Summary:

The department (DOT) shall install and maintain adult changing stations in facilities at certain rest areas throughout the state as determined by the department. Adult changing station is defined as an adult changing table placed within an enclosed restroom facility or other similar facility that is for use by persons with disabilities who need assistance with diapering. The requirement is repealed July 1, 2026.
