◆ Pacing ◆

The drama should be balanced as well, a little for one character, then a little for the other, not one-sided. That being said, please no like god mode/Mary Sues.

◆ Communication ◆

I like to chat a bit OOC. sending media that represents the characters and just overall plotting. I think it's fun. Please communicate what you like, what you want to see, any plot points you think would be fun. Anything really. It helps keep the momentum of the rp going forward

◆ Timing ◆

I understand people have lives, and stuff comes up. I tend to be a daily replier, and it's ok if my partner isn't. However, if you are not replying for a week and don't mention that you are hung up with something then I will assume you are no longer interested. It is hard to keep the momentum of a story going when we average one reply a week. If you are bored, say something. Let me know what is working and what is not working because I want to make sure both of us are having fun.
