serve as a form of communication.

If we could translate their meaning into our language, it might help us better understand 131's needs.

Theories:

Seeing as 131 has a relatively simple intelligence that is comparable to a cat, I have a few theories as to why 131 might have picked the CD that was the same color as it was.

Theory 1:

Due to 131 lacking the ability to form relatively complex thoughts, it could be that it has a relatively straightforward mind. This means that 131 might have the simple mindset where even color seems to have a big impact on the decisions it makes.

Theory 2:

131 could also be acting out of instinct, since many animals with simpler intelligence prefer things that resemble themselves.

This mechanism was originally developed as a way to find partners in nature to survive.

Now, seeing as 131 is not a wild animal nor does it need partners like itself to survive, it might still retain this instinct, which could explain why it made this choice.

Additional information:

I managed to get an insight from a Licensed Psychological Counselor on why they this might





be the case. It was written by LawyerGravi which was also spectating my test.

"As a Licensed Psychological Counselor of the Medical Department, I think that SCP-131 might prefer the Class-D that's affected by 294's Scientific Department drink because they look like SCP-131 after. Through the other drinks, the speed of the Class-D increased, and now the skin color, too. SCP-131 has probably only seen itself with dark blue skin, seeing other people with this attribute might make it subconsciously, or in this case obviously prefer the person that is similar to itself." -Mariyam L. 


