Description:

1. The Student Exchange Program from KAILI University, China PR, visited Sisaket Rajabhat University

The Chinese Language Program, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Sisaket Rajabhat University, welcomed exchange students from Kaili University, Guizhou Province, People's Republic of China. This academic cooperation was continuously implemented during Semester 2/2025 from 2–13 November 2025. The program aimed to strengthen international academic cooperation, promote cultural exchange, and provide students with opportunities for language learning and international experience.

2. The Student Exchange Program from Sisaket Rajabhat University visited KAILI University and Guizhou University of Finance and Economics, China PR

Sisaket Rajabhat University established academic cooperation through Memoranda of Understanding (MOUs) with Guizhou University of Finance and Economics and Kaili University, People's Republic of China. During the 2026 academic year, the Chinese Language Program, Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, sent 12 students to participate in exchange activities from 9 March to 5 July 2026. The program enhanced students' language skills, intercultural competencies, and international learning experiences.

3. The Student Exchange Program from Sisaket Rajabhat University visited Northwest University, China PR

The Chinese Language Teaching Program, Faculty of Education, Sisaket Rajabhat University, sent two students to participate in a two-month exchange program at Northwest University, People's Republic of China, from 5 March to 5 May 2026. The program provided opportunities for students to improve language proficiency, academic competencies, and cross-cultural understanding.

4. International Relations, Sisaket Rajabhat University, participated in "The 2nd Rajabhat University Network Exchange 2026 (RUNEX 2026)"

Sisaket Rajabhat University participated in "The 2nd Rajabhat University Network Exchange 2026 (RUNEX 2026)," organized by the Foreign Affairs Strategy Division of Rajabhat Universities. The program aimed to strengthen international academic networks and improve students' competencies in English and Chinese languages. Activities included language competitions, project presentations, seminars, and international student development activities.

5. Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) 2025

Sisaket Rajabhat University, in collaboration with Sisaket Rotary Club, organized the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards (RYLA) 2025 program. Participants included youth aged 10–20 years from China, Japan, Korea, Thailand, the United States, African countries, and Lao PDR. The program focused on developing leadership skills, social responsibility, cultural exchange, and international networking among youth participants.

6. Indian Studies Corner and Academic Cooperation with the Embassy of India in Thailand

Sisaket Rajabhat University established an Indian Studies Corner and initiated academic cooperation with the Embassy of India in Thailand in the areas of education, cultural exchange, scholarships, and information technology studies. The initiative serves as a learning resource center for students, university staff, and the public while promoting international understanding and academic collaboration.



7. Renewal of the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Sisaket Rajabhat University and the Institute of International Education (IIE)

Sisaket Rajabhat University renewed its Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Institute of International Education (IIE) to strengthen cooperation in TOEFL ITP English language testing and academic development. The agreement supports the enhancement of language competencies and educational opportunities for students, staff members, and the public.

8. The 4th Thailand Cultural Exchange Festival (Thailand-CEF)

Sisaket Rajabhat University participated in the 4th Thailand Cultural Exchange Festival involving representatives from 11 countries, including Mexico, Indonesia, Israel, Italy, Bulgaria, the Philippines, China, Brazil, India, Lao PDR, and Thailand. Through the participation of the Pong Lang Phuka Lamduan ensemble, the university promoted cultural exchange and international understanding through traditional performing arts.

9. International Folklore Music Festival and Cultural Exchange Activities

The Pong Lang Phuka Lamduan ensemble of Sisaket Rajabhat University represented Thailand in the International Folklore Music Festival and cultural exchange activities held during the Songkran Festival at Wat Phrai Phatthana, Sisaket Province. Participants from eight countries joined the event, promoting intercultural learning and preserving traditional cultural heritage through international performances.

10. Academic Cooperation Agreement between Pakse Teacher Training College, Lao PDR and Sisaket Rajabhat University

Sisaket Rajabhat University signed an academic cooperation agreement with Pakse Teacher Training College, Lao People’s Democratic Republic. The collaboration aims to strengthen academic relationships and encourage knowledge sharing between institutions.

Sisaket Rajabhat University signed an academic cooperation agreement with Champasak Technical Vocational College, Lao People’s Democratic Republic, to promote academic exchange, personnel training, collaborative research, and faculty capacity development.
