This tutorial will go over how to complete and submit an assignment from NoRedInk. NoRedInk is a program that will help you master grammatical concepts through engaging assignments. Make sure you have already [set up a NoRedInk account](#) before starting the assignments from this tutorial.

1. Sign in to [NoRedInk](#) using your Mountain Heights Academy Google account.
Note: If you have previously set up an account but do not remember your username or password, do not set up another one. Contact your teacher for help retrieving your login information.
2. Click on your assignment(s) for the week underneath "Your Assignments."

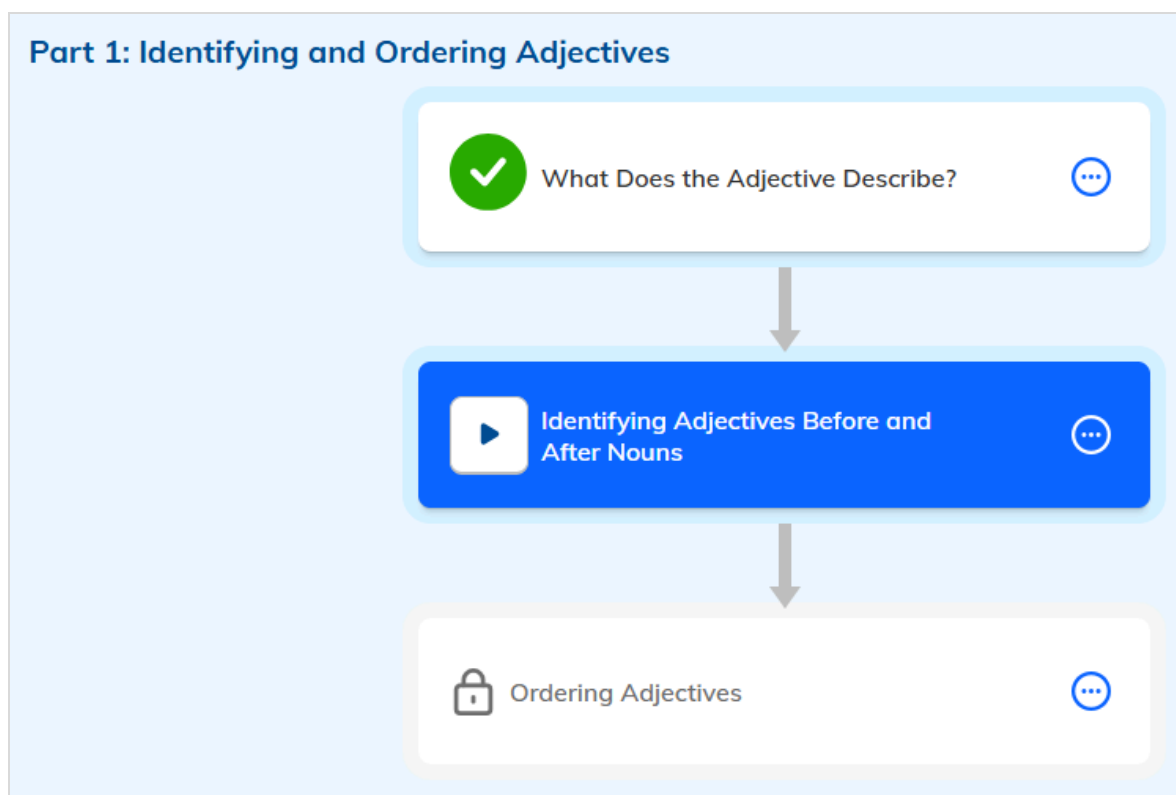

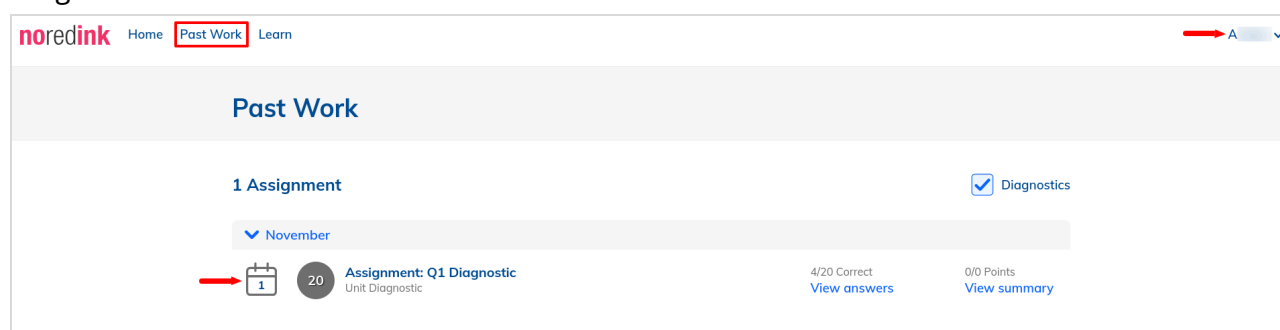
 **Practice: Capitalizing Sentences, Names, and**

- a. If the assignment is a practice assignment , click the **play button** to start completing a topic within an assignment. There may be multiple topics inside of the practice assignment, so

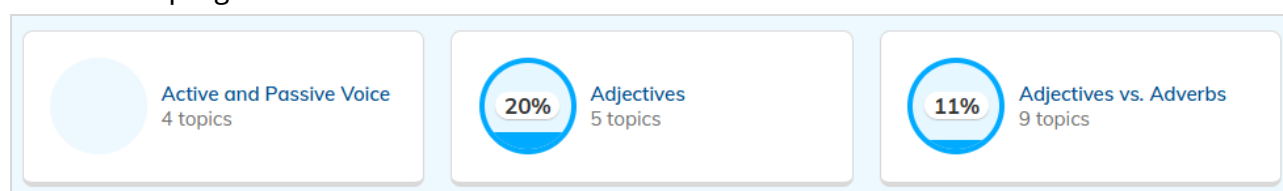
make sure to do them all.
