The OCSB is now accepting registration for Summer School 2025. Please see the attached flyer for information: <u>Summer School 2025 flyer</u>. Registration is open until June 20, 2025 @ 3pm. In all cases, a parent digital signature is required.

Please be advised:

- Registration for students in grades 9-11 is being completed through the OCSB Student Portal using the PRISM icon for all Reach Ahead in-person and online, Credit Recovery, and Upgrades.
- 2. If grade 9s are registering for Careers (GLC2O) and Civics (CHV2O), please take note that they are two half credit courses and registration must be done for both credits separately. As well, there are English and French Immersion options, so please choose the correct language.
- 3. Grade 8 students must sign up through the OCSB Continuing Education website. Grade 8s are only allowed to take TAS10 and AWQ20.
- 4. The **Credit Recovery** deadline is June 25, 2025 @ 4pm. Students must register through the OCSB Student Portal using the **PRISM icon**. These courses are not offered online but you can choose the location. Sacred Heart will upload the credit profile.
- Construction SHSM students in grade 11 may sign up for the summer co-op program.
 Students will use this <u>SHSM Summer School link</u> to register. Students should see their guidance counsellor at Sacred Heart once they complete the SHSM form.
- 6. The OCSB Indigenous Summer Program is offered in-person only at St. Pius and students can earn the NAC1O credit. If interested please complete the Indigenous Summer Program form to register.
- 7. Grade 6, 7 and 8 students have an option to sign up for the <u>Skills Builder Program</u>. The Skills Builder Program is an English literacy and numeracy support program for learners who are presently achieving at a level 2 or lower. Students will receive daily support to improve their reading, writing, numeracy, study and organizational skills. Please register using the <u>Skills Builder Program form</u>.
