

GOD'S VISION FOR OUR CHURCH

40+ Days of Prayer, Discernment, & Discussion Hudson Valley Cooperative Parish November 11 through December 29, 2024

What is God's desire and vision for YOUR church, the churches within our Hudson Valley Cooperative Parish? Each one of our churches is struggling with financial sustainability, losing key members as they move or pass away, not able to bring in new members, lamenting the small numbers of children and young adults, burning out from trying to meet the critical needs of our communities with too few people to do too much work.

And, yet, we KNOW this is not who or where God wants our church community to be. Our hearts are aching to reach out from that deepest connection of LOVE to serve one another and those in our world in vital and important ways. Our souls are hungering for time and space to be immersed in meaningful worship and deep spiritual grounding and fulfillment. God wants us to THRIVE, not struggle to simply survive!

Last spring, our Parish Council was presented with information and data on the Church and its decline. We recognized that we needed to have some hard conversations about the reality of our

individual congregations, our financial resources, our worship attendance, and our volunteers' ability/time/energy to support our missions and ministries. Some churches may be faced with the immediate decision of closing or merging, and others see those decisions looming on the very near horizon. Pastor Grace offered one vision of how we might meld our churches together to combine our Sunday morning worship experience, identify and address critical community needs with ministry hubs, and pool our resources to become one larger church community instead of many small struggling congregations. We need to consider and explore this and other ideas of how we can become a vibrant, thriving church presence to all of our communities.

We hope you have started having conversations within your Administrative Council and with your church members. That you are asking difficult questions and taking an honest look at the reality of where you are, and given current trajectories, where that is taking you if changes are not made quickly. This is REALLY HARD WORK. It requires soul searching of what church means to you, why you are a part of the community you are in, and whether you are willing to do the work needed to help move our Church to where God is leading us.

Here is an opportunity to enter into these discussions with ALL of the laity across our Parish. As a Church, it is foundational that we ground ourselves in our faith and surround ourselves with prayer and discernment for what God wants of us, to set aside our own desires, concerns, and egos, and to open ourselves to allow the Spirit to work within us and through us. We are asking you to take some time each day to immerse yourself in prayer for your local church, for each church in this Parish, and for wisdom, discernment, and guidance for how we can come together and be a stronger, more effective witness to God's love.

We will gather together once a week via Zoom to discuss the tough issues we are facing, to pull apart those difficult questions, to share what may have surfaced during your prayer time, and to work together to explore how we may step forward. This is a laity driven effort and we need your input. We know everyone's schedules are busy, especially since we are doing this through the Thanksgiving and Christmas seasons, and that you will not be able to make each

discussion. We are meeting on a different day each week so that hopefully you will be able to attend at least some of the sessions:

Sunday, November 17, 4-5:30pm Monday, November 25, 7-8:30pm Tuesday, December 3, 7-8:30pm Wednesday, December 11, 7-8:30pm Thursday, December 19, 7-8:30pm Friday, December 27, 7-8:30pm

I'mWe will then conclude this phase of our prayer, discernment, and discussion work by holding a Wesley Covenant Service:

Common Worship Service, Sunday December 29, 10am (place to be decided) where all churches willing to give up their own Sunday morning worship service on this 5th Sunday can join in one sanctuary for us all to worship together as we enter into the new year.
