What's Bequia like?

Bequia is one of 32 islands that makes up St Vincent and the Grenadines. It has a population of around five thousand people and it's one of our favourite places in the world. We hope you'll love it as much as we do.

What's the weather like?

29 degrees all year round with a nice breeze. Evenings cool down slightly so you might want to bring a cardigan.

What is there to do in Bequia?

Everything you'd expect on a Caribbean island! The beaches are like a film, the lobster is fresh and the rum punch will send you loopy.

When is the wedding?

Saturday 26th April, 3:30pm.

How will we get from the airport to our hotel?

We will meet people at the airport to make sure they get into taxis.

How do we get to Bequia from Saint Vincent?

We will be getting the ferry at 1030am on Thursday.
It costs £25 return and takes about 45 minutes.

What's the dress code?

We're getting married on the beach so you probably don't want to wear anything heavy. Men will be comfortable in summer suits / linen.

What currency do I need?

The main currency is Eastern Caribbean Dollars. You can't get these everywhere in the UK so we would advise making sure you have got your currency in good time. You can also use US dollars in hotels and restaurants.

Do I have to spend the whole time with the wedding party?

Definitely not! We want everyone to have a great time so feel free to do your own exploring - we will share all our favourite places. You do have to come to the ceremony though!

What plug sockets are in St Vincent?

St Vincent uses UK plugs so you don't need an adaptor.

Do I need a visa?
