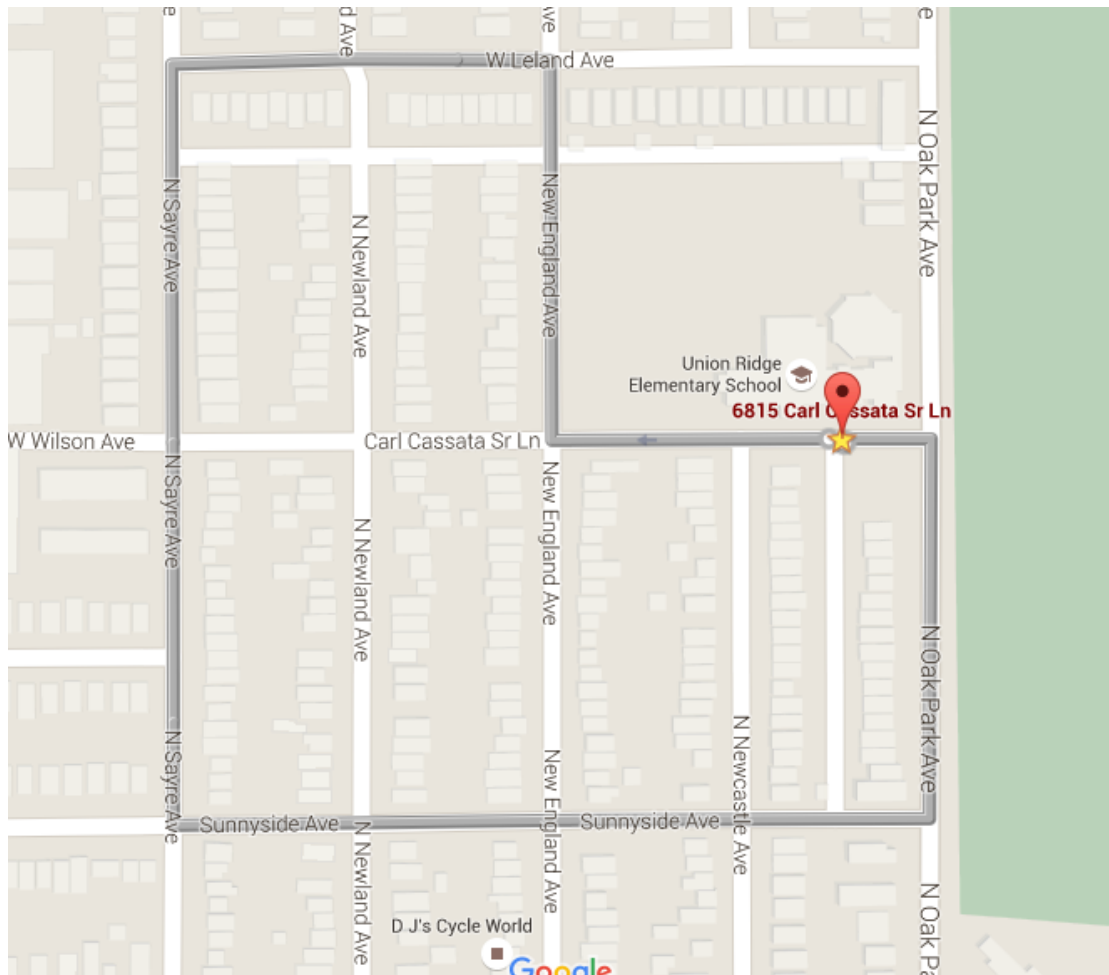
Thursday, October 25th - Wear Jeans- I'm a JEAN-ius, I'm *DRUG FREE!*
