Electrify Our Future Subcommittees

**Time commitments:

Members will attend general meetings **once a month or once every two months** for a few minutes or so. Individual subcommittee meeting timings **may vary in frequency** depending on the committee and the work needed. Occasionally, we will have community events to attend together as a coalition in order for electrification promotion, but they do not happen very often, and anyone can volunteer depending on their availability.

Presentations:

Details: In this group, members would work on presenting to various advocacy organizations about electrification. Members would need to show a certain level of commitment as they may be expected to lead/facilitate presentations at different community events or events within their own school. Members would also work to communicate and reach out to other advocacy organizations as seen fit.

*Note: For those interested in presentations, there may be a mini workshop hosted soon to aid members with their electrification presentations.

Publications:

Details: The members of this committee will focus on writing articles on electrification and other environmental topics. Members are in charge of the formal publications necessary for the coalition and are responsible for ensuring the maintenance of a written platform for student voice. Members would take on the task of writing 1 or 2 articles every other month, allowing for a more flexible rotation schedule.
