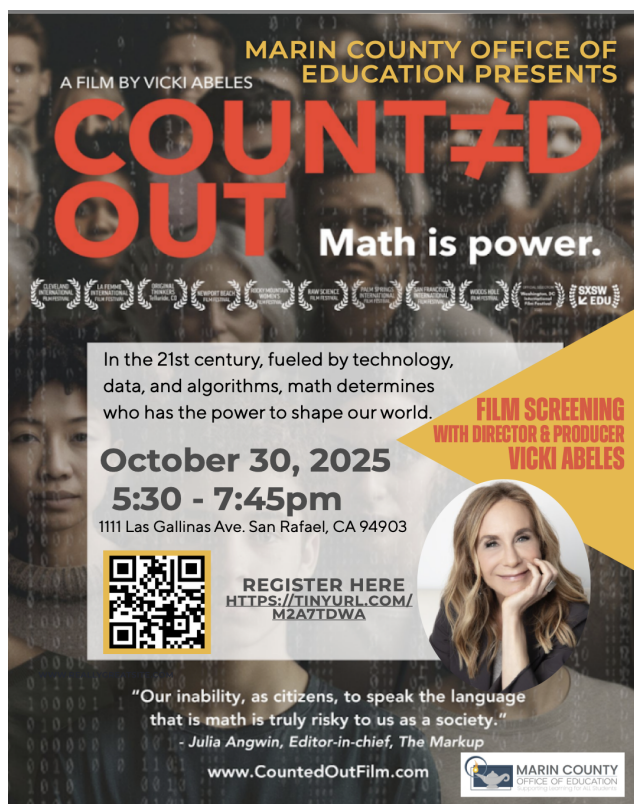




ENGLISH: You're Invited: *Counted Out* Film Screening – October 30!

Summary: *Counted Out* investigates the biggest crises of our time (Math) through an unexpected lens. In our current economy, math is everywhere. The news we see, the influence of our votes, the education we have access to, the jobs we get; all of it is underwritten by an invisible layer of Mathematics that few of us understand, or even notice. Our numeric literacy—whether we can speak the language of math—is a critical determinant of social and economic power. Through personal stories, expert interviews, and scenes of math transformation, *Counted Out* shows what's at risk if we keep the status quo. Ask yourself:

- Do we want an America in which most of us don't consider ourselves “math people”?
- Do we want an America in which math proficiency goes down as students grow up?
- Or do we want a country where everyone can understand the math that shapes our society?
