1. Introduction

The LIVE NOW Chrome Extension allows users to view live and upcoming YouTube live streams from the channels they are subscribed to. This privacy policy explains what data the extension accesses, how it is used, and how we protect your privacy.

2. What Data We Access

To function properly, LIVE NOW requests permission to:

- Authenticate your Google account using the YouTube Data API
- Read your YouTube channel subscriptions
- Fetch public metadata about live or upcoming broadcasts (titles, thumbnails, schedule)

We **do not collect, store, or share** any personal information such as your name, email, or YouTube activity history.

3. How Your Data Is Used

We use your authorized YouTube API access **only** to:

- Identify which subscribed channels are currently live
- Display future scheduled live streams in a calendar-style layout

The access token is used temporarily and only within your browser. **No data is sent to external servers or stored.**

4. Data Sharing

We do **not sell or share** any user data with third parties.

We do **not use** your data for advertising, marketing, or analytics.

5. Storage


All data used by LIVE NOW is handled in-memory or stored locally within Chrome using `chrome.storage`. No data is sent to external servers.

6. Permissions Justification

- **Identity:** Used to authenticate the user via OAuth
 - **Storage:** Used to store temporary access tokens
 - **Host Permission (`googleapis.com`):** Required to fetch public stream data from the YouTube Data API
