- Budget Update: Raised 53000 so far not including special initiatives (not including acuto family fundraiser). We have underspent on several items, so in good shape. Have second cycle of teacher mini grants coming up. Have only spent 2200 of our 5000 budgeted.

- a. Movie Nights we'll start planning some regular ones after the 8th grade movie night. Ours will really just be community outings. Maybe entry is a nonperishable food item? Concessions can be fundraising?
- b. Worcester Railers night link to click on for tickets and can see JV and V games pre railers
- c. Playful Engineers options Husband and wife in Amherst who come and do STEM activities that can be catered to different age levels etc. Done during the school day. Can do a 3 day residency so they hit every grade level. \$1200/day, but offer evening community night events for \$600-\$700ish (2 hours) - anybody can come. Could do a community event first and feel it out and then book the more expensive option for next year if we like it. Maybe the week of the book fair?
