- The inclusion of \$50 million for Whole-Home Repairs in Governor Shapiro's budget proposal is a win for our homes!
- It's been less than a year since funding began to flow to counties to launch the Whole-Home Repairs Program, and already across the Commonwealth, more than a thousand homes have been repaired and countless lives have been changed.
- When Whole-Home Repairs passed, we knew the need was huge. One in four Pennsylvania voters lives in a home that needs a critical repair, and one in three has utility bills that are unaffordable. Demand for the program has far outpaced available resources. Hundreds of thousands of Pennsylvanians live in a home that needs a critical repair, and county administrators are reporting that the number of eligible applicants is 4 times, 10 times, and even 25 times greater than they can serve.
- With this budget, Governor Shapiro has shown his commitment to fixing our homes and
 investing in the long-term health of our communities. Now, it's time for legislators in both
 chambers, and on both sides of the aisle, to come together. Housing insecurity crosses
 all geographic and political boundaries, and it will take all of us working together to move
 toward a shared vision of every one of our neighbors and loved ones safe in their
 homes, and safe in their communities.

 can serve. In Allegheny County alone, 96% of eligible applicants are being deferred
 simply because of insufficient funds to meet the need.
- Pennsylvania residents need this program to stay safe and healthy in their homes.
 Pennsylvania builders need this program for good local jobs and for training up tomorrow's workers. County administrators are ready to deploy Whole-Home Repairs funds as soon as they come through to expand the incredible successes and help more neighbors retain their homes and stay in the communities they love.
