

# Show What You Know

## Kindergarten

Show What You Know is a cumulative assessment designed to measure students' ScratchJr knowledge gained during the CAL curriculum. This assessment is designed to be run synchronously at the beginning of Lesson 22. Before class, teachers should print out Show What You Know Student Sheets (*make sure to print in landscape mode*) for the students to record their answers to each question. These sheets are designed to be printed and folded together as a small book for each child. Once in class, the teacher will project the Show What You Know Teacher Slides on the board and read each question aloud to the class. Teachers may read the question up to 3 times. Some slides have supplemental materials such as videos. Teachers should play those videos at least twice for the class when reading each corresponding question. Students should have at least 2 minutes per question. Extra time can be decided at the teachers' discretion. This assessment is not designed to have a time limit.
