Early on in the Pandemic some schemes closed down, mainly because the volunteers were older, but things are gradually picking up now. There have been 3 mergers with a new scheme in the village of Newdigate and we have 5 schemes in the pipeline. Some groups are now collecting donations via BACS. The Inland Revenue have no intention of putting up Fuel Allowance, which has been set at 45p per mile since April 2012.

The Treasurer Valerie Smith gave her report and Adoption of Accounts. We finished the year with a balance of £3,935.16 compared to £4,286.07 last year a decrease of £350.91
