Introduction

At Beth Bozman Education, it is believed that rewarding good behaviour and providing encouragement to make sensible choices is vital. The goal is to nurture an environment where students feel confident, respected and inspired to grow both academically and personally.

Aims

This policy is designed to:

- Promote teaching and learning through strong, respectful relationships
- Help pupils thrive in a safe, happy and secure environment, becoming responsible and independent learners
- Encourage and reward good behaviour through positive reinforcement
- Treat all pupils fairly and apply this policy consistently and supportively
- Ensure all children understand and follow the rules
- Create a space where effective learning and high self-esteem are fostered
- Promote self-discipline and a shared responsibility for behaviour

Clear Expectations

Beth Bozman Education refers to BB Behaviour to help students understand and operate within clear behavioural boundaries. This is a set of simple values and expectations that help create a respectful, focused, and enjoyable learning environment.

- Be respectful and polite to other pupils and tutor
- Be kind in words and actions
- Try your best in every session
- Listen to others without interrupting

Rewards

- Verbal praise and encouragement
- Stickers

Sanctions

When behaviour falls below expectations:

- A verbal warning will be given
- If inappropriate behaviour continues or is more serious:
 - A parent/guardian will be informed
 - An individual action plan will be developed in consideration of the pupil's needs and circumstances

Physical Intervention

Physical intervention will only be used as a last resort to prevent immediate harm to the student or others and will follow legal and professional guidelines.

Academic Integrity

Beth Bozman Education will support and guide learning but will not complete homework or assignments for students. Academic dishonesty (cheating or plagiarism) will be addressed respectfully, with the aim of promoting personal growth and integrity.

Parental Involvement

Parents and guardians are valued partners in their child's education. At Beth Bozman Education, we:

- Maintain open communication and welcome collaboration
- Inform parents promptly of concerns or successes
- Encourage parents to share feedback or raise concerns
- Invite parents to join in celebrating student achievements at end-of-term events
