


Instructions on where to find the chronic homeless table, and the raw client chronic homeless information on the CoC APR and how this data is reflected in the primary report.

#### **Chronic Homeless Table**

Run CoC APR 2017



- 2. From page 1 of the APR, type in the #12 in the page search box and then click ENTER
- 3. This will bring you to the link to the Veteran, Chronic Homeless and Youth Report.
- 4. Click on the hyperlink
- 5. You will now be able to click on the links to the tables you would like to view



**Important Note:** As long as one of the members of the household are chronically homeless then all members get counted as chronically homeless.

## CaseWorthy - Chronic Homeless Status on the CoC APR 2017

New Chronic Homeless Columns on the Client Detail Sub-report:

1. Click on the client detail sub-report link



- 2. The two new chronic homeless columns are the last two columns of the report
- 3. The chronic homeless column will show the CH value for the individual
- The chronic homeless household column will show the CH value for the household



- 5. This is the raw data for the household. The primary report will properly report the chronic homeless status for each household member.
  - a. If any adults in the household calculate as chronically homeless then all members will be identified on the primary report as chronically homeless
  - b. If no adult members are chronically homeless then the household will not be considered chronically homeless nor will its members.
