The November 11, 2001, Quarterly Retreat Meeting was held at the home of Richard and Elaine Whisnant. A quorum was present.

If any funds remain they are to go into Capital Funds. Richard Whisnant amended the motion to have the assessment be paid by January of 2002 to facilitate the bath remodeling work. The motion carried.

Members were updated on the new procedures for the front gate entry at Summerwinds and encouraged to get their card pass if they did not have one already.

Virgil Jones announced that a new maintenance agreement on the air conditioning system had been voted by the Management and would be placed with Bolton Electric. The agreement will allow upkeep of the system by Bolton and will allow emergency servicing of the unit without delay. The cost will be \$100 yearly.

Valery Cronk submitted the following slate of officers for next year: Phil Hayes, Chairman, Larry Bidwell, Vice Chairman, Gail Jones, Secretary, Joan Shelton, Treasurer and Nell Allen, Member at Large. They were elected by acclamation.

The meeting was adjourned.
