[Ablinaen](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders, Abinary

Ablinaen is a singular aphorian gender that has no gender quality or alignment, but exists outside of all conventionality. It is not binary, genderless, or xenic.

It is aporagender (aporaen) if it did not have the qualities of abinarine or aporine and instead

existed without any quality or alignment. It is called “aphorian” and not “abinary” so that its definition has no reference to the abinary quality.



[Aebie](#)

Category: Abinary, Diminutive Terms, Referential Language

Aebie is a diminutive term for someone who is aenban, a nonbinary abinary person. It is similar to enby, a diminutive term for a nonbinary person. Diminutive terms usually denote youth, but can be used by anyone who relates to those terms. This term may also be called “aeby” or “aebit”.



[Aeboy](#)

Category: Abinary, Diminutive Terms, Referential Language

Aeboy is a diminutive term for someone who is an aenman, a nonbinary abinary man or male aenban; a combination of *aebie* and boy. It is similar to enby, a diminutive term for a nonbinary person. Diminutive terms usually denote youth, but can be used by anyone who relates to those terms. This term may also be called “aenmaby”.



[Aemale](#)

Category: Abinary, Sex Terms

Aemale is a sex term for anyone who is an aenban and a man, which is a nonbinary abinary man. Sex terms can be used to describe any sex characteristics, both primary and secondary, much like the terms “male” and “female”. This may also be called “aemanox” or “aemanon”.

Category: Umbine, Outherine, Abinary

Aenera is an umbine gender related to womanhood. Umbine is an outhetine quality that encompasses qualities comparable to ordinous ones - masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral. Genders may also be ordinous and in this case, aenera is comparable to womanhood.



[Aenmel](#)

Category: Abinary, Sex Terms

Aenmel is a sex term for anyone who is an aenban, which is a combination of nonbinary and abinary. Sex terms can be used to describe any sex characteristics, both primary and secondary, much like the terms “male” and “female”. This may also be called “aenbanox” or “aenbanon”.



[Aenvir](#)

Category: Umbine, Outherine, Abinary

Aenvir is an umbine gender related to manhood. Umbine is an outharine quality that encompasses qualities comparable to ordinous ones - masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral. Genders may also be ordinous and in this case, aenvir is comparable to manhood.



[Aesthetivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec

Aesthetivir is an experience where one's *gendervir* identity is influenced by aesthetics or sensory experiences. It is the combination of aesthetigender and gendervir, which would make it a *xenovir* identity.



[Afeminine](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities, Gender Quality

Afeminine means moving through many gender qualities such as masculine, neutral, xenine, outharine, etc. but never experiencing femininity.



[Agendercosmic](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders

Agendercosmic describes a feeling of genderlessness that is connected to space, galaxies, stars, and other celestial bodies. This does not necessarily mean the genderless nature of this identity is related to the void or black holes, but it can be the case depending on how the individual uses the label.



[Agenderprox](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Miscellaneous Genders, Proximal Genders

Agenderprox is a gender that is relative to agender, but is something separate and entirely on its own. It doesn't exist outside of the gender spectrum, but may be very close to outside of it. It may also be another way to say "almost agender", as if there is a fraction of identity that prevents it from being totally genderless. This identity falls under the proximal gender umbrella, where you would find terms such as proxvir or juxera.

Agenderprox individuals may consider themselves to be demiagender, demineutrois, agender men, agender women, aporagender, or they may use the term by itself. This term can also be

used with other identities - they may call themselves agenderproxvir or that they are an agenderprox xenogender person. They can also be aligned with any gender or completely unaligned.



[Agendervir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Agiaspec, Demigender

Agendervir is when an individual is part *gendervir* and part agender. The two parts of the identity can fluctuate or be fluid, can be completely separate and static, or blend together into one identity.

The *-vir* ending is for those who have a male-related, male-adjacent, or male-aligned identity, and is more inclusive than the diminutive *boy* as seen in many other labels.



[Ainepicene](#)

Category: Abinary, Aporine, Niaspec

Ainepicene is a specifically abinary epicenity. This epicenity exists far outside the binary and can include abinarity, outherness, maverinity, and any anonbinary or off-binary epicenities. Not to be confused with the umbine quality "aimpicene."



[Alique](#)

Category: Demigender, Miscellaneous Genders

Alique is another way to say "deminonbinary".



[Alitrum](#)

Category: Niaspec, Demigender

Alitrum is an identity that is part nonbinary and part neutral.



[Alignment-fluid](#)

Category: Alignment

Alignment-fluid refers to being fluid between multiple alignments. These can include masculine, feminine, neutral, epicene, or agenrine alignments, but it can also include those that are xenine or outherness.

Someone who is alignment-fluid can also be fluid between alignments of genders rather than

gender qualities - they can be woman-aligned, catgender-aligned, gendervoid-aligned, and many others.



[Allotropic](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders, Genderflux, Genderfluid

Allotropic is a descriptor for a gender that exists or has the ability to exist in all three states of static, fluid, and flux.

This is typically a word to describe a singular gender that is both kymenian (static) and amplusian (moving) at the same time, but it may also be used to describe a multigender experience. A bigender identity can be overall allotropic, but one's specific genders can also be allotropic.



[Altemel](#)

Category: Alterhuman, Sex Terms, Exclusive Identities

Altemel is a sex term for anyone who is *alterine*, an alterhuman gender quality. Sex terms can be used to describe any sex characteristics, both primary and secondary, much like the terms "male" and "female". This may also be called "altenox" or "altenon".



[Alterine](#)

Category: Alterhuman, Gender Quality, Exclusive Identities

Alterine is a gender quality that encompasses any gender, alignment, expression, presentation, or quality connected to alterhumanity. This includes identities relating to otherkinity, therianthropy, plurality, otherheartedness, *draconity*, and anything else that may fall under the alterhuman umbrella. Someone who is transitioning in an alterine way may be called *transalterine*. This term is exclusive to alterhumans.



[Altervir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Altervir, Alterhuman, Exclusive Identities

Altervir refers to a *gendervir* person whose alterhumanity is inseparable from their gender. Alterhuman identities include plurality, otherkinity, therianthropy, synpaths, starseeds, otherheartedness, copinglinks, and many more.



[Amaverine](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

Amaverine describes moving through many gender qualities such as masculine, feminine, neutral, xenine, outh erine, etc. but never experiencing maverinity.



[Amasculine](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities, Gender Quality

Amasculine means moving through many gender qualities such as feminine, neutral, xenine, outh erine, etc. but never experiencing masculinity.



[Ampline](#)

Category: Gender Quality

Ampline is a gender quality related to all multigender identities including polygender, bigender, trigender, demigender, genderfluid, and genderflux. Not to be confused with *amplusian*, which is an umbrella term for all non-static genders - amplusian can, however, be an ampline gender.

Noun: *Amplinity*. Ampline-in-nature (APLIN.)



[Anderaster](#)

Category: Niaspec, Outh erine

Anderaster is a gender that is both outh erine and neutral at the same time. It is a subset of andergender, a system of genders that describe the intersection of outh erinity and other (typically ordinous) gender qualities. This is not a multigender term, but a singular gender made up of two aspects or qualities.



[Andrangine](#)

Category: Dipherine, Outh erine, Abinary, Liaspec, Masculine, Gender Quality

Andrangine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of androgyny and masculinity. It is outh erine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, androgynous and masculine.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities. The feminine version is *gynangine*.



[Andrine](#)

Category: Gender Quality

Andrine is a gender quality related to men and boys, which includes most *gendervir* identities. It is not the same as masculine, an ideo-quality similar to malehood but also existing as its own quality that can overlap with any kind of gender. Andrine specifically separates the idea of malehood from masculinity to avoid the tendency to place the former under the latter (Basically,

man is not a masculine gender. It is an andrine gender.)



[Andro](#)

Category: Referential Language

Andro is an age-nonspecific referential term for someone who is male. The plural form is *andros*.



[Aneirian](#)

Category: Aporine, Abinary, Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders

Aneirian: An identity that is aporine-aligned and part of the Galactian Alignment System. It is an alignment that is not masculine, feminine, or anything in between, but still feels some strong sense of genderedness (and so it is not agenrine.)



[Angidrox](#)

Category: Centrigender, Liaspec

Angidrox is a gender that exists in between androx and androgyne. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of androx and androgyne, nor does it derive from the two.



[Angigynx](#)

Category: Centrigender, Liaspec

Angigynx is a gender that exists in between gynx and androgyne. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of gynx and androgyne, nor does it derive from the two.



[Angiverin](#)

Category: Maverine, Liaspec, Centrigender, Polymaverine, Auingender

Angiverin is a gender that is a maverine centrangi gender, meaning it is a maverine gender that exists between fiaspec and miaspec genders. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of maverine, fiaspec, and miaspec, nor does it derive from the three.



[Androgynic](#)

Category: Polygender, Miscellaneous Genders, Liaspec, Coregenic

Androgynic refers to having an androgyne-related or androgyne-aligned gender no matter how

the rest of your gender changes or moves.

One can be fluid between many non-androgynous identities while androgyne remains the "base" of the identity, or one can fluctuate between intensities of gender while androgyne stays present.



[Androneu](#)

Category: Niaspec

Androneu is a gender that is within the gender-neutral spectrum, but with a strong connection to *andrinity* - this is a gender quality related to malehood.



[Aneutral](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities, Gender Quality

Aneutral means moving through many gender qualities such as feminine, masculine, xenine, outhérine, etc. but never experiencing neutrality.



[Anodieic](#)

Category: Alignment, Outherine

Anodieic is a word for being anodieic-aligned.



[Anonbinarine](#)

Category: Gender Quality

Anonbinarine is a gender quality related to anonbinary genders and qualities. Anonbinarine-in-nature (ANOBIN.)



[Anthrine](#)

Category: Gender Quality

Anthrine is a gender quality referring to all non-xenine qualities. This includes femininity, masculinity, epicenity, aporinity, outhérinity, agenrinity, maverinity, and all others (on their own or in combination) that are in no way related to xenity. You may consider this quality to be anthrine-in-nature (ANTHIN.)



[Anthroxen](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Centrigender

Anthroxen is a gender that exists in between anthrogender and xenogender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of anthrogender and xenogender, nor does it derive from the two.



Antitrinarist

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

Antitrinarist refers to anyone who pushes back against the establishment of a gender trinary, the forcing of nonbinary people into third genderedness, and the insinuation that the supposed “third gender” of the trinary should lump all nonbinary people into one single point. It rejects, in fact, any establishment of an -arity as an attempt to replace the gender binary and also rejects terms like “atrinary” that recognize any kind of gender trinary. It is a stance against exorsexism, particularly within one’s own community.

This identity pairs well with maverism and *gender disobedient*. It is not meant to be against people with binary genders or non-outherine aporagenders. This was created in solidarity with anyone who is of an outherine gender who is constantly forced into the “atrinary” label, as well as with those who are expected to call their gender a “trinary” gender.



Aphoric

Category: Alignment, Abinary

Aphoric is a word for being aphorian-aligned.



Aponine

Category: Gender Quality

Aponine is a gender quality for genderfreeness. It includes genders that are entirely removed from the concept of gender and identities where gender is irrelevant or insignificant to the individual. Genders that can be aponine are genderfree, apogender, quoigender, as well as some experiences with genderqueer and genderpunk. They may feel like their gender is entirely autonomous. The noun form of this term is *aponinity*.



Aporaen

Category: Aporine, Abinary, Referential Language

Aporaen is an age nonspecific term for aporine people used in the same way "nonbin" is used. *Aporaens* is the plural form.



[Aporafemale](#)

Category: Aporine, Demigender, Polygender

Aporafemale is a gender that is part aporine, part female.



[Aporamale](#)

Category: Aporine, Demigender, Polygender

Aporamale is a gender that is part aporine, part male.



[Aporavir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Aporine, Demigender

Aporavir is part *gendervir*, part aporagender. This could mean a *bivir* identity, or a *demivir* identity depending on the individual. One might also consider this an aporine-aligned gendervir identity.



[Aporaxenic](#)

Category: Aporine, Abinary, Xiaspec

Aporaxenic is an identity where one is both aporagender and xenogender at the same time. This could mean feeling not male, not female, not anything in between, but something vaguely xenic. It could also mean being xeno-aligned and aporagender, or having an aporine xenogender experience.



[Asteresque](#)

Category: Abinary, Aporine, Niaspec, Space Related Genders

Asteresque is a gender that is not male, female, or anything in between and is entirely unaligned and neutral at its core. It is not ambiguous (UNAMIN) nor is it genderless. Its neutral quality can often "soften" or "neutralize" other genders, acting as a balancing element in one's gender experience (particularly for multigender people, where one gender might feel more aligned or more strongly felt.) It falls under the nonbinary, aporagender, and ningender umbrellas and is not necessarily xenine, but may be viewed that way by some people who use the label.



[Asterettian](#)

Category: Outherine, Space Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Asterettian is a gender that is linked to the void and fluctuates with soft celestial outhertine

energy. It is part of the celestial gender system and is the void-aligned counterpart is *constellarian*.



[Asteristic](#)

Category: Polygender, Space Related Genders

Asteristic refers to having more than one gender that aren't at all linked or related. This word comes from "asterism", which is a cluster of stars that do not form constellations.



[Asteroid-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Asteroid-aligned is an erratic and unpredictable alignment that is cold. May feel like it's far away from other alignments. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



[Astramel](#)

Category: Sex Terms, Niaspec, Aporine

Astramel is a sex term for anyone who is *astereque*, an unambiguous neutral aporagender. Sex terms can be used to describe any sex characteristics, both primary and secondary, much like the terms "male" and "female". This may also be called *astranox* or *astranon*.



[Astran](#)

Category: Niaspec, Aporine, Referential Language, Space Related Genders

Astran is an adult referential term for someone who is *asteresque*, used like the word "man" or "woman." The plural form is *astren*.



[Astrangine](#)

Category: Dipherine, Outherine, Abinary, Liaspec, Niaspec, Gender Quality

Astrangine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of androgyny and neutrality. It is outharine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, androgynous and neutral.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities.



[Astrovir](#)

Category: Alignment, Gendervir, Cosmovir Alignments, Xiaspec, Masculine

Astrovir is a *gendervir* person whose masculinity and the fiery energy of the daytime Sun are a central part of their identity. It is part of the *cosmovir alignments*.



[Astrunine](#)

Category: Abinary, Outherine, Niaspec, Dipherine, Gender Quality

Astrunine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of neutral and epicene. It is outharine in nature and is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality created from other qualities.



[Atrinvold](#)

Category: Outherine, Uingender

Atrinvold (also called *ouinvold*) is a gender that is specifically outharine and not genderless, but is unknown otherwise. It is not feminine, masculine, androgynous, or neutral, but may be outharine, xenine, or even beyond that. This is not an umbrella term but exists by itself as its own unknown gender.



[Attravir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Orientation

Attravir is an orientationgender specifically for *gendervir* folk. It describes the experience of one's orientation being intrinsically tied to one's gendervir identity in some way - usually because the two are inseparable aspects of identity that can overlap or influence one another.

Orientationgenders include identities such as lesbiangender, gaygender, acegender, arogender, genderbi, or genderpan. Identities that would potentially fall under attravir are lesbianvir, gayvir, acevir, arovir, virbi, or virpan - none of which have been coined as of yet.



[Aurora-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Aurora-aligned is a fluctuating, colorful, and bright alignment that swirls through the temperate atmosphere. Associated with solar winds, magnetic fields, and planet Earth. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

An aurora is a bright band of light caused by solar winds disturbing the Earth's magnetic field.



[Axenine](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

Axenine means moving through many gender qualities such as feminine, neutral, masculine, outharine, etc. but never experiencing xenity. This is not to be confused with *nonxenic*.



[Axenovir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xiaspec, Agiaspec

Axenovir refers to being an agender, xenic, and *gendervir* person. This doesn't necessarily mean that this is a *trivir* identity, but may be considered such depending on the individual. Sometimes, this could simply be a xeno-aligned *agendervir* identity, or a *xenovir* agingender.

This identity may also be called *axenvir*.

[Bi-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment

Bi-aligned means having two alignments.



[Bi-maverine](#)

Category: Maverine, Outharine, Abinary, Bigender, Polygender, Polymaverine, Auingender

Bi-maverine is a bigender experience where both genders are maverine, either by alignment, quality, or aspect (mvingender.) A bi-maverine person can be any two genders even if they are not maverique or another aporine gender. For example, if someone is both a man and a woman but experiences manhood and womanhood in a maverine way, that person can be considered bi-maverine.



[Bibby](#)

Category: Referential Language, Bigender, Polygender

Bibby is a diminutive referential term for someone who is bigender. The plural form is *bibbies*.



[Bigen](#)

Category: Referential Language, Bigender, Polygender

Bigen is an adult referential term for someone who is bigender. The plural form is *bigens*.



Bigenesque

Category: Bigender, Proximal Genders

Bigenesque (also called *bigenderesque*) is a bigender-like gender. It's a way to say "My gender is *almost* bigender, but something keeps it from being fully or literally bigender." One might have partial genders making up the identity or maybe their gender is only made up of proximal genders.



Binarypunk

Category: Genderpunk, Binary Related Genders

Binarypunk is the voluntary experience of flipping the gender binary on its head for one's own personal expression or as an act of protest. It is the rejection of binaries in any sense of the word, including creating binaries between genders, alignments, expressions, or assigned genders at birth. It is an anti-assimilation punk movement within the scope of gender binarity. This term is similar to *gender disobedient*, but with a focus on the gender binary and any gendered concepts related to it.

A binarypunk experience may involve having a gender related to or within the binary but using unconventional means of expression (through clothing, pronouns, gendered terminology, etc.) or it may involve a rejection of the gender binary in favor of a "new binary". An individual may break gender convention and expectations - men and women playing with gender fuckery, complex or "contradictory" labels, being xeno-aligned or having a gender aligned with wildly abstract and new concepts - all with the purposeful disassembling or redefinition of the gender binary or any binary concepts. Masculinity and femininity is turned on its head and recontextualized to fit a more individualistic experience that defies any convention or boundaries.



Bitrigger

Category: Bigender, Trigender, Polygender

Bitrigger is a gender that is both bigender and trigender at the same time. It is the static version of *bitrinic*.



Bitrinic

Category: Bigender, Trigender, Polygender, Miscellaneous Genders

Bitrinic is the feeling of changing between being bigender and being trigender. This could mean fluidity or fluctuations between numbers of genders (from two to three) or being bigender with an unknown third gender.



Bivir

Category: Gendervir, Polyvir, Polygender

Bivir means having two or more *gendervir* identities. It typically refers to two whole gendervir genders - either static or changing, experienced at the same time or separately. However, it can also be two partial gendervir (*demivir*) identities as well.



Bixenic

Category: Polygender, Xiaspec

Bixenic means having two xenic or xeno-aligned genders.



Blueberry Transmaverine

Category: Maverine, Feminine, Niaspec

Blueberry transmaverine describes a transmaverine (transmav) person that presents in a way that looks traditionally “soft fem” but has an entirely autonomous, outharine form of expression. Presentation for a blueberry transmav may stay within the neutral-to-fem range but never overly feminine and never with the intent to call it feminine.



Brite

Category: Vocorian

Brite is a word for a *vocorian* person who presents in a way that is flashy, bright, and colorful. This term may be used as an adjective or a noun depending on preference. It is the opposite of *overcast*.

Captivir

Category: Gendervir, Miscellaneous Genders

Captivir is a term for the feeling of being drawn to many or all *gendervir* identities or wanting to express one's gender in a multitude of male-aligned ways. Someone who is captivir may want an identity and expression that is gendervir-like without being gendervir, or they may feel aligned with many gendervir genders.



Carinaean

Category: Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders, Liaspec

Carinaean is a galactian alignment that is both *pyxian* and *velaeen* (both *andrine*-aligned and *gynine*-aligned. Andrine is a gender quality related to manhood and gynine is a gender quality related to womanhood.



[Celestarivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Polyvir, Polygender, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Demigender

Celestarivir is part celestarian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.



[Celestialine](#)

Category: Gender Quality, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders

Celestialine is gender quality for all space-related genders, alignments, and qualities. Considered a xiaspec term. Celestialine-in-nature (CELIN.)



[Centaurian](#)

Category: Ilyagine, Outherine, Space Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Centaurian is a gender that is linked to soft celestial ilyagine energy. It is part of the celestial gender system and its void-aligned counterpart is *luminarian*.



[Centgender](#)

Category: Polygender, Miscellaneous Genders

Centgender refers to the experience of having 100 or more genders.



[Centraunen](#)

Category: Centrigender, Auingender

Centraunen is an autonomous gender that is also *centrine*, meaning it exists between two or more genders. It is autonomous specifically because of its placement between several genders. Any centrigender that has autonomy specifically as a result of it being a centrigender can be called centraunen.



[Centraut](#)

Category: Maverine, Aporine, Outherine, Centrigender, Auingender

Centraut is a maverine gender that is also centrine, meaning it exists between two or more genders. It is autonomous specifically because of its placement between several genders. Any centrigender that has autonomy and a personal inner conviction of gender *as a result* of it being a centrigender can be called centrautic.



Centrine

Category: Gender Quality, Centrigender

Centrine is a gender quality for centrigenders, midgenders, midbinary genders, and any of those that sit between two genders. It can include androgynous genders and lingenders. This identity is centrine-in-nature (CENIN.)



Centrinic

Category: Polygender, Centrigender, Coregenic

Centrinic refers to having a centrigender no matter how the rest of your gender changes or moves.

One can be fluid between many non-*centrine* identities while centrigender remains the "base" of the identity, or one can fluctuate between intensities of gender while the centrigender stays present. Centrigenders include androgyne, neutremme, neutromme, androx, gynx, neutrangi, trinteri, and many more.



Centrivir

Category: Gendervir, Centrigender

Centrivir is a gender that feels like it sits between two different *gendervir* identities. It is a type of centrigender.



Centrivoird

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Centrivoird is a part of the *voidic genders* and refers to voidness as the core of one's identity.



Chandrean

Category: Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Chandrean is a gender that is linked to soft celestial xenine energy. It is part of the celestial

gender system and its void-aligned counterpart is *quasarian*.



Circamaverine

Category: Maverine, Proximal Genders

Circamaverine is a gender that moves around and toward maverinity but never falls entirely within it. It is similar to proxveri but is a gender that changes, shifts, moves, spikes, and flows. It is similar to *mavouthrainic*, but is less specific



Colorvir

Category: Gendervir, Alignment, Xenovir, Xiaspec

Colorvir is a *xenovir* identity related to or aligned with the concept of color. An example could be blue-colorvir, which is someone who is either *gendervir* and bluegender or a blue-aligned gendervir person.



Constellarian

Category: Outherine, Space Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Constellarian is a gender that is linked to soft celestial outharine energy. It is part of the celestial gender system and its void-aligned counterpart is *asterettian*.



Constellatic

Category: Polygender, Space Related Genders

Constellatic refers to having more than one gender that are all linked or related in some way. This word comes from “constellation”, which is a cluster of stars that make up a recognizable pattern.



Constellation-aligned

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Constellation-aligned is a cold, multifaceted alignment that is complex and solid. May feel as though the individual parts of the alignment make up one larger alignment identity. Associated with starlight and astrology. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



Constellavir

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Polygender, Polyvir, Space Related Genders

Constellavir refers to having both a space-related gender and two or more *gendervir* identities; a combination of a space-related gender and *polyvir*. This could also mean being aligned with some aspect of space while being polyvir.



[Contermic Bigender](#)

Category: Polygender, Miscellaneous Genders, Bigender

Contermic bigender is having two genders that seem very close together or that overlap in some way.



[Coregenic](#)

Category: Polygender, Coregenic

Coregenic is a type of gender that stays the same at its “baseline” no matter how much the gender around it changes or moves. It is an umbrella term for various types of genders that remain the same at their baseline and can include genderfluid, genderflux, or other types of genders.



[Cosmaverine](#)

Category: Aporine, Abinary, Outherine, Maverine, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Auingender

Cosmaverine refers to a maverine person whose gender is connected to space, planetary bodies, galaxies, and/or stars. This could mean someone who is maverine-aligned with a space-related xenogender or a maverique person aligned with a space-related gender or quality. This may also be seen as a multigender identity, being bigender with one maverine gender and one space-related gender.



[Cosmonautic](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Space Related Genders

Cosmonautic is an identity that is influenced by the vastness of space and a yearning for adventure beyond the stars. It fluctuates with cosmic energy, taking on aspects comparable to starlight, deep space, colorful galaxies, and distant unexplored planets.



[Crescevoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Crescevoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to a voidness that expands or contracts; can be considered gendervoidflux.



[Cytokinic](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Polygender

Cytokinic is a gender that splits off into smaller, similar genders much like how a cell divides. It may feel like these smaller genders are specific identities or it may simply feel like one's gender is made up of many small unidentifiable parts.

Letter: D



[Damocloidian](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders, Auingender

Damocloidian is a maverine-aligned identity that is part of the Galactian Alignment System.

This term comes from “damocloid”, a type of minor planet with an eccentric orbit.



[Demi-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment

Demi-aligned means having a partial alignment. One could be demi-male aligned, demi-xeno aligned, demi-agender aligned, and many others.



[Demi-cosmoic](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Demi-cosmoic is any partial relation to or alignment with a *cosmoic alignment*. This covers identities such as *demi-void aligned*, *demi-quark aligned*, *demi-planet aligned*, etc. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



[Demiera](#)

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Demigender

Demiera refers to any and all identities that are partially related to or partially aligned with erahood (being *genderera*.) It may have an additional part to the identity.

This term can also be used on its own to simply mean a partially genderera person, much like how "demigirl" and "demiboy" are used.



[Deminoxavire](#)

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Xenoavire, Xiaspec, Liaspec, Demigender

Deminoxavire is a partially or wholly *genderavire* person whose gender is partially tied to darkness and an overall feeling of nighttime; partially *noxavire*.



[Deminoxera](#)

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Xenoera, Xiaspec, Demigender

Deminoxera is a partially or wholly *genderera* person whose gender is partially tied to darkness and an overall feeling of nighttime; partially *noxera*.



[Deminoxvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Demigender

Deminoxvir is a partially or wholly *gendervir* person whose gender is partially tied to darkness and an overall feeling of nighttime; partially *noxvir*.



[Demivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Demigender

Demivir refers to any and all identities that are partially related to or partially aligned with virhood (being *gendervir*.) It may have an additional part to the identity.

This term can also be used on its own to simply mean a partially gendervir person, much like how "demiboy" and "demigirl" are used.



[Demivirflux](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Genderflux, Virflux, Demigender

Demivirflux is a partial, static *gendervir* identity that partly fluctuates. It is a demiflux gendervir identity.



[Demivoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders, Demigender

Demivoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to being partially gendervoid or void of gender.



[Demixenic](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Demigender

Demixenic means having a partial xenic or xeno-aligned gender.



[Diaproximal](#)

Category: Centrigender

Diaproximal is a subset of centrigenders that miss certain, most, or all aspects of the genders it's in between. It also may encompass genders that still resemble a little bit of its 'extremities', such as proximal genders.



[Diphorian](#)

Category: Alternative Terms, Binary Related Genders

Diphorian is an alternative term to the word "binary", encompassing being a man/boy or a woman/girl. For example, someone may be a diphorian man or a diphorian woman. Someone may consider themselves to be demidiphorian, or they may be bigender with one diphorian gender and one *exterian* gender.



[Dracomav](#)

Category: Alterhuman, Draconic Genders, Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Auingender

Dracomav is a *draconic* identity aligned with maverinity in some way. That may mean being dragonkin and transmaverine, a dragon therian and maverique, or any combination of similar identities. This identity is inherently alterhuman.



[Dracosmic](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Draconic Genders, Space Related Genders

Dracosmic is a gender tied to space and draconity. This does not automatically mean an alterhuman-related gender, though the label can be used as such. This, instead, could be an identity tied to the feeling or aesthetics of dragons.

This is an intentionally flexible term that can include any combination of being space-aligned or having a space gender, being dragonkin, being dragonhearted or a dragon therian, being a starseed or some other astral/alien gender, having a draconic gender or an identity aligned with

dragons, and many others. This gender can be fluid or flux - *dracosmifluid* and *dracosmiflux* respectively. It can be used as a label by itself or with another label.



[Dracosmifluid](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Draconic Genders, Space Related Genders, Genderfluid

Dracosmifluid is being fluid between genders related to space and draconity. It is a fluid *dracosmic* identity.



[Dracosmiflux](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Draconic Genders, Space Related Genders, Genderflux

Dracosmiflux is fluctuating between genders related to space and draconity. It is a fluctuating *dracosmic* identity.



[Dracosmivoid](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Draconic Genders, Space Related Genders, Agiaspec

Dracosmivoid is an identity related to space and draconity that is void-aligned or feels gendervoid in nature, the "core" of it always feeling like the darkness of deep space or the void of a blackhole. It is a *dracosmic* identity that is void in nature.



[Dracovir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Altervir, Alterhuman, Draconic Genders

Dracovir refers to a draconic *gendervir* identity or a gendervir dragonkin. This could also mean someone who is a dragon therian or dragonhearted and gendervir - the usage depends on the individual.

For some otherkin, their kintype may overlap with how they experience gender because of how the species of their kintype views the concept of gender. A male dragon may have an entirely different experience with gender than a male human. However, this does not automatically make the identity xenic.

This is a flexible identity that encompasses any and all alterhuman and male-related experiences and can be used by anyone it resonates with. It can be paired with other identities - one can be dracovirflux or a female-aligned dracovir person for example - or it can be used as an umbrella term for anyone who has multiple genders related to malehood and draconity.



[Dryavir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Alignment, Forestic Alignments

Dryavir is a *gendervir* identity that is intrinsically epicenic and is part of the *forestic alignments*. It isn't automatically a *xenovir* identity, though the individual may choose to use the label in that way.



[Duarian](#)

Category: Bigender, Polygender, Alternative Terms

Duarian is having two distinct genders. This is an alternative word for bigender, much like *exterian*, *aphorian*, and *anodiean*.



[Duoboy](#)

Category: Polygender, Bigender

Duoboy means having two genders - one that is male, and another that is male-related in some way.

Someone who is duoboy could be boy and proxvir, boy and genderfaun, boy and *xenovir*, and many others.



[Duocentrine](#)

Category: Centrigender

Duocentrine is any centrigender that is centered between genders of the same quality. For example, neutremme and neutromme are duocentrine; they are both of a neutral quality. *Angidrox* and *angigynx* may also be duocentrine because they are both androgynous.



[Duogirl](#)

Category: Polygender, Bigender

Duogirl means having two genders - one that is female, and another that is female-related in some way.

Someone who is a duogirl could be girl and *eravoid*, girl and juxera, girl and azuregirl, girl and girlby, and many others.

Letter: E



[Elirgian](#)

Category: Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders

Elirgian is an alignment with gender ambiguity (amingender) and is a part of the Galactian Alignment System.

It is named after an ELIRG, an **Extremely Luminous Infrared Galaxy**, and is reminiscent of the brightest galaxy in the universe known as W2246-0526.



[Enbinic](#)

Category: Polygender, Coregenic, Miscellaneous Genders

Enbinic refers to having a nonbinary-related or nonbinary-aligned gender no matter how the rest of your gender changes or moves.



[Endotriquet](#)

Category: Genderfluid, Miscellaneous Genders

Endotriquet describes a gender that moves along a spectrum of three genders or qualities. It is not automatically a multigender identity, but can change between three genders or qualities (which includes experiencing all proximals and centrinites.) You would say "My gender is endotriquet" or "I have an endotriquet gender", though some may choose to say "I am endotriquet." The noun form is "endotriquity."



[Envoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Miscellaneous Genders

Envoid refers to when one's nonbinary identity is influenced by gendervoidness.



[Eosian](#)

Category: Liaspec, Space Related Genders, Galactian Alignment

Eosian is an androgyne-aligned identity that is part of the galactian alignment system. Androgyne refers to a gender that is both male and female, which differs from androgynous but often falls under it. This makes eosian similar to calypsian, an androgynous galactian alignment, but not the same thing. Any one of any gender may be androgynous, but androgyne is a specific gender.



[Epinine](#)

Category: Gender Quality

Epinine is a gender quality related to epigender and similar genders. It can include xenogender, gendervast, gender infinity, pangender, maverique, outharine genders, exorgender, and any gender that feels like it exists above or beyond the gender spectrum. The noun form is *epininity*. It is epinine-in-nature.



[Eraenine](#)

Category: Outharine, Abinary, Umbine, Gender Quality

Eraenine is a gender quality for umbine femalehood - that is, an outharinity that can be compared to femalehood but lies outside the *ordinous* qualities of masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral.



[Erasoft](#)

Category: Genderera, Miscellaneous Genders

Erasoft is a “soft” *genderera* identity. It can also mean having a connection to “soft” erahood. Softness can mean a number of things to the individual, but it can include a slight connection to being genderera (*demiera*.)



[Eratrois](#)

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Niaspec, Demigender

Eratrois (to be renamed “neutroera”) is an identity that is part *genderera* and part neutrois. This could manifest as two partial genders or a bigender experience with two whole genders. Some eratrois people may be a female-aligned neutrois person or a neutral-aligned woman, or they may be both juxera and neutrois at the same time - the usage is entirely up to the person. This identity is under the multigender, demigender, and genderera umbrellas.

Eratrois is similar to *eratum*, which is part genderera and part gender neutral. The difference is that neutrois encompasses many gender experiences including being genderless, neutral, aporagender, and more while “gender neutral” specifically refers to neutrality or a neutral alignment.



[Eratum](#)

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Niaspec, Demigender

Eratum is an identity that is part *genderera* and part neutral. While it may be similar to *eratrois*,

the difference is that *eratrums* are specifically part neutrois whereas *eratrums* can be any neutral identity.



[Eratrumflux](#)

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Niaspec, Genderflux, Demigender

Eratrumflux refers to having a neutral *genderera* identity that fluctuates. It can be a fluctuating *eratrums* or *eratrums* identity.



[Eravoid](#)

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Agiaspec, Demigender

Eravoid is an identity that is part *genderera*, part gendervoid. This could mean a bi-era identity or a *demiera* identity depending on how the individual wishes to use the label.



[Erenic](#)

Category: Genderera, Polyera, Polygender, Coregenic

Erenic refers to having a *genderera* identity no matter how the rest of your gender changes or moves.

This could mean being fluid between many genders, but *genderera* is always present, or it could mean floating between other related identities with a *genderera* "baseline".



[Erique](#)

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Demigender

Erique is another way to say "demigirl". It was created as a more inclusive way to refer to demigirls, demigals, demi-women, and similar identities. It is specific to being a demigirl and is not interchangeable with *demiera*.



[Esquine](#)

Category: Gender Quality

Esquine is a quality for proximal genders, alignments, and any gender that is meant to be similar to another gender or that is compared to another gender. Maveresque and neutresque can be *esquine* genders, as well as genders like *juxera* and *proxvir*. The noun form is *esquinity*.



Eternitempic

Category: Polygender, Miscellaneous Genders, Beyond Pangender

Eternitempic is a gender that is experienced through all of time and space. It exists forever through history, evolving and changing as it moves through different events in time but never fully leaving. It feels like a gender that can "time travel".

This gender can be seen as a linear, mono-universal counterpart to *infiniversic*, the experience of having every gender from every point in the multiverse all at the same time.



Exiel

Category: Ilyagine, Outherine, Demigender

Exiel is an ilyagender with a very vague or soft feeling of gender. It is similar to demi-ilyagender, but with an overall weak inner sense of gender, and is not inherently a uingender or amingender (meaning it is not undefined nor is it ambiguous.)

Ilyagender is not male, female, or anything neutral and is a tangible presence of gender. In this case, exiel is a very weak presence of gender that might feel like it barely exists or it might even feel fleeting. It exists in the same way as air, something you know exists and you generally know what it's made of, but is a very passively existing unseen thing.



Exodoxaen

Category: Outherine, Xiaspec, Genderpunk, Auingender

Exodoxaen is an outhetine (sometimes xenine) gender that is described as being very unique and independent that refuses to be anywhere near the binary spectrum or neutral spectrum.

There is a voluntary nature to this gender, similar to "gendermaverick", where it refuses to fall within the binary, within neutrality, and sometimes within gender as a concept (if this term is being used in a xenine way.) It is similar to maverique, with an autonomy and inner conviction of gender that places it outside of typical categorization.



Exoplanetarian

Category: Ilyagine, Outherine, Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders

Exoplanetarian is an ilyagine-aligned identity that is part of the Galactian Alignment System.

This term comes from "exoplanet", which is any planet outside of the solar system.



Exordinous

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

Exordinous is a word to describe genders and qualities that do not fall within ordinosity - that is, all genders that are not man, woman, or neutrois and all qualities that are not masculine, feminine, and neutral. This would include outherness, maverinity, ilyaginity, xenity, itherinity, périnity, and anything else outside of ordinous genders or qualities. *Exordinosity* is the noun form. All of the previous examples of exordinous gender qualities have a unifying exordinosity to them.



Exterastervir

Category: Alignment Gendervir, Cosmovir Alignments, Xiaspec

Exterastervir is a *gendervir* person whose xenity and the wonder of distant unknown stars are a central part of their identity. It is part of the *cosmovir alignments*.



Exterian

Category: Alternative Terms

Exterian is any gender that is not entirely male or female. This is an alternative term to nonbinary, similar to terms like “aphorian” and “anodiean.”

Letter: F



Faebie

Category: Referential Language, Diminutive Terms, Abinary, Feminine

Faebie (or *faebie*) is a diminutive referential term for someone who is *faenine*, a gender quality related to abinary femininity. The plural form is *faebies*. A diminutive term typically denotes youth, but it's not uncommon for nonbinary adults to use diminutive terms for themselves (seen in the usage of the term *enby*.)



Faen

Category: Referential Language, Abinary, Feminine

Faen is an age nonspecific referential term for someone who is *faenine*, a gender quality related to abinary femininity. The plural form is *faens*.



Faenan

Category: Referential Language, Abinary, Feminine

Faenan (plural: *faenen*) is an adult referential term for someone who is *faenine* (femininity through an abinary lens.)



[Faenine](#)

Category: Gender Quality, Feminine, Abinary

Faenine is a gender quality related to abinary femininity. It is femininity that does not derive from binarity but can be compared to such. The noun form is *faeninity* and it is faenine-in-nature (or FAEIN.)



[Faeverique](#)

Category: Aporine, Maverine, Feminine, Auingender

Faeverique refers to a feminine-aligned maverique person.



[Faevir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Alignment, Forestic Alignments, Feminine

Faevir is a *gendervir* identity that is intrinsically feminine and is part of the *forestic alignments*. It isn't automatically a *xenovir* identity, though the individual may choose to use the label in that way.



[Faunverique](#)

Category: Aporine, Abinary, Maverine, Masculine, Auingender

Faunverique refers to a masculine-aligned maverique person.



[Faunvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Alignment, Forestic Alignments, Masculine

Faunvir is a *gendervir* identity that is intrinsically masculine and is a part of the *forestic alignments*. It isn't automatically a *xenovir* identity, though the individual may choose to use the label in that way.



[Femanix](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Centrigender, Binary Related Genders

Femanix is a gender that exists in between binary woman and agender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of woman and agender, nor does it derive from the two.



[Femgynx](#)

Category: Centrigender, Liaspec

Femgynx is a gender in between female and gynx. It is a centrigender and is therefore not the combination of female and gynx, nor does it derive from the two. It is the counterpart to *homdrox*.



[Fingynine](#)

Category: Feminine, Gender Quality

Fingynine is a fingender that is *gynine* or has a gyninous quality (that is, a quality related to womanhood.) This may mean someone who has a feminine gender but feels a connection or [alignment](#) to womanhood, but they may not necessarily be a woman. This term is an adjective, but the noun form may be called *fingyne* (as in, “I am a fingyne.”)



[Florafluid](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Genderfluid

Florafluid is an identity where one is fluid between plant-related xenogenders. This can mean being xeno-aligned and being fluid between many plant-related genders (such as genders based on trees, flowers, flower fields, seeds, petals, floral scents, etc.) or being fluid between different floral-inspired xenic gender presentations.



[Fragmevoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Fragmevoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to many small pieces that make up a void-like gender.

Letter: G



[Gender Disobedient](#)

Category: Genderpunk

Gender disobedient is when someone decides that their gender - whether it's related to gendered language, pronouns, presentation, labels, etc. - does not conform to conventional

social or physical categorization of gender. It's the refusal to participate in gender or the abandonment of gender as a construct.

This idea implies a choice to be gender disobedient, similar to labels like genderpunk or "genderfucked". This label does not have to inherently mean genderless, gender neutral, xenogender, or nonbinary. Instead, this identity is implicative of a sociopolitical movement in defiance of society's idea of gender. However, this is NOT a refusal to recognize culture-specific genders nor is it a refusal to recognize anyone else's gender in general. It's a way to answer the question "What is your gender?" with "Not applicable!"

Also called "gender non-compliant".



Genderautumnal

Category: Genderfluid, Xiaspec, Seasonal Gender System

Genderautumnal is a quiet but noticeable gender in warm shades of red, orange, brown, and dark green. It represents a fleeting sense of identity, as if the very sense of self were preparing for sleep not unlike the animals and plants in autumn. This gender is restless, eagerly awaiting the turning of the tides and the changing of the season. It is part of the *Seasonal Gender System*.

"Autumnal" is an adjective for anything to do with the season of autumn.



Genderavire

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Bigender, Liaspec

Genderavire is an umbrella term for being both *gendervir* and *genderera*. Those who are bigender, trigender, ambigender, ambigyne, ambinique, aporagender, epicene, androgyne, genderfluid, or genderflux may use this term if they experience both malehood and femalehood in any way (or an alignment to both.) They may also use this term when they experience an identity that is distantly related to both malehood and femalehood, such as being bigender between proxvir and juxera. A similar term would be "femache", but genderavire encompasses a broader range of identities.

Unlike gendervir and genderera, this term is inherently a polygender identity.

Genderavire is the combination of "gendervir" and "genderera", with the E added to the end to help it stand out from related terms and to change the pronunciation.

It is pronounced *jen-DAIR-uh-VEER*. It may also be called "eravir" or "virera".



Gendercreative

Category: Miscellaneous Genders, Binary Related Genders

Gendercreative is the rebuilding and recreation of binary gender into something new, colorful, unique, and creative. This gender may be something abstract or it may be something tied to a specific experience, such as one's neurotype or otherkinity. Gendercreative may act as another word for genderqueer and can be used as a label by itself, or it can be paired with other labels - meaning, you can be a "gendercreative boy" or you can call yourself "agendercreative".



[Gendered Neutral](#)

Category: Niaspec

Gendered neutral is a gender experience that is neutral with an underlying "genderedness". Examples would be neutrois men and women or binary folks who consider themselves to be gender neutral.



[Genderequinox](#)

Category: Seasonal Gender System, Xiaspec

Genderequinox is a fluctuating gender from the *seasonal gender system* that happens twice in a cycle. This is the point where fluctuations between genders enter a kind of standstill that can feel like all genders are balanced perfectly right before the next change. This gender can feel calm, subdued, or experience changes between genders that are barely perceptible. Genderequinox can be experienced within the *gendervernal* phase and the *genderautumnal* phase.

"Equinox" refers to two points in the year when day and night are equal in length - once in the spring and once in the fall.



[Genderera](#)

Category: Genderera

Genderera is an umbrella term for all female-adjacent, female-aligned, and female-identified genders. Examples would be girl, trans woman, transfem, demigirl, girlflux, nonbinary woman, nixera, juxera, agender girl, nanogirl, etc.

The genderera label has many related neolabels underneath it including agenderera, eraflux, *eravoid*, *eratroids*, *demiera*, and even newly created alignment systems (some of these examples have not yet been coined.) Genderera is an adjective, so you would say that someone is genderera, or that they are a genderera person.

This label can also be used on its own, much like the term "nonbinary".

Someone who has multiple genderera identities would be considered *polyera*. The male-related equivalent would be called *gendervir*.

It is pronounced *JEN-der-AIR-uh*.



[Genderestival](#)

Category: Genderfluid, Xiaspec, Seasonal Gender System

Genderestival is a fiery hot gender that is as expansive as the ocean and as dry as summer beach sand, appearing in harsh hues of red, orange, and yellow. It represents a playful nature and the height of identity self-exploration, much like the temperature reaches a peak. This gender tends to reach some lows and then spikes upwards with much more energy, using up whatever energy it has before it has to experience its sudden change into quietude. It is part of the *Seasonal Gender System*.

"Estival" is the adjective for anything to do with the season of summer.



[Genderhearted](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Genderhearted refers to having a connection to or affinity for a specific gender experience on a deep level without actually being that gender. This person may present themselves as that preferred gender or they may simply enjoy the idea of that gender and want it for their gender hoard.

Genderheartedness can express itself in a variety of ways: Boyhearted individuals may feel a connection to boyhood without actually being that gender, while someone who is xenohearted may feel that kind of connection to being xenogender. The difference between genderheartedness and alignment is that being genderhearted means feeling a deep-level connection, almost spiritually, without being that gender or alignment.

This term is similar to *cupiogender*, where an individual wishes to be a gender but isn't actually that gender.



[Genderhibernal](#)

Category: Genderfluid, Xiaspec, Seasonal Gender System

Genderhibernal is a somber, cold, and absent gender that feels as if it's sleeping beneath the winter snow, appearing in hues of icy blue, sparkling silver, and bright white. It represents rest before a great change, as if the self is hitting a low point before shooting upwards to head toward its peak. This gender has immense amounts of energy and new life vibrating at its core. It is part of the *Seasonal Gender System*.

"Hibernal" is the adjective for anything to do with the season of winter.



[Gendersolstice](#)

Category: Seasonal Gender System, Xiaspec

Gendersolstice is a fluctuating gender from the *seasonal gender system* that happens twice in a cycle. It can feel like one or more genders is outweighing the rest, or there may be an intense feeling of genderedness overall. This gender can happen within the *genderhibernal* phase and within the *genderestival* phase. When in the genderhibernal phase, it can feel like one's gender aligns with all the wintry themes of that gender. In the genderestival phase, it can feel more like summer.

"Solstice" is a time of year when in winter, the night is the longest. In summer, it's when day is the longest.



Genderspill

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Genderspill is a multigender identity where one gender feels like it's spilling over into other genders. This may result in mixed or muddy genders.



Gendervernal

Category: Genderfluid, Xiaspec, Seasonal Gender System

Gendervernal is a bright and newly emerging gender that is warm, sunny, and appears in hues of green. It represents exploration of new ideas and facets of identity, spreading until it covers a wide area much like how new plant life can grow and spread. This gender is constantly building up energy that may end up exploding outward. It is part of the *Seasonal Gender System*.

"Vernal" is an adjective for anything to do with the season of spring.



Gendervir

Category: Gendervir

Gendervir is an umbrella term for all male-adjacent, male-aligned, and male-identified genders. Examples would be boy, trans man, transmasculine, demiboy, boyflux, nonbinary man, nixvir, proxvir, agender boy, nanoboy, etc. The experience of having a gendervir identity is called "gendervirhood" or "virhood". It is not an inherently masc-aligned identity and is therefore never considered a mingender.

The gendervir label has many related neolabels underneath it including *polyvir*, *agendervir*, *virflux*, *virvoid*, *neutrovir*, *demivir*, and even newly created alignment systems. It spans many experiences from multigender to genderflux to demigender to xenogender.

Gendervir is an adjective, so you would say that someone is gendervir, or that they are a gendervir person. This label can also be used on its own, much like the term "nonbinary".

This term is pronounced *JEN-der-VEER*.



Gravinous

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

Gravinous: Any non-neutral gender or quality. *Gravinosity* is the noun form.

Gravinous genders can include any non-neutral genders such as male, female, androgyne, maverique, ilyagender, péragender, xenine, and agender. Gravinous qualities would include masculine, feminine, androgynous, outhérine, maverine, xenine, and null. Particular aporinities would apply here as well.



Gravity-aligned

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Gravity-aligned is a heavy and mysterious alignment that weighs on the person and feels like it draws other alignments to it. Moves slowly through both space as well as celestial bodies. May feel like it keeps other alignments "in line" or moves other alignments in a pattern (think planets rotating around a sun.) Associated with celestial bodies and black holes. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



Gonadian

Category: Sex Terms, Miscellaneous Identities

Gonadian is a word to describe someone who only wishes to pursue bottom surgery with no connection to AGAB or gender. It is a *sexadian* label.



Gynangine

Category: Dipherine, Outhérine, Abinary, Liaspec, Feminine, Gender Quality

Gynangine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of androgyny and femininity. It is outhérine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, androgynous and feminine.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities. The masculine version is *andrangine*.



Gynine

Category: Gender Quality

Gynine is a gender quality related to women and girls, which includes most *genderera* identities. It is not the same as feminine, an ideo-quality similar to femalehood but also existing

as its own quality that can overlap with any kind of gender. Gynine specifically separates the idea of femalehood from femininity to avoid the tendency to place the former under the latter (Basically, woman is not a feminine gender. It is a gynine gender.)

Category: Niaspec

Gynineu is a gender that is within the gender-neutral spectrum, but with a strong connection to *gyninity* - this is a gender quality related to femalehood.

Category: Centrigender, Masculine

Herrproche is a gender that exists in between herrlein and homproche. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of herrlein and homproche, nor does it derive from the two.

Category: Centrigender, Liaspec

Homdrox is a gender in between male and androx. It is a centrigender and is therefore not the combination of male and androx, nor does it derive from the two. It is the counterpart to *femgynx*.

Category: Sex Terms, Outherine, Ilyagine

Ilyamel is a sex term for anyone who is ilyagine, an ilyagender gender quality. Sex terms can be used to describe any sex characteristics, both primary and secondary, much like the terms "male" and "female". This may also be called *ilyanox* or *ilyanon*.

Ilyapora is a gender that exists in between ilyagender and aporagender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of ilyagender and aporagender, nor does it derive from the two.

Category: Ilyagine, Feminine, Outherine

Ilyette is an ilyagender that has feminine influences.



[Ilyneu](#)

Category: Ilyagine, Niaspec, Centrigender

Ilyneu is a gender that exists in between ilyagender and epicene. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of ilyagender and epicene, nor does it derive from the two.



[Ilyomme](#)

Category: Ilyagine, Centrigender

Ilyomme is a gender that exists in between ilyagender and male. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of ilyagender and male, nor does it derive from the two.



[Incognavire](#)

Category: Genderavire, Uingender, Liaspec

Incognavire means being part *genderavire*, but unsure of the other part or if there is another part. It is similar to terms like “voidfeminine” and “voidmasculine”.

This term will be renamed soon, as it is confusingly pronounced the same as *incognivir*.

Category: Genderera, Uingender

Incognera means being part *genderera*, but unsure of the other part or if there is another part. It is similar to terms like “voidfeminine” and “voidmasculine”.

Category: Gendervir, Uingender

Incognivir means being part *gendervir*, but unsure of the other part or if there is another part. It is similar to terms like “voidfeminine” and “voidmasculine”.

Category: Agiaspec, Uingender

Incognivoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to voidness that is unknown or undefined.



[Infiniversanull](#)

Category: Polygender, Beyond Pangender

Infiniversanull refers to experiencing all void-aligned, void-related, null, and null-aligned genders from all timeliness within every universe. This is a gender experienced within the context of the multiverse and can work as the antigender to and uncreation of any currently known gender, alignment, or expression - that means that this gender is an extreme extension of pangendernull with a focus on infinity.

This gender can exist all at once or it may feel like it pulls infinitely inward from all directions, creating a tangible intangibility of gender. It is the embodiment of singularity and the antithesis of *infiniversic*.

An *infiniversanull* experience can include fluctuations between genders, fluidity, both at once, or erratic changes between genders and alignments. It can be chaotic or subtle - the experience is variable in all possible ways.

Category: Beyond Pangender

Infiniversic refers to experiencing all genders from all timeliness within every universe. This is a gender experienced within the context of the multiverse and can expand far past any currently

known gender, alignment, or expression - that means that this gender is an extreme extension of pangender.

This gender can exist all at once or it may feel like it expands infinitely in all directions. When asked what your gender is, you may be inclined to say "everything, everywhere, all at once."

An infiniversic experience can include fluctuations between genders, fluidity, both at once, or erratic changes between genders and alignments. It can be chaotic or subtle - the experience is variable in all possible ways.



Infinixenic

Category: Xiaspec, Beyond Pangender

Infinixenic is the experience of having every single existing xenogender as well as xenogenders not yet discovered. This can be an infinitely shifting and expanding experience, or the feeling of being each individual xenogender statically. It is an extension of *panxenic*.

An infinixenic experience may also include an infinite number of xenic presentations, expressions, or alignments that either fluctuate, flow, or remain static depending on the individual.



Interplanetarian

Category: Kenochoric, Celestial Genders, Space Related Genders

Interplanetarian is a gender that is linked to soft celestial kenuous energy. It is part of the celestial gender system.



Intrasine

Category: Gender Quality

Intrasine is a quality for genders that feel like they exist within or close to a range of genders. For example, someone might feel like their gender (or genders) exists in a neutral-to-maverine range, which would be considered an intrasine gender. Some intrasine genders might be within a range of three or more genders as well. Intrasine genders are not centrigenders, but rather genders influenced by multiple aspects on either side of it. It may even feel like it moves along or around this range, changing one's proximity to the genders within it. The noun form is *intrasinity*.



Intringender

Category: In Nature Gender

Intiringender is a gender that is *intrasine*-in-nature (INTRIN), meaning a gender that feels like it

exists within a range of other genders. It is not the same as a centrigender, which normally exists between genders but is not derived from them nor a combination of them.

Category: Celestial Genders, Space Related Genders

Ixionian is a gender that is linked to soft celestial ambiguous energy. It is part of the celestial gender system.

Juparivir is part juparian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.

Juxunknown is a gender that exists in between juxera and (gender) unknown. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of juxera and unknown, nor does it derive from the two.

Juxy (or *juxie*) is a diminutive referential term for an adult who is juxera, a gender that is close to femalehood but exists on its own plane.

Kenoqueer is a kenochoric gender that has an inseparable genderqueer quality. It is the intersection of kenosity and genderqueerness.

Kuiper-aligned refers to tiny, fragmented pieces of alignments that gather together far away from other alignments. May feel cold and slow, and will occasionally overlap with the gravitational pull of other alignments. Associated with asteroids and darkness. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

The Kuiper Belt is a region in the solar system made up of celestial bodies that exist outside of Neptune's orbit.

Kuiperivir is part kuiperian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.

Kymendigen is a gender that exists in between genderfluid and genderstatic. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of genderfluid and genderstatic, nor does it derive from the two.

Category: Gender Quality, Agiaspec

Libragenrine is a gender quality related to libragenders and any identities that are mostly agender with a connection to another gender or quality. Libragenrine-in-nature (LIBRIN.)



[Limenine](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders, Gender Quality

Limenine is a gender quality that encompasses genders that feel like they exist within a “liminal space” or on the edge of other genders. It is not an exclusively kenoine term, but it may be included. This concept of being limenine may be called "gender liminality" or simply "liminal genders." Genders that fall within limeninity may be demigenders, void genders, uingenders, genders that transcend categorization (but not gender itself), proximal genders, and alignments.

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders, Space Related Genders

Linkvoid is part of the *voidic genders* that refers to multiple void genders that are linked or connected in some way.



[Loripsic](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Loripsic is an identity that acts as a sort of “placeholder” gender for those who do not know what their gender is or are currently questioning. It can act as an umbrella term for anyone who is questioning, indifferent about gender, in between changing gender labels, who have an identity that is too complicated to explain, or who do not wish to disclose their labels.

Loripsic is a gender on its own and is not intended to be combined with any other gender labels, though similar genders may include graygender, cassgender, and quoigender.

“Loripsic” comes from the filler text “Lorem Ipsum”, which is a nonsensical text block used as a placeholder where you would later add the required text.



[Loquite](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Abinary, Auingender

Loquite is a gender based on maverique in that it is not agender, but also not related to the binary genders in any way, and is based on a strong emotion. This gender wishes to be heard and is loud and proud about its presence, hoping to find connections to other people in the community with a similar gender experience. It takes pride in how it's described as a gender that stands out from the rest.

Category: Alignment, Gendervir, Cosmovir Alignments, Xiaspec

Lumevir is a *gendervir* person whose epicenity and the combined power of planetary bodies in a solar system are a central part of their identity. It is part of the *cosmovir alignments*.



Lumin

Category: Niaspec, Aporine, Referential Language, Space Related Genders

Lumin is an age nonspecific referential term for someone who is *asteresque*, used like the word "man" or "woman." The plural form is *lumins*. This term may also be called *lux* (plural: *luxes*.)



Luminarian

Category: Ilyagine, Outherine, Space Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Luminarian is a gender that is linked to the void and fluctuates with soft celestial ilyagine energy. It is part of the celestial gender system and is the void-aligned counterpart to *centaurian*.



Lunar-aligned

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Lunar-aligned is a quiet, slow, and cold alignment with a fixed course through space. May align with softness or grace. Associated with water and lunar eclipses. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



Lunavir

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders

Lunavir is a *gendervir* identity that relates to the aesthetic or feeling of a full-moon night. This could be the cool air on one's skin, the reflection of moonlight on a pool of water, or the moon illuminating the otherwise deep dark of night.



Lunavire

Category: Genderavire, Xenoavire, Xiaspec, Polygender, Space Related Genders, Liaspec



Lunettivir

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Feminine, Demigender

Lunettivir is part lunettian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.

Category: Vocorian

Lusteraen a *vocorian* gender that feels like it lights up a room and stretches out in all directions in a way that is bright and noticeable by all.



[Luxbinary](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Binary Related Genders

Luxbinary is an attempt to align one's binary gender with bright lights, being aligned with a *neobinary* identity that is related to light, or having a xenobinary gender related to light.

Category: Abinary, Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Diminutive Terms, Referential Language, Auingender

Maeboy is a diminutive term for someone who is a maverine *aeboy*, a diminutive combination of nonbinary, abinary, and man. It is similar to enby, a diminutive term for a nonbinary person. Diminutive terms usually denote youth, but can be used by anyone who relates to those terms. This term may also be called "maemaby".

Maen is an age nonspecific referential term for someone who is *maenine*, a gender quality related to abinary masculinity. The plural form is *maens*.

Maenan (plural: *maenen*) is an adult referential term for someone who is *maenine* (masculinity through an abinary lens.)

Category: Gender Quality, Masculine, Abinary

Maenine is a gender quality related to abinary masculinity. It is masculinity that does not derive from binarity but can be compared to such. The noun form is *maeninity* and it is maenine-in-nature (or MAEIN.)

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Magnevoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to a gender that is pulled toward a void-like center.



[Masque](#)

Category: Masculine

Masque is a masculinely queer expression, presentation, or aspect of gender. This may manifest as gender nonconformity that is masculine at its core or it may refer to performance masculinity (as in masculine drag.) Masquehood includes gender fuckery, cross-dressing, drag, gender nonconformity, and any identity that is the result of queering masculinity.

Mavapora is a gender that exists in between maverique and aporagender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of maverique and aporagender, nor does it derive from the two.

Mavautre is a gender between maverique and outhetine. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of maverique and outhetine, nor does it derive from the two.



Maverera

Category: Genderera, Demiera, Polyera, Polygender, Demigender, Maverine

Maverera is part *genderera*, part maverique. This could mean a bi-era identity, or a *demiera* identity.



Maverivir

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Maverine, Outherine, Polymaverine, Demigender, Auingender

Maverivir means being part *gendervir*, part maverique. This could mean a *bivir* identity, or a *demivir* identity.



Mavilya

Category: Maverine, Ilyagine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Centrigender, Auingender

Mavilya is a gender that exists in between maverique and ilyagender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of maverique and ilyagender, nor does it derive from the two.



Mavnymangi

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Liaspec, Polymaverine, Auingender

Mavnymangi is a gender that is a maverine nymangi gender, meaning it is a maverine gender that is also abinary and androgynous. It is similar to *renexaen*, which is a maverine gender that is outhetine and androgynous.



Mavouthrainic

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Auingender

Mavouthrainic is a maverine gender that moves from outhetinity to aporinity and back again, as if moving closer to and farther from neutrality or another non-outhetine abinary quality. Its proximity to this abinary changes from overlapping it to being entirely away from it. It doesn't

always fluctuate and is often more fluid as it moves in and out, but it can move in a variety of ways depending on the individual.



Mavrest

Category: Maverine, Ilyagine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Auingender

Mavrest is a word for a gender that is both ilyagine and maverine. It is not a combination of maverique and ilyagender, but exists outside of these as its own autonomous, outharine gender. It is a way to say "I definitely have a gender that is not masculine, feminine, neutral, or null but is entirely autonomous-in-nature and nothing more."



Mavric

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Alignment, Auingender

Mavric is a term for someone who is maverine-aligned. It is an adjective and so someone would say "I am mavric" or "My gender is mavric."



Mavrifaen

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Feminine, Auingender

Mavrifaen is maverine gender with a quality that is adjacent to femininity, but exists on its own in opposition to the concept. It can be compared to "fem-like" concepts but does not stem from binary femininity. It is an outharine, autonomous femininity. The masculine counterpart is *mavrimaen*.



Mavrimaen

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Masculine, Auingender

Mavrimaen is maverine gender with a quality that is adjacent to masculinity, but exists on its own in opposition to the concept. It can be compared to "masc-like" concepts but does not stem from binary masculinity. It is an outharine, autonomous masculinity. The feminine counterpart is *mavrifaen*.



Mavrinx

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Centrigender, Liaspec, Auingender

Mavrinx is a gender between maverique and androgyne. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of maverique and androgyne, nor does it derive from the two.



Mavrox

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Liaspec, Centrigender, Auingender

Mavrox is a gender between maverique and androx. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of maverique and androx, nor does it derive from the two.



Mavrynx

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Liaspec, Centrigender, Auingender

Mavrynx is a gender between maverique and gynx. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of maverique and gynx, nor does it derive from the two.



Melouine

Category: Centrigender, Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Auingender

Melouine is a gender that exists in between melauche and jouine. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of melauche and jouine, nor does it derive from the two.



Mercurivir

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Demigender

Mercurivir is part mercurian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.



Metanine

Category: Outherine, Gender Quality

Metanine is an outharine gender quality encompassing Category 1 outharinities - entirely new, apart from "those other four" (the *ordinous* qualities of masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral) yet not exactly xenine. This means all outharinities that are entirely *exordinous* with no comparison to them or derivation would be considered metanine. The noun form is *metaninity*.



Midkenuous

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

Midkenuous is a kenuous identity that feels like it's "locked" between realms or maybe even between genders. That in-between area can feel like a liminal space itself. "Midkenosity" is the experience of being midkenous.



[Mistvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Demigender

Mistvir is an experience that feels very vaguely *gendervir*, the amount of gender feeling like it's everywhere and yet barely felt.

While it's similar to the term nanoboy, the difference is that it encompasses extreme gendervagueness within the larger gendervir umbrella. It also has the added feeling of being ever-present but hazy.

Category: Centrigender

Monomulti is a gender that exists in between monogender and multigender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of monogender and multigender, nor does it derive from the two.



[Mulberry Transmaverine](#)

Category: Maverine, Masculine, Niaspec

Mulberry transmaverine describes a transmaverine (transmav) person that presents in a way that looks traditionally "soft masc" but has an entirely autonomous, outh erine form of expression. Presentation for a mulberry transmav may stay within the neutral-to-masc range but never overly masculine and never with the intent to call it masculine. The feminine version is blueberry transmaverine.

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Abinary, Auingender

Multimav is a maverine gender made up of several "elements". It is not a multigender maverine experience (see *polymaverine* for this.)

This could mean maverinity that is comprised of femininity, masculinity, neutrality, nullity, positivity, negativity, or even infinity. It is one maverine gender with multiple components of any kind, those components being gender qualities, aspects, or elements.

Multimin is a multimasculine identity where one is masculinely gendered but experiences other genders as well.



[Multinix](#)

Category: Centrigender, Agiaspec

Multinix is a gender that exists in between multigender and agender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of multigender and agender, nor does it derive from the two.



[Multivoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Multivoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to having multiple genders with void-like qualities.



[Myriadian](#)

Category: Polygender, Alternative Terms

Myriadian is any gender made up of multiple genders or parts. This is an alternative term for multigender, much like exterian, aphorian, and anodiean.

Category: Genderflux, Miscellaneous Genders

Nadirine is the experience of reaching the lowest point of a "spike" in one's gender fluctuation. It doesn't describe a person, but a gender. When a gender feels nadirine, it feels like it's reached a minimum point or even lower.



[Nebula-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Nebula-aligned is a fluid, colorful, and bright alignment that floats slowly through the cold void of space. May often feel cloudy or intangible. Associated with the alignment of supernovae and with stars. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

A nebula is the dust and gas thrown out after a dying star explodes.



[Neobinarine](#)

Category: Gender Quality, Binary Related Genders

Neobinarine is a gender quality for *neobinary* genders and any genders attempting to reshape binarity for oneself. Neobinarine-in-nature (NEOBIN.)



[Neobinary](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders, Binary Related Genders

Neobinary is a gender experience that exists to reshape and redefine the gender binary. An individual who is neobinary or who considers emself to have a neobinary experience may partially or mostly relate to the gender binary but can decide that eir connection to the binary is outside of conventional standards of gender categorization. This is genderqueerness and genderfuckery specifically within the scope of the gender binary.



[Neutronian](#)

Category: Maverine, Space-Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Neutronian is a gender that is linked to the void and fluctuates with soft celestial maverine energy. It is part of the celestial gender system and it is the void-aligned counterpart to *rigelian*.



[Neptunivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Masculine, Demigender

Neptunivir is part neptunian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.



[Neudrox](#)

Category: Niaspec, Liaspec, Centrigender

Neudrox is a gender between neutral and androx. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of neutral and androx, nor does it derive from the two.



[Neufae](#)

Category: Genderfluid, Niaspec

Neufae is an identity that is fluid between genders that are not miaspec or man-aligned, but with

gender neutrality at its core.



[Neufaun](#)

Category: Genderfluid, Niaspec

Neufaun is an identity that is fluid between genders that are not fiaspec or woman-aligned, but with gender neutrality at its core.



[Neugynx](#)

Category: Niaspec, Liaspec, Centrigender

Neugynx is a gender between neutral and gynx. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of neutral and gynx, nor does it derive from the two.



[Neumeline](#)

Category: Niaspec, Sex Terms, Gender Quality, Abinary

Neumeline is a gender quality specifically tied to neutrois physiology, either to describe one's sex characteristics or to describe one's outward neutral appearance. It comes from neumel, a neutral sex label. It is exclusive to neutral sex labels but can be extended to terms like aporale, enbinmel, abinmel, and even xaemel if it includes neutrality in some way.

Category: Neurogender, Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Auingender, Exclusive Identities

Neuromav is a maverine identity that exists due to one's neurotype. This could mean one's maverine identity being influenced by being autistic, plural, or any other neurotype, or it could mean that your gender literally feels like a neurotype.

This term can also be called "neuromaverine."

Category: Gendervir, Miscellaneous Genders, Neurogender Exclusive Identities

Neurovir is a *gendervir* identity that exists due to one's neurotype. This could mean one's gendervir identity being influenced by being autistic, plural, or any other neurotype, or it could mean that your gender literally feels like a neurotype.



Neutramav

Category: Maverine, Aporine, Abinary, Niaspec, Demigender, Auingender

Neutramav is a gender that is partially neutral and partially maverine. This could be both a bigender and a demigender identity.



Neutrautonomie

Category: Maverine, Aporine, Abinary, Niaspec, Auingender

Neutrautonomie is a gender between neutral and maverique. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of neutral and maverique, nor does it derive from the two.



Neutrinic

Category: Niaspec, Polygender, Coregenic, Miscellaneous Genders

Neutrinic refers to having a neutral-related or neutral-aligned gender no matter how the rest of your gender changes or moves.

This could mean being fluid between many different genders while some kind of niaspec identity is always present, or it could mean having fluctuations between gender intensity while a neutral gender is always acting as the "base" of the identity.



Neutroisavire

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Niaspec, Liaspec

Neutroisavire is an identity that is part *genderavire* and part neutrois. This could manifest as two partial genders or a bigender experience with two whole genders. Some neutroisavire people may be a genderavire-aligned neutrois person or a neutral-aligned genderavire person, but some may be femache and neutrois at the same time - the usage is entirely up to the person.

Neutroisavire is similar to *nuavire*, which is part genderavire and part gender neutral. The difference is that neutrois encompasses many gender experiences including being genderless, neutral, aporagender, and more while "gender neutral" specifically refers to neutrality or a neutral alignment.

This identity can be pronounced *noo-TROY-uh-VEER* or *noo-TROYZ-uh-VEER*.



Neutrojuxera

Category: Niaspec, Aporine, Abinary, Polygender

Neutrojuxera is a neutral identity that is similar to binary female, but exists on a plane by itself. This can mean being both neutrois and juxera, but this label can encompass any combination of niaspec identity with being *genderera* in some way.



[Neutroprox](#)

Category: Niaspec, Aporine, Abinary, Proximal Genders

Neutroprox is a neutral identity - such as neutrois - that is similar to a binary gender, but exists on a plane by itself.



[Neutroproxvir](#)

Category: Niaspec, Abinary, Polygender, Proximal Genders

Neutroproxvir is a neutral identity that is similar to binary male, but exists on a plane by itself. This can mean being both neutrois and proxvir, but this label can encompass any combination of niaspec identity with being *gendervir* in some way.



[Neutrosine](#)

Category: Gender Quality, Niaspec

Neutrosine is a gender quality specifically related to the neutrois experience.

Neutrosine genders include neutrois, demineutrois, neutroisflux, neutroisfluid, paneutrois, *neutrovir*, *eratrois*, neutresque, neutroix, electrois, nucelotrois, and any other gender related to being neutrois.

This quality is neutral-in-nature (NIN) and a niaspec term. The noun form is *neutrosity* or *neutrosinity*.



[Neutrovir](#)

Category: Niaspec, Gendervir, Demivir, Demigender

Neutrovir is an identity that is part *gendervir* and part neutrois. This could manifest as two partial genders or a bigender experience with two whole genders. Some neutrovir people may be a male-aligned neutrois person or a neutral-aligned man, but some may be proxvir and neutrois at the same time - the usage is entirely up to the person. This identity is under the multigender, demigender, and gendervir umbrellas.

Neutrovir is similar to *viritrum*, which is part gendervir and part gender neutral. The difference is that neutrois encompasses many gender experiences including being genderless, neutral,

aporagender, and more while "gender neutral" specifically refers to neutrality or a neutral alignment.



Neuxemme

Category: Niaspec, Centrigender

Neuxemme is a gender between neutral and neutremme. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of neutral and neutremme, nor does it derive from the two.



Neuxomme

Category: Niaspec, Centrigender

Neuxomme is a gender between neutral and neutromme. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of neutral and neutromme, nor does it derive from the two.



Ninxeno

Category: Niaspec, Xiaspec, Polygender

Ninxeno is a gender that is both ningender and xingender at the same time. Ningender is an umbrella term for all genders neutral-in-nature (NIN) and xingender is the same, but for genders that are xenine-in-nature (XIN.) Therefore, ninxeno encompasses a wide range of experiences that are both neutral and xenine at the same time.



Ninxenomav

Category: Niaspec, Xiaspec, Maverine, Aporine, Polygender

Ninxenomav is a gender that is both ningender, xingender, and maverine at the same time. Ningender is an umbrella term for all genders neutral-in-nature (NIN) and xingender is the same, but for genders that are xenine-in-nature (XIN.) Maverine is a gender quality related to autonomous outharine genders like maverique - entirely outside of masculinity, femininity, neutrality, and genderlessness. Therefore, ninxeno encompasses a wide range of experiences that are both neutral and xenine at the same time.



Ninxenouthier

Category: Niaspec, Xiaspec, Outharine, Polygender

Ninxenouthier is a gender that is both ningender, xingender, and outharine at the same time. Ningender is an umbrella term for all genders neutral-in-nature (NIN) and xingender is the same, but for genders that are xenine-in-nature (XIN.) Outharine is a gender quality entirely outside of masculinity, femininity, neutrality, and genderlessness. Therefore, ninxenouthier

encompasses a wide range of experiences that are both neutral and xenine at the same time.



[Nixangine](#)

Category: Dipherine, Outherine, Abinary, Agiaspec, Liaspec

Nixangine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of androgyny and genderlessness. It is outharine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, androgynous and agender.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities.



[Nixastrine](#)

Category: Dipherine, Outherine, Abinary, Agiaspec, Niaspec

Nixastrine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of agender and neutrality. Dipherine is an outharine quality that results from the combination of *ordinous* qualities - masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral. It is not a bigender identity, but two qualities coming together to create a singular identity.



[Nixaut](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Agiaspec, Auingender

Nixaut is a genderless maverinity. It is not the blend of agender and maverine, but a genderlessness that is autonomous. It is a "strong inner sense of genderlessness" which means it excludes feelings of vagueness, blurriness, voidness, "gray" gender, questioning, or confusion.

Category: Alternative Terms, Agiaspec

Nixian: A lack of gender identity. This is an alternative term for agender, similar to terms like "aphorian" and "anodiean." It may also be called *nihilian*.



[Nixinine](#)

Category: Dipherine, Outherine, Abinary, Agiaspec, Feminine, Gender Quality

Nixinine is a dipherine gender quality that is both agender and feminine. It is outharine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, agender and feminine.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities. The masculine counterpart is *nixuline*.



[Nixuline](#)

Category: Dipherine, Outherine, Abinary, Agiaspec, Masculine

Nixuline is a dipherine gender quality that is both agender and masculine. It is outharine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, agender and feminine.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities. The feminine counterpart is *nixinine*.



[Noctfluid](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Genderfluid

Noctfluid is an identity where one is fluid between night-related xenogenders. This can mean being xeno-aligned and being fluid between many night-related genders (such as genders based on nighttime, stars, the moon, darkness, etc.) or being fluid between different nocturnal-inspired xenic gender presentations.



[Non Assignata](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Non assignata (or “non-assignata”) refers to having no assigned gender at birth (AGAB.) This has system headmates in mind but can have other uses. Someone who is non assignata can have any gender at all and are not inherently genderless - the only distinction is that the individual did not have a gender assigned to them at birth. "Birth" refers to creation or arrival in the context of headmates or alters in plural systems

“Non assignata” is Latin for “not assigned”.



[Non-gendered](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Non-gendered refers to someone who chooses not to be gendered in any way despite their own gender identity.

For example, someone may be a man but won't want to be referred to in any gendered terms such as guy, sir, man, boy, etc. or want he/him pronouns used on them.



[Non-geno](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Non-geno refers to someone who rejects any kind of gender labels.



[Non-oriented Gender Hoarder](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

A **non-oriented gender hoarder** is someone who does not identify as any identity in their gender hoard.



[Nonfriendgender](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Nonfriendgender is a gender related to nonfriending. This can be related to being aplatonic as well. Nonfriending is typically an aspect identity and can be a version of platonic-repulsed.



[Nonxenic](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Nonxenic (or “axenic”) means having an identity that is not a xenogender and is another way to say anthrogender. It is not a way to say that one is unaligned with being xenogender, just that the individual experiences an anthrogender.



[Noxavire](#)

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Xenoavire, Xiaspec, Liaspec

Noxavire is a partially or wholly *genderavire* person whose gender can be compared to darkness and an overall feeling of nighttime. This can mean being femache-aligned with a connection to nighttime aesthetics, being partially or fully *gendervir* and *genderera* with an alignment to nighttime or darkness, or being fluid between genderavire and nighttime -coric identities. It falls under the *xenoavire* and xenogender umbrellas.



[Noxera](#)

Category: Genderera, Xenoera, Xiaspec

Noxera is a partially or wholly *genderera* person whose gender can be compared to darkness and an overall feeling of nighttime. This can mean being female-aligned with a connection to nighttime aesthetics, being partially or fully female with an alignment to nighttime or darkness, or being fluid between genderera and nighttime -coric identities. It falls under the *xenoera* and xenogender umbrellas.



[Noxvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec

Noxvir is a partially or wholly *gendervir* person whose gender can be compared to darkness and an overall feeling of nighttime. This can mean being male-aligned with a connection to nighttime aesthetics, being partially or fully male with an alignment to nighttime or darkness, or being fluid between gendervir and nighttime -coric identities. It falls under the *xenovir* and xenogender umbrellas.



[Nuavire](#)

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Niaspec, Liaspec

Nuavire is an identity that is part *genderavire* and part neutral. While it may be similar to *neutroisavire*, the difference is that neutroisavire is specifically part neutrois whereas nuavire can be any neutral identity.



[Nullmav](#)

Category: Maverine, Auingender, Uingender, Auingender

Nullmav is a maverinity that nullifies one's gender in some way. It is not a combination of null and maverine qualities, but a nullification caused by maverinity. This is intentionally broad so that people can determine for themselves what nullification of gender means.



[Nullvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Uingender

Nullvir is the undefinable, intangible, nullification, and uncreation of gender in the scope of being *gendervir*, either partially or fully. It is a gendervir identity that is nonexistent but present; a gendered void.



[Nymvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Alignment, Forestic Alignments, Feminine

Nymvir is a *gendervir* identity that is intrinsically feminine and is a part of the *forestic alignments*. It isn't automatically a *xenovir* identity, though the individual may choose to use the label in that way.

Letter: O



[Obscurivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Uingender

Obscurivir is an undefined or ambiguous *gendervir* identity. It is a gendervir uingender or graygender experience.



[Obscuvoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Obscuvoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to voidness that feels ghostly or invisible; the opposite of *tangivoid*.



[Omni-oriented Gender Hoarder](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

An **omni-oriented gender hoarder** is someone who identifies as every identity in their gender hoard.



[Omnigray](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities, Omnine

Omnigray refers to having a gray, hazy, or unknown identity across all aspects; includes graysexual, grayromantic, graygender, etc.



[Omnifem](#)

Category: Polygender, Omnine, Feminine

Omnifem refers to experiencing all or almost all possible feminine experiences within one's culture.



[Omnimasc](#)

Category: Polygender, Omnine, Masculine

Omnimasc refers to experiencing all or almost all possible masculine experiences within one's culture.



[Omnineu](#)

Category: Polygender, Omnine, Niaspec

Omnineu refers to experiencing all or almost all possible neutral experiences within one's culture.



[Omnixen](#)

Category: Polygender, Omnine, Xiaspec

Omnixen refers to experiencing all or almost all possible xenic experiences within one's culture.



[Omnivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Polyvir, Polygender, Omnine

Omnivir means having all or almost all *gendervir* identities within one's culture or experience, or having an uncountable number of gendervir identities. This would exclude identities belonging to groups the individual is not a part of (For example, a gendervir identity tied to being autistic would be inaccessible to an allistic omnivir individual.)

This is similar to *panvir*, but typically involves fewer genders.



[Orbitarian](#)

Category: Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders, Binary Related Genders

Orbitarian is a binary-aligned identity that is part of the Galactian Alignment System.

The name comes from "orbit", which is what any two celestial bodies can do. Anything can orbit something else in space, which helps imply that this identity can be more flexible than just "man and woman" together.



[Ordinous](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

Ordinous is a word to describe genders that fall within the common, pre-existing qualities of masculine, feminine, androgynous, epicene, and neutral. It also describes the genders man, woman, androgyne, and neutrois and anything in between them. *Ordinosity* is the noun form of this word. When we talk about the ordinosity of genders, we're talking about the unifying quality of ordinous genders.



[Othervir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Altvir, Exclusive Identities

Othervir refers to a *gendervir* person whose otherkinity is inseparable from their gender. It is a type of *altvir*.



[Outhapora](#)

Category: Outherine, Aporine, Centrigender

Outhapora is a gender that exists in between outhetine and aporagender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of outhetine and aporagender, nor does it derive from the two.



[Outherera](#)

Category: Genderera, Outherine

Outherera is an outhetine *genderera* person. This could mean someone who is outhetine-aligned and genderera, female-aligned and outhetine, or bigender with one genderera gender and one outhetine gender.



[Outhervir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Outherine

Outhervir is an outhetine *gendervir* person. This could mean someone who is outhetine-aligned and gendervir, male-aligned and outhetine, or bigender with one gendervir gender and one outhetine gender.



[Outhilya](#)

Category: Outherine, Aporine, Centrigender

Outhilya is a gender that exists in between outhetine and ilyagender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of outhetine and ilyagender, nor does it derive from the two.



[Outhraen](#)

Category: Outherine

Outhraen is a monolexic term for an outhetine person, much like how one might call ilyagender

"ilyaen."



[Ouverine](#)

Category: Aporine, Abinary, Maverine, Outherine, Polymaverine, Auingender

Ouverine is the intersection of outherness and maverinity, where the two are inseparable aspects of one's gender.



[Overcast](#)

Category: Vocorian

Overcast is a word for a *vocorian* person who presents in a way that is subdued, dull, or monotone. This term can be used as an adjective or a noun depending on preference. It is the opposite of *brite*.

[Pan-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment

Pan-aligned means having every alignment within one's culture or experience. This means that alignments that are exclusive to a specific culture or specific to a group that experience certain neurotypes are not accessible to a pan-aligned person.



[Pan-neutral](#)

Category: Niaspec

Pan-neutral is having every neutral, ningender, niaspec, and/or neutral-aligned experience within one's culture or experience. It is pangender in an entirely neutral scope.



[Pancentraut](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Centrigender, Auingender

Pancentraut is a maverine gender that feels like it exists between every single gender available to the individual. It is centered between every one of these genders but does not derive from nor is it a combination of said genders. This is a maverine *centrine* pangender experience.



[Panmaverine](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Polymaverine, Polygender, Auingender

Panmaverine is having every maverine, mvingender, mviaspec, and/or maverine-aligned experience within one's culture or experience. It is pangender in an entirely maverine scope.



[Panplurvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Altervir, Neurogender, Exclusive Identities

Panplurvir is a *gendervir* experience where all headmates in a system have some kind of gendervir identity. It falls under the *altervir* umbrella.

It's not uncommon for headmates or alters in a system to have similar gendered experiences, as they can often originate or split off from the same source. They may have a gender that overlaps with the host's or they may all share a consciousness that influences their genders.



[Pantrinary](#)

Category: Polygender

Pantrinary refers to having every single gender that exists within the gender trinary. This would include male, female, neutral, and every single gender in between.



[Panvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Polyvir, Polygender

Panvir means having all *gendervir* identities within one's culture or experience. This would exclude identities belonging to groups the individual is not a part of (For example, a gendervir identity tied to plurality would not be accessible to a panvir singlet.)

It is a more expanded version of *omnivir* because pangender tends to encompass genders not yet discovered, but the two may be used interchangeably.



[Panxenic](#)

Category: Polygender, Xiaspec

Panxenic is the experience of being every xenogender within one's culture or experience.



[Panxenovir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Polyvir, Polygender

Panxenovir refers to having every *xenovir* identity within your culture. This would exclude identities belonging to groups the individual is not a part of (For example, a *gendervir* identity tied to schizophrenia would not be accessible to a non-schizophrenic panxenovir person.)

This identity may also be called “panxenvir”.



[Paratrinary](#)

Category: Proximal Genders, Outherine

Paratrinary is a gender that exists outside of but very near the gender trinary. It's not masculine, feminine, or neutral but is proximal to one or more of those qualities. Paratrinary identities can include proxvir, juxera, or *neutroprox* as well as many others. One may even consider their demigender identity to be paratrinary in some way.

This identity is a proximal gender and, despite the name, is not related to being paragender. The *para-* root word refers to being "alongside" the gender trinary.



[Perplexgender](#)

Category: Genderpunk, Miscellaneous Genders

Perplexgender is a gender that exists solely to confuse others; an identity that is prone to changing at a moment's notice in a way that doesn't make sense. This can take the form of gender nonconformity or gender fuckery, depending on how the individual views their own gender experience.



[Phonan](#)

Category: Vocorian, Referential Language

Phonan is an adult referential term for someone who is *vocorian*. The plural form is *phonen*.



[Photospherian](#)

Category: Galactian Alignment, Alignment, Space Related Genders, Liaspec

Photospherian is a galactian alignment that is both selenian and helian (both female-aligned and male-aligned.) It may not necessarily be feminine-aligned or masculine-aligned. It is similar to *eosian*, which is an androgyne-aligned galactian alignment (but not necessarily androgynous.) It is a liaspec term, meaning it is androgynous-in-nature.



[Planet-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Planet-aligned is a stable, solid, and warm alignment thriving with liveliness. May align with both sunlight or darkness. Associated with weather patterns and gravitational forces. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



[Plurvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Alterhuman, Altervir, Neurogender, Exclusive Identities

Plurvir is *gendervir* identity related to one's plurality. This could mean sharing a gendervir identity with the host, having an entire system whose members are all or mostly gendervir, or a virhood that generally influences the system as a whole.

When all of a system's members are gendervir, it is known as *panplurvir*. When some of them are gendervir, it is *polyplurvir*.



[Plutoivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Demigender

Plutoivir is part plutoian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.



[Polaric Bigender](#)

Category: Polygender, Miscellaneous Genders, Bigender

Polaric bigender means having two genders that seem far apart from one another and never overlap.



[Poly-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment

Poly-aligned means having more than one alignment. It can encompass being *bi-aligned* or *tri-aligned*, but may be used when it's difficult to know how many alignments are being experienced.



[Poly-cosmoic](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Poly-cosmic refers to having multiple cosmoic alignments. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



[Polyaporine](#)

Category: Polygender, Aporine, Abinary

Polyaporine means experiencing multiple aporine genders. Can also be called “polyaingender”.



[Polyera](#)

Category: Genderera, Polygender

Polyera means having multiple *genderera* identities or partial identities. This could mean being a specific genderera identity, but can also be used as a term on its own.



[Polymaverine](#)

Category: Polygender, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Maverine, Polymaverine, Auingender

Polymaverine (or *polyverine*) means experiencing multiple maverine genders. Can also be called “polyAporine”.



[Polyneutral](#)

Category: Polygender, Aporine, Abinary, Niaspec

Polyneutral means experiencing multiple neutral genders. Can also be called “polyningender”.



[Polyneuxenic](#)

Category: Polygender, Aporine, Niaspec, Xiaspec

Polyneuxenic means experiencing multiple neutral and xenic genders.



[Polyplurvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Altervir, Neurogender, Exclusive Identities

Polyplurvir refers to a *gendervir* experience where multiple headmates in a system have some kind of gendervir identity.

It's not uncommon for headmates or alters in a system to have similar gendered experiences, as

they can often originate or split off from the same source. They may have a gender that overlaps with the host's or they may all share a consciousness that influences their genders.



[Polytrinary](#)

Category: Polygender

Polytrinary refers to having each gender from the gender trinary. This would include male, female, and neutral, but also genders that exist in between those.



[Polyvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Polygender

Polyvir means having multiple *gendervir* identities or partial identities. This could mean being a specific gendervir identity, but can also be used as a term on its own.



[Polyvoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Polygender

Polyvoid refers to having more than one void-aligned or void-like gender.



[Polyxenaporine](#)

Category: Polygender, Xiaspec, Aporine, Abinary

Polyxenaporine means experiencing multiple xenic and aporine genders.



[Polyxenic](#)

Category: Polygender, Xiaspec

Polyxenic refers to having multiple xenic identities. This could mean any combination of two or more xenogenders, static or fluid, or fluctuating between multiple xenogenders. This could also apply to having multiple xenic alignments or xeno-aligned expressions.

[Proxan](#)

Category: Referential Language, Proximal Genders

Proxan is a referential term for an adult who is proxvir, a gender that is close to malehood but exists on its own plane. The plural form is *proxen*.

[Proxy](#)

Category: Referential Language, Diminutive Terms, Proximal Genders

Proxy (or *proxie*) is a diminutive referential term for someone who is proxvir, a gender that is close to malehood but exists on its own plane. The plural form is *proxies*.



[Proxvoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Proxvoid is part of the *voidic genders* and is adjacent to the void or having an almost void-like quality.



[Pyxian](#)

Category: Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders

Pyxian is a galactian alignment that is *andrine*-aligned. Andrine is a gender quality related to manhood.

[Quadrarian](#)

Category: Niaspec, Gender Quality, Miscellaneous Identities, Masculine, Feminine

Quadrarian is being masculine, androgynous, feminine, and neutral at the same time. These four terms refer to gender qualities rather than genders, so this identity is not necessarily a multigender one. Someone who is quadrarian can be any gender or genders at all, or they may not even have a gender.



[Quantum-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Quantum-aligned is a paradoxical alignment that is both known and unknown, present and absent. May be complex or simple, and may overlap with many other alignments or none at all. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

Quantum refers to quantum mechanics, which is a theory of how the universe works below the level of atoms.



[Quark-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Quark-aligned is an infinitesimal fraction of an alignment that feels like it's almost not there at all. May feel like it's the very foundation of one's alignment or alignments. Associated with particles. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

Quarks are the incredibly small building blocks of protons and neutrons.



[Quasar-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Quasar-aligned is a chaotic, powerful, and ever-changing alignment that is hazy and massive. Feels like it encompasses every single alignment with a placement in the very center of the cosmoic spectrum, but can also simply influence several alignments at once. Associated with merging galaxies, cosmic expansion, and stars. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

A quasar is a bright and powerful field of energy at the center of a galaxy.



[Quasarian](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Quasarian is a gender that is linked to the void and fluctuates with soft celestial xenine energy. It is part of the celestial gender system and is the void-aligned counterpart to *chandrian*.



[Quintarian](#)

Category: Niaspec, Outherine, Gender Quality, Miscellaneous Identities, Masculine, Feminine

Quintarian is being masculine, androgynous, feminine, neutral, and outharine at the same time. These five terms refer to gender qualities rather than genders, so this identity is not necessarily a multigender one. Someone who is quintarian can be any gender or genders at all, or they may not even have a gender.



[Quoivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Uingender

Quoivir is a *gendervir* uingender or graygender identity that encompasses a number of experiences including:

- Someone who may be gendervir but feels that gender identity and/or existing gender terms don't quite apply to them.
- Someone whose relationship with virhood is complicated; someone who isn't sure whether they experience virhood or what virhood means for them.
- Is using the term as an alternative to "questioning", in order to communicate exhaustion or frustration with searching for a better gendervir identity term for oneself.
- Someone who is gendervir and doesn't care much for gender as a concept.

[Régnavant](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Miscellaneous Genders, Auingender

Régnavant is a maverine gender that feels archaic, as if it existed before concepts like masculine, feminine, neutral, and null existed. It is strongly gendered and almost prehistoric in nature.



[Renexaen](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Auingender

Renexaen is a maverine gender that is androgynous-in-nature without using midbinary concepts. It can be compared to androgyny but is entirely both autonomous and outharine. It does not exist between femininity and masculinity nor can it be compared to them.

Category: Maverine, Space-Related Genders, Celestial Genders

Rigelian is a gender that is linked to soft celestial maverine energy. It is part of the celestial gender system and its void-aligned counterpart is *neutronian*.

[Sarosique](#)

Category: Liaspec, Proximal Genders

Sarosique is an androgynous-like gender or a gender that is proximal to an androgynous gender. It is similar to androgyny but exists on its own plane, much like other proximal genders.



[Satellian](#)

Category: Galactian Alignment, Alignment, Space Related Genders, Feminine, Masculine, Outherine

Satellian is a galactian alignment that is lunarian, solarian, and *spherian* all at once. This means being aligned with femininity, masculinity, and outherinity. It is part of the galactian alignment system.



[Saturnivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Feminine, Masculine, Demigender

Saturnivir is part saturnian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.



[Satusic](#)

Category: Xiaspec

Satusic is a gender experience that feels like it's just waking up in the early hours of a cool morning, barely warmed by the sparse beams of sunlight coming through an open window. This gender feels sleepy, new, foggy, and maybe cool to the touch. "Satus" is Latin for "start", as in starting one's day.



[Satuvir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec

Satuvir is a slightly boyish identity that feels like a cool and foggy early morning. It's fresh and comforting like the early morning hours when the sun is just coming up and the air is sharp but calm. It is the *gendervir* equivalent to satusic. "Satus" is Latin for "start", as in starting one's day, which has been combined with *-vir*.



[Semi-oriented Gender Hoarder](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Identities

A **semi-oriented gender hoarder** is someone who only identifies as some of the identities in their gender hoard.



[Sentirine](#)

Category: Gender Quality, Outherine

Sentirine is a gender quality that is a combination or fluidity between umbine, autonine, and

preterine. The noun form is *sentirinity*. It is intrinsically an outhetine quality.

Sexadian

Category: Sex Terms, Miscellaneous Identities

Sexadian refers to specific identities involving the changing of one's sex characteristics in a way that is not tied to gendered concepts or assigned gender at birth. For example, a sexadian term might be used to describe one's wish to have bottom or top surgery, but without any sort of reference to AGAB or gender.



Simulneufem

Category: Polygender, Niaspec, Feminine

Simulneufem is a neutral identity that is entirely inseparable from one's femininity.



Simulneumasc

Category: Polygender, Niaspec, Masculine

Simulneumasc is a neutral identity that is entirely inseparable from one's masculinity.



Singularity-aligned

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Singularity-aligned is a small and enigmatic red-hot alignment that has the potential to be something bigger. May indicate questioning alignment rather than being sure. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

Singularity refers to the starting point of the Big Bang where all of space was confined into an extremely small amount of space.



Softavire

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Miscellaneous Genders, Liaspec

Softavire is a “soft” *genderavire* identity. It can also mean having a connection to “soft” genderavire-ness. Softness can mean a number of things to the individual, but it can include a slight connection to being genderavire (*demiavire*.)



Solavir

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders

Solavir is a *gendervir* identity that relates to the aesthetic or feeling of a bright sunny day. This could mean the warmth of sunlight on one's skin, the bright sunlight reflecting off a body of water, or beams of sunlight coming in through a window.



Solugender

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Auingender

Solugender is an umbrella term for a system of genders that are maverine as well as another gender quality. It can also be used as a standalone identity.

Much like andergender, one can be solunova, solufaun, solufae, or any variation based on the andergender system.



Solusine

Category: Gender Quality, Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary

Solusine is a gender quality related to *solugender* (both of which were actually coined here.) Anything that is solusine is SOLIN (solusine-in-nature.)



Spherian

Category: Outherine, Aporine, Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders

Spherian is an outhetine-aligned identity that is part of the Galactian Alignment System.

The name refers to the celestial sphere, a radius of astronomical observation oriented around Earth. Since outhetine genders are typically non-xenine, basing it on how Earth views the cosmos is parallel to the idea of basing genders on human gender concepts.



Staravire

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Staravire, Xenoavire, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Liaspec

Staravire refers to being part *genderavire*, part celestial gender. It is a *xenoavire* identity related to soft celestial energy.

This identity could be also a bigender identity with the two genders being a celestial gender and genderavire, or it could be a genderavire identity aligned with a celestial gender.



Starera

Category: Genderera, Starera, Xenoera, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders

Starera refers to being part *genderera*, part celestial gender. It is a *xenoera* identity related to soft celestial energy.

This identity could be also a bi-era identity with the two genders being a celestial gender and genderera, or it could be a genderera identity aligned with a celestial gender.



Starlet

Category: Niaspec, Aporine, Referential Language, Diminutive Terms, Space Related Genders

Starlet is a diminutive referential term for someone who is *asteresque*, used like the word "boy" or "girl." The plural form is *starlets*. Diminutive terms usually denote youth, but can be used by anyone who relates to those terms. This term may also be called *nova* (plural: nova.)



Starvir

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Demigender

Starvir refers to being part *gendervir*, part celestial gender. It is a *xenovir* identity related to soft celestial energy.

This identity could be also a *bivir* identity with the two genders being a celestial gender and gendervir, or it could be a gendervir identity aligned with a celestial gender.



Stellar-aligned

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Stellar-aligned is a large, hot, and bright alignment with a fixed course through space. May be loud or boisterous. Associated with light and solar eclipses. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



Stellarine

Category: Gender Quality, Niaspec, Aporine

Stellarine is a gender quality meant to specifically describe genders that are neutral and aporine. This differs from the use of neutral as a term for alignment or presentation, as it is a more specific description. It may be used as another word for neutrine.



Stellavir

Category: Alignment, Gendervir, Cosmoic Alignments, Xiaspec, Feminine

Stellavir is a *gendervir* person whose femininity and the brightness of nighttime stars are a central part of their identity. It is part of the *cosmovir alignments*.



Supernova-aligned

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Supernova-aligned is a huge and red-hot alignment that seems to expand rapidly in all directions. May feel like it's burning up other alignments around it. Associated with stars. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.

A supernova is the result of the explosion of a star.



Synchrine

Category: Outherine, Gender Quality

Synchrine is an outhetine gender quality encompassing Category 3 outhetinities - uncommon combinations. The "uncommon" part refers to qualities that may be *ordinous* (masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral) or *exordinous* (outside of those four), but will always end up as something new and outhetine when combined. The noun form is *syncrinity*.

Letter: T



Tangivoid

Category: Agiaspec, Voidic Genders

Tangivoid is part of the *voidic genders* and refers to voidness that feels tangible; the opposite of *obscuvoid*.



Tercentric

Category: Centrigender

Tercentric is a centrigender that exists in between any three genders. It isn't automatically a circa-binary gender, as tercentric individuals can have a gender in between genders that are not male, female, or epicene.



Therivir

Category: Gendervir, Altervir, Exclusive Identities

Therivir refers to a *gendervir* person whose therianthropy is inseparable from their gender. Therianthropy can mean identifying as any existing Earth animal or as an animalistic species.

The species of one's theriotype may experience gender differently than humans do, though this doesn't automatically make this identity xenic.



Thoradian

Category: Sex Terms, Miscellaneous Identities

Thoradian is a word to describe someone who only wishes to pursue top surgery with no connection to AGAB or gender. It is a *sexadian* label.



Transalterine

Category: Alterhuman, Transgender, Exclusive Identities

Transalterine is a term for any transgender person who has a connection to or is transitioning toward *alterinity* (as in, some kind of alterine identity.) Transalterinity refers to any identity under the alterhuman umbrella such as otherkinty, therianthropy, plurality, *draconity*, and more. This term is exclusive to alterhumans.

For example, one might decide they want to transition in a way that reflects the species of a nonhuman headmate, or they may wish to present more as their kintype in a way that reflects both their gender and animality. The use of this label depends on the individual.



Transamplius

Category: Transgender

Transamplius is a term describing a transgender experience where one is moving more into one's existing gender rather than moving away from a given gender. For example, someone may feel as though they have always been androgynous and are currently transitioning further into androgyny as a sort of hyperandrogynous or androgynous+ identity, instead of being one gender and transitioning to androgyny (a different gender than the one they started out as.)



Transandrine

Category: Transgender

Transandrine is a transgender identity connected to the gender quality of *andrine* - this is a quality tied to malehood and related genders such as demiboy, libramale, bxy, and most genders under the *gendervir* umbrella. This identity does not necessitate physical transitioning, but may indicate a connection or alignment to andrine aspects



[Transanonbinarine](#)

Category: Transgender, Abinary

Transanonbinarine is a transgender identity related to *anonbinarine*, a gender quality connected to the anonbinary experience. Anonbinary is a gender that is not binary nor is it nonbinary, making it an unlabel of sorts.



[Transfaenine](#)

Category: Transgender, Abinary, Feminine

Transfaenine is a transgender identity connected to *faeninity* (a gender quality for abinary femininity.) This may mean transitioning to faeninity or having some kind of connection to it while being trans - the usage of this term can vary from person to person. It is not the same as transfeminine, which is a trans identity related to either transgender femininity or transgender women (not specifically binary or abinary.)



[Transgynine](#)

Category: Transgender

Transgynine is a transgender identity connected to the gender quality of *gynine* - this is a quality tied to femalehood and related genders such as demigirl, librafemale, gxrl, and most genders under the *genderera* umbrella. This identity does not necessitate physical transitioning, but may indicate a connection or alignment to gynine aspects.



[Transmaenine](#)

Category: Transgender, Abinary, Masculine

Transmaenine is a transgender identity connected to *maeninity* (a gender quality for abinary masculinity.) This may mean transitioning to maeninity or having some kind of connection to it while being trans - the usage of this term can vary from person to person. It is not the same as transmasculine, which is a trans identity related to either transgender masculinity or transgender men (not specifically binary or abinary.)



[Transmaveresque](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Transgender, Auingender

Transmaveresque is the experience of transitioning to or having a connection to maveresquinity (related to the gender of maveresque.) This could mean a trans identity aligned with maverinity, connected to proxverity, or related to maveriquinity in some way. It is a trans identity with a maverine-like or maverique-like quality.



[Transneucetrine](#)

Category: Transgender, Niaspec, Centrigender

Transneucetrine is a transgender identity that is both neutral and *centrine* (a quality related to centrigenders.) It may be used to describe someone who is centrigender and transneutral, or a trans person whose neutrality is a result of being in-between genders.



[Transneutrosine](#)

Category: Transgender, Niaspec, Agenrine

Transneutrosine is a trans identity connected to *neutrosine*, a gender quality specifically tied to neutrois. This may be a more specific subset of transneutral or even transagenrine. Someone who is transneutrosine may feel a connection to the neutrois experience or want to transition toward such.



[Transverinesquine](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Proximal Genders, Transgender, Auingender

Transverinesquine is a trans identity related to being *verinesquine*, meaning a quality proximal to maverinity. Someone who is transverinesquine might have a trans identity similar to maverinity but is not fully maverine. This term may also be called “transveresquine.”



[Transvoid](#)

Category: Agiaspec, Miscellaneous Genders, Transgender

Transvoid refers to when one's transgender identity is influenced by gendervoidness.



[Transxenic](#)

Category: Polygender, Xiaspec, Transgender

Transxenic means being a xenic transgender person. This could mean transitioning to a xenic identity, or simply being a transgender person who is xeno-aligned or identifies with a specific xenogender. It is a broad term, but for those who are xenic and prefer to use the word "trans" to refer to themselves.



[Transxenovir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Polyvir, Polygender, Transgender

Transxenovir refers to a *gendervir* trans person who is either xeno-aligned or xenogender.

Not every *xenovir* (gendervir + xenogender) person is transgender and may prefer to use other labels. If being transgender is important to one's identity, transxenovir may be the best way to describe it.

This identity may also be called *transxenvir*.



[Tri-aligned](#)

Category: Alignment

Tri-aligned means having three alignments.



[Trigenesque](#)

Category: Trigender, Proximal Genders

Trigenesque (also called *trigenderesque*) is a trigender-like gender. It's a way to say "My gender is *almost* trigender, but something keeps it from being fully or literally trigender." One might have partial genders making up the identity or maybe their gender is only made up of proximal genders.



[Trinarian](#)

Category: Gender Quality, Niaspec, Miscellaneous Identities, Masculine, Feminine

Trinarian is being masculine, feminine, and neutral at the same time. These three terms refer to gender qualities rather than genders, so this identity is not necessarily a multigender one (and thus should not be confused with trigender.) Someone who is trinarian can be any gender or genders at all, or they may not even have a gender.



[Trivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Polyvir, Trigender, Polygender

Trivir means having three or more *gendervir* identities. It typically refers to three whole gendervir genders - either static or changing, experienced at the same time or separately. However, it can also be three partial gendervir identities as well.



[Trixenic](#)

Category: Trigender, Polygender, Xiaspec

Trixenic means having three xenic or xeno-aligned genders.



Twain

Category: Referential Language, Bigender, Polygender

Twain is an age-nonspecific referential term for someone who is bigender. The plural form is *twains*. Also called duo (*duos*) or venn (*venns*.)

Letter: U



Uindingen

Category: Centrigender, Uingender

Uindingen is a gender that exists in between uingender and dingender. It is a centrigender and is therefore not a combination of uingender and dingender, nor does it derive from the two.



Unambiguous

Category: Gender Quality

Unambiguous is the quality of genders that are not uingenders or amingenders. That includes ambiguine, ambigue, graygender, quoigender, and similar identities, all of which are not unambiguous. It is unambiguous in nature or UNAMIN (seen in the term *unamingender*.)



Unanimgender

Category: Miscellaneous Genders, In Nature Gender

Unamingender is an umbrella term for any gender that is *unambiguous*-in-nature (UNAMIN.)



Undel

Category: Ilyagine, Outherine

Undel is an ilyagender that ebbs and flows through nonspecific genders or qualities. One's inner sense of gender itself might feel like it changes on a small scale, sometimes imperceptibly or in a way that's hard to describe other than being outhetine in some way. This term can be used as a noun or an adjective.

While this gender does have some nonspecific elements, it is not meant to be ambiguous or a uingender. Instead, it's simply a gender that is not male, female, or neutrois with an inner sense

of gender not as strongly felt as the experience of maverique. It is meant to say "There is definitely a gender there, and it is not X/Y/Z, and it definitely moves in some way."



Unangine

Category: Gender Quality, Dipherine, Outherine, Abinary, Liaspec

Unangine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of androgyny and epicene. It is outharine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, androgynous and epicene.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities.



Unidroine

Category: Abinary, Outherine, Dipherine, Masculine, Gender Quality

Unidroine is a dipherine gender quality that is both epicene and masculine. It is outharine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, epicene and masculine.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities.



Unigynine

Category: Abinary, Outherine, Dipherine, Feminine, Gender Quality

Unigynine is a dipherine gender quality that is both epicene and feminine. It is outharine in nature, created by an uncommon combination of *ordinous* qualities (in this case, epicene and feminine.) It is not a bigender identity, but rather a singular quality made up of other qualities.



Uninixine

Category: Dipherine, Outherine, Abinary, Agiaspec, Gender Quality

Uninixine is a dipherine gender quality that is the combination of agender and epicene. Dipherine is an outharine quality that results from the combination of *ordinous* qualities - masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral. It is not a bigender identity, but two qualities coming together to create a singular identity.

Vacudiean

Category: Alternative Terms, Agiaspec

Vacudiean is a gender that can only be described as a sense of voidness or emptiness where a feeling of *diphorian*, *exterian*, or *aphorian* gender is expected to be. It is an alternative term for

“voidbinary.”



[Variaspec](#)

Category: Miscellaneous Genders

Variaspec is an umbrella term for identities that change, including fluid genders, genders that fluctuate, "spikes" in gender, and genders influenced by external sources such as mood or weather. Any gender that changes in any way can be considered variespec.

Identities that fall under this are genderfluid, genderflux, fluidflux, hydrangeaflux, cosmosflux, affectugender, bordergender, contragender, and genderfluid subsets such as genderfaun.

Someone who is variespec can use many labels found under this umbrella or they may simply call themselves variespec. This identity is interchangeable with amplusian, but was made to match terms like "niaspec" or "aiaspec".



[Velaean](#)

Category: Alignment, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders

Velaean is a galactian alignment that is *gynine*-aligned. Gynine is a gender quality related to womanhood.



[Vemme](#)

Category: Gendervir, Feminine, Referential Language

A **vemme** is a feminine *gendervir* person, similar to the word "femme". This is also called "verre". It is the combination of "vir" and "femme".



[Venusarivir](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Starvir, Xenovir, Xiaspec, Space Related Genders, Feminine, Demigender

Venusarivir is part venusarian, part *gendervir*. It is part of the *starvir* identities.



[Verache](#)

Category: Binary-Related Genders, Liaspec, Maverine

Verache is a gender with both maverine and femache qualities. It is a bigender experience where one is both a man and a woman, while also being maverine. Both individual genders may feel maverine in nature, or the entire bigender identity may be aligned with maverinity. Rarely,

this label might describe a trigender identity of some kind of maverine gender, man, and woman.



[Veran](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Referential Language, Auingender

A **veran** is an adult referential term for a maverine person, used much like the word "enban". The plural form is *veren*.



[Veribinary](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Binary Related Genders, Auingender

Veribinary (or *maveribinary*) is a maverine binary gender. Someone who has a veribinary gender may be both maverine and a man or woman, though it usually isn't a multigender experience. It may feel more like one's binary gender is of a maverine quality.



[Verimel](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Sex Term

Verimel is a sex term for anyone who is maverine. Sex terms can be used to describe any sex characteristics, both primary and secondary, much like the terms "male" and "female". This may also be called "verinox" or "verinon".



[Verinesquine](#)

Category: Maverine, Outherine, Aporine, Proximal Genders, Gender Quality, Auingender

Verinesquine is a quality for all maverine-like genders or qualities, including proxveri and other genders proximal to maverique. Verinesquine genders might also be maverine centrigenders - such as *neutrautonomie*, *mavrox*, or *mavrynx*, or maverine multigenders that cause the gender to be only partially maverine (this might happen if someone is paramaverine or libramaverique, for example.) This term can also be called "veresquine."

Someone who is *transverinesquine* might have a trans identity similar to maverinity but is not fully maverine. This term may also be called "transveresquine."



[Viraenine](#)

Category: Outherine, Abinary, Umbine, Gender Quality

Viraenine is a gender quality for umbine malehood - that is, an outherness that can be compared to malehood but lies outside the *ordinous* qualities of masculine, feminine, androgynous, and neutral.



Virenic

Category: Gendervir, Polygender, Polyvir, Coregenic

Virenic refers to having a *gendervir* identity no matter how the rest of your gender changes or moves.

This could mean being fluid between many genders, but gendervirhood is always present, or it could mean floating between other related identities with a gendervir "baseline".



Virferal

Category: Gendervir, Miscellaneous Genders

Virferal is a vicious or feral *gendervir* identity that may express itself with animalistic instinct. It can be related to therianthropy or otherkinity, but it can also be its own identity separate from alterhumanity.



Virfluid

Category: Gendervir, Genderfluid, Virfluid

Virfluid is a *gendervir* identity that is fluid. It can also be called *gendervirfluid*. It's a term for a smoother change in gender than *virflux*.



Virflux

Category: Gendervir, Genderflux, Virflux

Virflux is a *gendervir* identity that fluctuates.



Virique

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Demigender

Virique is another way to say "demiboy". It was created as a more inclusive way to refer to demiboys, demiguys, demi-men, and similar identities. It is specific to being a demiboy and is not interchangeable with *demivir*.



Viritrum

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Niaspec, Virflux, Demigender

Viritrum is an identity that is part *gendervir* and part neutral. While it may be similar to *neutrovir*, the difference is that neutrovir is specifically part neutrois whereas viritrum can be any neutral identity.



[Viritrumflux](#)

Category: Gendervir, Niaspec, Genderflux, Virflux

Viritrumflux refers to having a neutral *gendervir* identity that fluctuates. It can be a fluctuating *viritrum* or *neutrovir* identity.



[Virliminal](#)

Category: Gendervir, Miscellaneous Genders

Virliminal refers to a *gendervir* person who feels that their gender is linked to or aligned with liminal spaces. This term falls under the kenochoric umbrella and is a kenovir identity. As such, this would not be considered a *xenovir* identity or xenic in any way.

A liminal space is an area that is usually populated but is now deserted. The empty or eerie feeling of being in such a space is called kenopsia. A virliminal individual may feel a sense of unease or emptiness that influences the way their gendervir identity feels, or it may even feel like a lonely gender. It's not quite the emptiness that gendervoidness can feel like, as that emptiness usually refers to a void where one's gender should be.



[Virmythic](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec

Virmythic is a *gendervir* identity that is largely influenced by mythology or mythological creatures. It is a mythical *xenovir* identity.



[Virplex](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Polyvir, Polygender, Demigender

Virplex is an umbrella of *gendervir* terms to describe one's gendervir identity as having multiple parts that make up a whole. It is a more specific *polyvir* identity, where gendered parts come together to create a new polyvir gender.



[Virplush](#)

Category: Gendervir, Xenovir, Xiaspec

Softer than *virsoft*, **virplush** is a soft *gendervir* identity that feels like fluffy clouds or pillows. While it may refer to a soft virhood, it goes further by incorporating a plush softness - this could mean a gender that literally feels plush-like, a feminine gendervir experience, or a gender that is tied to soft aesthetics.



Virpunk

Category: Gendervir, Genderpunk

Virpunk is a colloquial term, within the scope of *gendervir* experiences, for a culture of resistance against gendernormativity; a gendervir identity that in and of itself is a resistance against gender norms, homophobia and transphobia, oppression, and societal status.

This is a sociopolitical identity, much like genderqueer, but specifically for those who fall within the gendervir spectrum - this includes all male, male-aligned, and male-adjacent identities. Someone who is virpunk chooses to subvert the public's assumptions on what it means to be a "man" and challenges the expectations, roles, and stereotypes that come with this identity. It is a very flexible term that can include those who are nonbinary, abinary, polygender, agender, gender nonconforming, and more.



Virsoft

Category: Gendervir, Miscellaneous Genders

Virsoft is a "soft" *gendervir* identity. It can also mean having a connection to "soft" virhood. Softness can mean a number of things to the individual, but it can include a slight connection to being gendervir (*demivir*.)



Virsplit

Category: Gendervir, Polyvir, Polygender

Virsplit is a *gendervir* identity that feels like one gender splitting off into multiple genders like branches. It is a complex *polyvir* experience.



Virstrange

Category: Gendervir, Miscellaneous Genders

Virstrange refers to an incredibly queer and unconventional experience with virhood that may include using a variety of gender terms all at once, expressing one's gender in a quirky or unexpected way, or using unconventional pronouns. This identity can be considered a proximal gender (like proxvir), a *xenovir* identity, an aporagender in some way, or something else that signifies an odd *gendervir* experience.



[Virvoid](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Agiaspec, Demigender

Virvoid is an identity that is part *gendervir*, part gendervoid. This could mean a *bivir* identity or a *demivir* identity depending on how the individual wishes to use the label.



[Virvoidsoft](#)

Category: Gendervir, Demivir, Agiaspec, Demigender

Virvoidsoft refers to having a "soft" gender that is part gendervir, part gendervoid. It can refer to a *virvoid* person with some kind of soft identity or a *virsoft* gendervoid person.

This is not a *xenovir* identity and so it does not have any connection to literal softness such as with pillows or clouds. The softness refers to one's connection to their own gender or the intensity of such gender. This could manifest as very small amounts of virhood or voidness, maybe even to the point of barely being felt.



[Vivin](#)

Category: Vocorian, Referential Language

Vivin is an age-nonspecific referential term for someone who is *vocorian*. The plural form is *vivins*.



[Voc](#)

Category: Vocorian, Referential Language, Diminutive Terms

Voc is a diminutive referential term for someone who is *vocorian*. It is also called **voque**. The plural form is *vocs* (*voques*.)



[Vociaspec](#)

Category: Vocorian

Vociaspec is a term that encompasses any identity within the *vocorian* spectrum of genders, which would include specific *vocingenders* as well as identities proximal to the vocorian experience.



[Vocimav](#)

Category: Maverine, Auingender, Uingender

Vocimav is a gender with a void that can only accommodate a maverine gender. This void feels empty - not blurry but ever-present and tangible. It only feels “filled” when a maverine gender takes up that space, otherwise it stays empty. Someone who is vocimav might have a gender that fluctuates between maverinity and voidness, or ey might have a maverine gender that “moves” in and out of the empty space.



Vocingender

Category: Vocorian, In Nature Gender

Vocingender refers to any genders that are *vocorian-in-nature* (VOCIN.) For example, *lusteræen* is a vocingender, as it is vocorian-in-nature. All genders coined under the vocorian umbrella would be identified the same way.



Vocorian

Category: Vocorian, Miscellaneous Genders

Vocorian is an umbrella term for genders related to the feeling of fullness, being strongly gendered, having a gender that is “loud” or takes up a lot of space, and having a gender that feels intense or abundant. It can be used as a label on its own or it can describe any number of genders that fit these descriptions.

Vocorine

Category: Vocorian, Gender Quality

Vocorine is the gender quality of *vocorian*.



Void-aligned

Category: Alignment, Cosmoic Alignments, Space Related Genders

Void-aligned is a formless, dark, and frigid alignment. May be unaligned or reject alignment altogether. Associated with black holes and deep space. It is part of the *cosmoic alignments*.



Voidavire

Category: Genderavire, Polygender, Agiaspec, Liaspec, Demigender

Voidavire is an identity that is part *genderavire*, part gendervoid. This could mean a bigender identity or a demigender identity depending on how the individual wishes to use the label.



[Voy](#)

Category: Gendervir, Diminutive Terms, Referential Language

A **voy** is what you would call a *gendervir* person, used much like the word "boy" or "man". It is the combination of "vir" and "boy".



[Vutch](#)

Category: Gendervir, Masculine, Referential Language

A **vutch** is a masculine *gendervir* person, used much like the word "butch". It is the combination of "vir" and "butch".

[Xai](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Orientation

Xai refers to a xenic gai person, This is gayness in the context of being xenogender and nonbinary, or gayness that can only be understood by someone who is nonbinary and xenic.



[Xby](#)

Category: Agiaspec

Xby refers to someone who is both agender and nonbinary. This could mean they are void-aligned and nonbinary, nonbinary-aligned in an agender way, or are multigender (agender and nonbinary separately.)



[Xen](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Referential Language

Xen is a noun to describe a xenic person - much like "man" for people who are male.



[Xenby](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Diminutive Terms, Referential Language

Xenby is a xenic nonbinary person. This can mean someone who is xeno-aligned and nonbinary, or xenogender and aligned with some kind of specific nonbinary gender. It can also mean someone who has two genders, one xenogender and one nonbinary.



[Xeno-atypical](#)

Category: Xiaspec

Xeno-atypical refers to someone who doesn't experience a conventional xenic identity. Maybe this means someone who aligns themselves with a binary gender, or someone whose xenogender is very similar to an anthrogender. Maybe they're binary-aligned while being xenogender.



[Xeno-questioning](#)

Category: Xiaspec

Xeno-questioning refers to the experience of questioning whether or not one is xenogender.



[Xenoavire](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Genderavire, Polygender, Liaspec

Xenoavire means having a *genderavire* identity that is xeno-aligned, or being both genderavire and xenic in some way.

This doesn't automatically make the identity multigender, but it may be considered such depending on the individual. Some may simply be a xeno-aligned genderavire person and consider that to be a single gender.



[Xenocryptic](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Uingender

Xenocryptic is a xenogender experience that is hazy, confusing, strange, or "other" in such a way that it feels disconnected from the entire concept of gender. It can be a xeno-aligned identity, a xenogender, a xingender, or a xeno-questioning identity that feels removed from gender *because* of its xenity. It can be considered a xeno-aligned apogender and is similar to "apeirogender."



[Xenoera](#)

Category: Xenoera, Xiaspec, Genderea, Polygender

Xenoera means having a *genderera* identity that is xeno-aligned, or being both genderera and xenic in some way.

This doesn't automatically make the identity multigender, but it may be considered such depending on the individual. Some may simply be a xeno-aligned genderera person and consider that to be a single gender.

This identity may also be called “xenera”.



[Xenogay](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Orientation

Xenogay refers to a xenic gay identity. This could mean being both gay and xenogender or xeno-aligned, or it can be gayness that can only be understood through the lens of xenity.



[Xenogxnder](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Agiaspec

Xenogxnder is a xenic agender identity. This could mean being xeno-aligned and agender, gendervoid in a xenic way, or being multigender (both xenogender and agender.)



[Xenoprox](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Proximal Genders

Xenoprox refers to having a gender that is relative to xenogender, but is something separate and entirely on its own. It doesn't exist outside of the gender spectrum, but may be very close to outside of it. It may also be another way to say "almost xenogender", as if there is a fraction of identity that prevents it from being totally xenogender. This identity falls under the proximal gender umbrella, where you would find terms such as proxvir or juxera.



[Xenoutherine](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Outherine, Aporine, Abinary, Miscellaneous Identities

Xenoutherine is the experience of being both xenine and outhherine at the same time. Xenity and outherinity are both gender qualities and tend to describe genders rather than being genders on their own, but this is entirely dependent on how the individual wishes to use the label. Someone may be aesthetigender and maverique, aporagender and xeno-aligned, or simply outhherine in a xenic way. It is similar to the term *polyxenaporine*.



[Xenosoft](#)

Category: Xiaspec

Xenosoft refers to a "soft" xenic identity. It can also mean having a connection to “soft” xenity. Softness can mean a number of things to the individual, but it can include a slight connection to being xenogender.



[Xenovir](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Xenovir, Gendervir

Xenovir means having a *gendervir* identity that is xeno-aligned, or being both gendervir and xenic in some way.

This doesn't automatically make the identity multigender, but it may be considered such depending on the individual. Some may simply be a xeno-aligned gendervir person and consider that to be a single gender.

This identity may also be called “xenvir”.



[Xenvoid](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Agiaspec

Xenvoid refers to when one's xenogender identity is influenced by gendervoidness.



[Xequinine](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Sex Terms, Gender Quality

Xequinine is a gender quality specifically tied to xenine physiology, either to describe one's sex characteristics or to describe one's outward xenine appearance. It comes from xequinox, a xenine sex label. This can also be called “xequine” or “xeuxeline”.



[Xir](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Xenovir, Gendervir, Referential Language

A **xir** is a xenic gendervir person, similar to the word "man" or "woman". It is the combination of "vir" and the letter X, for xenity. The plural is “xiren”.



[Xull](#)

Category: Xiaspec, Agiaspec, Polygender, Uingender

Xull (or *genderxull*) a combination of xenogender and gendernull. It's the experience of being null of gender as well as xenogender, xenic, or xeno-aligned at the same time.



[Xynth](#)

Category: Referential Language, Xiaspec

Xynth is a referential term for a person or being with no reference to any gender, though it is distinctly not male, female, masculine, feminine, neutral, null, nor anything in between.

It may be used by xenogender folks who feel that their gender is distinct enough to use a unique term not derived from anything else - *xin*, *xenby*, *xip*, *xenan*, etc. still reference an inherent xenity, so someone may prefer to use something else. Xynth is a removal from genderedness without using vague ungendered terms like "person." It is not a genderless term, but can be used to denote one's distance from conventional human gender. It is also inclusive of alterhumans who prefer non-anthropocentric terms.

[Zenithine](#)

Category: Genderflux, Miscellaneous Genders

Zenithine is the experience of reaching the highest point of a "spike" in one's gender fluctuation. It doesn't describe a person, but a gender. When a gender feels zenithine, it feels like it's reached a maximum point or even higher.



[Zephyrian](#)

Category: Niaspec, Galactian Alignment, Space Related Genders, Alignment

Zephyrian is a galactian alignment that is both neutrois-aligned and neutral-aligned (astraeon and hesperian.) It is not inherently a multigender identity, as it is two alignments at the same time, but some multigender people may use it.
