- 3. Cuir dath dearg ar an díón (cur dah jarag er on deen) Colour the roof red
- 4. Cuir dath gorm na fuinneoga (cur dah gurum er nah vwin-yoga) Colour the windows brown
- 5. Curi dath donn ar an simléar (cur dah dun er on shim-ler) Colour the chimney brown

Comhair (core) - count
